## **Salvation Scriptures**

- Ephesians 2:2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:
- Matthew 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as in heaven.
- Luke 22:42 Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done.
- John 16:7-9 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. 8 And when he is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: 9 Of sin, because they believe not on me;
- 2 Timothy 2:10 Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.
- Romans 15:20,21 Yea, so have I strived to preach the gospel, not where Christ was named, lest I should build upon another man's foundation: 21 But as it is written, To whom he was not spoken of, they shall see: and they that have not heard shall understand.
- Acts 2:36,37 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord & Christ. 37 Now when they heard *this*, they were pricked in their heart, & said to Peter & to the rest of the apostles, Men & brethren, what shall we do?
- Hebrews 4:2 For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard *it*.
- Jeremiah 24:7 And I will give them an heart to know me, that I *am* the LORD: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto me with their whole heart.
- Acts 16:14 And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard *us*: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.
- Matthew 13:14,15 And in them is fulfilled the prophecy of Esaias, which saith, By hearing ye shall hear, & shall not understand; & seeing ye shall see, & shall not perceive: For this people's heart is waxed gross, & their ears are dull of hearing, & their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with their eyes, & hear with their ears, & should understand with their heart, & should be converted, & I should heal them.
- Isaiah 6:9,10 he said, Go tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; & see ye indeed, but perceive not. Make the heart of this people fat, & make their ears heavy, & shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their heart, & convert, & be healed.

- Mark 4:11,12 And he said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God: but unto them that are without, all *these* things are done in parables: 12 That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and *their* sins should be forgiven them.
- John 12:39,40 Therefore they could not believe, because that Esaias said again, 40 He hath blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with *their* eyes, nor understand with *their* heart, and be converted, and I should heal them.
- Romans 11:7,8 What then? Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, & the rest were blinded (according as it is written, God hath given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, & ears that they should not hear;) unto this day.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:10,11 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 11 And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:
- Matthew 13:18-23 Hear ye therefore the parable of the sower. When any one heareth the word of the kingdom, & understandeth not, then cometh the wicked *one*, & catcheth away that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side. But he that received the seed into stony places, the same is he that heareth the word, & anon with joy receiveth it; Yet hath he not root in himself, but dureth for a while: for when tribulation or persecution ariseth because of the word, by & by he is offended. He also that received seed among the thorns is he that heareth the word; & the care of this world, & the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word, & he becometh unfruitful. But he that received seed into the good ground is he that heareth the word, understandeth; which also beareth fruit, & bringeth forth, some an hundredfold, some 60, some 30.
- 2 Corinthians 3:15,16 But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart. 16 Nevertheless when it shall turn to the Lord, the vail shall be taken away.
- Isaiah 30:28 And his breath, as an overflowing stream, shall reach to the midst of the neck, to sift the nations with the sieve of vanity: and *there shall be* a bridle in the jaws of the people, causing *them* to err.
- Hosea 11:3-7 I taught Ephraim also to go, taking them by their arms; but they knew not that I healed them. 4 I drew them with cords of a man, with bands of love: and I was to them as they that take off the yoke on their jaws, and I laid meat unto them. 5 He shall not return into the land of Egypt, but the Assyrian shall be his king, because they refused to return. 6 And the sword shall abide on his cities, and shall consume his branches, and devour *them*, because of their own counsels. 7 And my

- people are bent to backsliding from me: though they called them to the most High, none at all would exalt *him*.
- Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, to turn *them* from darkness to light, & *from* the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.
- 2 Timothy 2:24-26 And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all *men*, apt to teach, patient, In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; and *that* they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.
- Revelation 3:17-19 Because thou sayest, I am rich, & increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked: 18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and *that* the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; & anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see. 19 As many as I love, I rebuke & chasten: be zealous therefore, & repent.
- 2 Corinthians 7:10 For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.
- 2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.
- Luke 8:11-15 Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. 12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. 13 They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away. 14 And that which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection. 15 But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience.
- Acts 15:11 But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved, even as they.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
