mens' souls propagated by other souls, & bodies, Arianism, Deny true divinity of Jesus, deny that Jesus is consubstantial with the Father, say Jesus is similar in substance, similar, or dissimilar with the Father, Docetism, Belief that Jesus' physical body & his crucifixion were illusions, say Jesus only seemed to have a physical body and to physically die, he was incorporeal, a pure spirit, and could not physically die, Gnosticism, Luciferians, Luciferianism, Strongly anti-Arian sect, Pneumatomachians, Spirit fighters, deny the Holy Spirit, See Holy Spirit as a creation of Jesus, and a servant of the Father and the Son, Nicene Creed, Melchisedechians, say Melchisedech was the Holy Ghost, Monarchianism, indivisibility of God (the Father), Modalism, Adoptionism, monarchy of God to the extremes, dynamic monarchianism, believe Jesus was adopted as God's Son, Eastern theology, Monophysitism, Eutychianism, believe Christ's divinity dominates and overwhelms his humanity, Christ has two natures, Miaphysite position, say human and pre-incarnate divine nature of Christ were united as one divine human, Eutyches, Oriental Orthodoxes, Monothelitism, Belief that Jesus Christ had two natures but only one will, Oriental Orthodox Syriac, Armenian, Copticses, Maronites, Nestorianism, ecclesiastical rivalries, Patripassianism, Believe the Father and Son are 1, thus God the Father suffered on the cross

as Jesus, Psilanthropism, Belief that Jesus is merely human, Jesus never became divine, Jesus never existed prior to his incarnation as a man, Sabellianism, Believe the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are three characterizations of one God, not three distinct "persons" in one God, 3 parts of God just different roles, Modalistic Monarchianism, teaching that humans are divine souls, man created by an imperfect god - the Abrahamic God, a rejection and vilification of the human body, Material (Matter) versus Spiritual or Body (evil) versus Soul (good), Orthodox mystics taught gnosis (Knowledge of the God or the Good), corruption of Christianity, Gnosticism a dualistic heresy to Judaism, (Notzrim), Christianity and Hellenic philosophy, Arian Goths, (Huneric), and the Persian Empire, Conversion to Islam, Albigenian Crusade, Gnostic ideas influenced philosophies of various esoteric mystical movements, Manichaeism, dualistic religion stating that good and evil are equally powerful, & material things are evil, Paulicianism, Gnostic and dualistic sect, Priscillianism, Gnostic-Manichaean sect, & doctrines, magic, Naassenes, Sethianism, Believe snake in Eden was agent of the true god and brought knowledge of truth to man via the fall of man, Ophites, Believe serpent who tempted Adam and Eve was a hero, and God the enemy, Nicolaitans, say matter opposing spirit & body unimportant, Valentianism, Antinomianism, says Christians are freed by grace from any moral law, Audianism, Belief that god has human form, Anthropomorphism, Anthropomorphites, celebrate Jesus' death in the Jewish Passover, Quartodecimanism, Circumcellions, Donatism, a schism, Donatists, rigorists, say must be as of saints not sinners, sacraments done by traditores invalid, martyrdom as the supreme Christian virtue, saints actively sought martyrdom, Arab conquest, Ebionites, Jewish sect insisted on doing Jewish religious law and rites, as they said was Jesus' expounding of the Law, said Jesus was the Messiah but not as divine, Evionim, the Poor Ones, Euchites, Messalians,

Belief that: essence (ousia) of the Trinity perceived by carnal senses, Threefold God transformed himself into 1 to unite with the souls of the perfect, God has taken different forms in order to reveal himself to the senses, Only these revelations of God confer perfection on the Christian, state of perfection, freedom from the world and passion, is attained solely by prayer, not through thes or sacraments,

Bogomils of Bulgaria, the Bosnians, the Paterenes and Catharism, Iconoclasm, say icons are idols and should be destroyed, ordered destruction of all icons and persecuted those who refused, belief of the veneration of icons, Marcionism, Early Christian dualist belief system, say Paul is Jesus' chief apostle, rejected the Hebrew Bible and the Hebrew God, Marcionists, believed that the wrathful Hebrew God was a separate and lower entity than the all-forgiving God of the New Testament, similar to Gnostic Christian theology, apologists, Montanism, belief that prophecies of the Montanists superseded and fulfilled the doctrines proclaimed by the Apostles, ecstatic prophesying, believe Christians who fell from grace could not be redeemed, loss of salvation, avoidance of sin and discipline, emphasizing chastity, & forbidding remarriage, New Prophecy, Pelagianism, Believe original sin did not taint human nature and that mortal will is still capable of choosing good or evil without Divine aid, Councils of Aquileia, Basel, Carthage, Chalcedon, Constantinople, Diospolis, Ephesus, Orange, Philippopolis, Nicaea, Rimini, Seleucia, Toledo, & Trent, Semipelagianism, taught that grace aided free-will instead of replacing it,

Adoptionist and Manichaean mix, a mix of Armenian Paulicianism, and the Bulgarian Slavonics reform movement, dualist influence against the physical world, regarded as evil, thus denied that Jesus could become incarnate and still be the son of God, papal bull Ad abolendam, Mixed mystical beliefs with Christianity, believed possible to reach perfection on earth through a life of austerity and spiritualism, & they could communicate directly with God and did not need the Christians for intercession, Fraticelli, Spiritual Franciscans, Extreme of rule of Francis of Assisi, to poverty, and regarded the wealth of the R Cs as scandalous, baptism of infants, Eucharist, sacrifice of the mass, communion of saints, prayers for the dead, young girl, who gave herself out to be miraculously inspired by the Virgin Mary, Triclavianism, Belief that three, not four nails were used to crucify Christ and that a Roman soldier pierced him with a spear on the left, rather than right side, Albigenses and Waldenses, Waldensians, Vaudois, A spiritual movement, Genevan or Reformed branch of Protestantism, Febronianism, German nationalizing Catholicism, reunion of the dissidenteses with Catholic Christendom, Syllabus of Errors, Encyclical Immortale Dei, first Vatican Council, Erastianism, pope bulls Cum occasione, Restorationism, Christian primitivism, believe pristine
