## The Virtuous Woman

March is women's month, which includes international women's day. There probably won't be any Biblical perspectives, so we'll do it tonight.

Even though many religions and philosophies claim to set women free from oppression; it is similar to jumping out of the frying pan into the fire.

So why don't we look at it from God's point of view, as He revealed it through His Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, and as is written in His Word.

First, let us remember why Our Lord Jesus came down here.

Luke 4: 18 & 19 - The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

In what direction did He point us to follow? Matthew 22: 37 to 40 - Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

And when Our Lord Jesus calls for our total commitment to Our Heavenly Father, and to Him; He isn't kidding. Matthew 10: 37 to 39 - He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it.

Now did this apply to men only? Galatians 3: 26 to 29 - For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus. And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Yes, thankfully salvation and God's Promises are available to women also.

As human beings are social creatures, Our Lord God instills order in the confusing world, by setting up the family as the basic social unit.

In fact, the first motion passed in the new United Nations, after WW2, was to confirm the importance of the family.

Does God have any suggestions for the operation and maintenance of the family? Ephesians 5: 28 to 6: 4 - So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself. For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the

church: For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones. For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh. This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church. Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband. Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;) That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth. And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Is there any hierarchy in God's Creation? 1 Corinthians 11: 3 - But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God.

Before the manifestations start, what organization does not have a command structure? And instead of only demanding our privileges, all of us should be fulfilling our responsibilities. 1 Corinthians 7: 32 to 35 RSV - I want you to be free from anxieties. The unmarried man is anxious about the affairs of the Lord, how to please the Lord; but the married man is anxious about worldly affairs, how to please his wife, and his interests are divided. And the unmarried woman or girl is anxious about the affairs of the Lord, how to be holy in body and spirit; but the married woman is anxious about worldly affairs, how to please her husband. I say this for your own benefit, not to lay any restraint upon you, but to promote good order and to secure your undivided devotion to the Lord.

It's said, that the hand that rocks the cradle, rules the nation. There's a lot of truth to that. Would Moses or Samuel have followed the Lord God so closely, if they hadn't been brought up by Godly mothers? And many Godly women served Our Lord Jesus Christ, especially around the Crucifixion.

And they have a special function when they mature.

Titus 2: 1 to 8 ESV - But as for you, teach what accords with sound doctrine. Older men are to be sober-minded, dignified, self-controlled, sound in faith, in love, and in steadfastness. Older women likewise are to be reverent in behavior, not slanderers or slaves to much wine. They are to teach what is good, and so train the young women to love their husbands and children, to be self-controlled, pure, working at home, kind, and submissive to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be reviled. Likewise, urge the younger men to be self-controlled. Show yourself in all respects to be a model of good works, and in your teaching show integrity, dignity, and sound speech that cannot be condemned, so that an opponent may be put to shame, having nothing evil to say about us.

Are there any Bible passages about Godly women, so we can learn from them? Proverbs 31: 10 to 31 - Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price is far above rubies. The heart of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil. She will do him good and not evil all the days of her life. She seeketh wool, and flax, and worketh willingly with her hands. She is like the merchants' ships; she bringeth her food from afar. She riseth also while it is yet night, and giveth meat to her household, and a portion to her maidens. She considereth a field, and buyeth it: with the fruit of her hands she planteth a vineyard. She girdeth her loins with strength, and strengtheneth her arms. She perceiveth that her merchandise is good: her candle goeth not out by night. She layeth her hands to the spindle, and her hands hold the distaff. She stretcheth out her hand to the poor; yea, she reacheth forth her hands to the needy. She is not afraid of the snow for her household: for all her household are clothed with scarlet. She maketh herself coverings of tapestry; her clothing is silk and purple. Her husband is known in the gates, when he sitteth among the elders of the land. She maketh fine linen, and selleth it; and delivereth girdles unto the merchant. Strength and honour are her clothing; and she shall rejoice in time to come. She openeth her mouth with wisdom; and in her tongue is the law of kindness. She looketh well to the ways of her household, and eateth not the bread of idleness. Her children arise up, and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praiseth her. Many daughters have done virtuously, but thou excellest them all. Favour is deceitful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that feareth the LORD, she shall be praised. Give her of the fruit of her hands; and let her own works praise her in the gates.

There are so many good points mentioned here, why don't we take a closer look at it? Proverbs 31: 10 to 31 NKJV - 10 Who can find a virtuous wife? For her worth is far above rubies.

- 11 The heart of her husband safely trusts her; So he will have no lack of gain.
- 12 She does him good and not evil All the days of her life.
- 13 She seeks wool and flax, And willingly works with her hands.
- 14 She is like the merchant ships, She brings her food from afar.
- 15 She also rises while it is yet night, And provides food for her household, And a portion for her maidservants.
- 16 She considers a field and buys it; From her profits she plants a vineyard.
- 17 She girds herself with strength, And strengthens her arms.
- 18 She perceives that her merchandise is good, And her lamp does not go out by night.
- 19 She stretches out her hands to the distaff, And her hand holds the

spindle.

- 20 She extends her hand to the poor, Yes, she reaches out her hands to the needy.
- 21 She is not afraid of snow for her household, For all her household is clothed with scarlet.
- 22 She makes tapestry for herself; Her clothing is fine linen and purple.
- 23 Her husband is known in the gates, When he sits among the elders of the land.
- 24 She makes linen garments and sells them, And supplies sashes for the merchants.
- 25 Strength and honor are her clothing; She shall rejoice in time to come.
- 26 She opens her mouth with wisdom, And on her tongue is the law of kindness.
- 27 She watches over the ways of her household, And does not eat the bread of idleness.
- 28 Her children rise up and call her blessed; Her husband also, and he praises her:
- 29 "Many daughters have done well, But you excel them all."
- 30 Charm is deceitful and beauty is passing, But a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised.
- 31 Give her of the fruit of her hands, And let her own works praise her in the gates.

As we have seen, there are many noble qualities to the Godly woman.

And they can be emulated in our current society.

It will be hard, the ways of the world are not compatible with what Our Lord expects.

1 John 2: 15 - Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

Finding a godly woman to be your virtuous wife is the second most important decision a man will make in this life. The most important, is accepting Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour. So guys, forget the dating agencies. Pray earnestly, seek diligently, until Our Lord Jesus leads you to your prize worth more than many rubies.
