- Luke 13:27 But He shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence ye are; depart from Me, all ye workers of iniquity.
- Matthew 7:23 (AV) And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from Me, ye that work iniquity.
- Matthew 7:22 Many will say to Me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Thy Name? and in Thy Name have cast out devils? and in Thy Name done many wonderful works?
- Hebrews 6:1 Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God,
- Luke 8 Referred to the sowing of the seed (Word of God). V14 And that which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

- Psalms 141:1-4 « A Psalm of David. » LORD, I cry unto Thee: make haste unto me; give ear unto my voice, when I cry unto Thee. 2 Let my prayer be set forth before Thee as incense; and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice. 3 Set a watch, O LORD, before my mouth; keep the door of my lips. 4 Incline not my heart to any evil thing, to practise wicked works with men that work iniquity: and let me not eat of their dainties.
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus,

- and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Psalms 141:5 Let the righteous smite me; *it shall be* a kindness: and let him reprove me; *it shall be* an excellent oil, *which* shall not break my head: for yet my prayer also *shall be* in their calamities.
- 2 Samuel 12:7,9,13 And Nathan said to David, Thou art the man. Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I anointed thee king over Israel, and I delivered thee out of the hand of Saul; 9 Wherefore hast thou despised the commandment of the LORD, to do evil in his sight? thou hast killed Uriah the Hittite with the sword, and hast taken his wife to be thy wife, and hast slain him with the sword of the children of Ammon. 13 And David said unto Nathan, I have sinned against the LORD. - Psalms 51 Referred to David's repentance.
- Psalms 141:6-8 When their judges are overthrown in stony places, they shall hear my words; for they are sweet. 7 Our bones are scattered at the grave's mouth, as when one cutteth and cleaveth *wood* upon the earth. 8 But mine eyes *are* unto Thee, O GOD the Lord: in Thee is my trust; leave not my soul destitute.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.
- Psalms 141:9,10 Keep me from the snares *which* they have laid for me, and the gins of the workers of iniquity. 10 Let the wicked fall into their own nets, whilst that I withal escape.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Deuteronomy 32:4 *He is* the Rock, His <u>work</u> *is* perfect: for all His ways *are* judgment: a God of Truth and without <u>iniquity</u>, just and right *is* He.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Luke 23:4 Then said Pilate to the chief priests and to the people, I find no fault in this man.
- 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye Holy; for I am Holy.

- 1 John 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in Him purifieth himself, even as He is pure.
- Psalms 23:3 He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for His Name's sake.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Job 31:3 *Is* not destruction to the wicked? and a strange *punishment* to the workers of iniquity?
- Job 34:8 Which goeth in company with the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u>, and walketh with wicked men.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Job 34:22 *There is* no darkness, nor shadow of death, where the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u> may hide themselves.

- Daniel 3:16-18 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we are not careful to answer thee in this matter. 17 If it be so, our God Whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. 18 But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.
- Psalms 14:4 Have all the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u> no knowledge? who eat up my people *as* they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD.
- Hebrews 1:14 Are they (God's angels) not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?
- Psalms 28:3 Draw me not away with the wicked, and with the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u>, which speak peace to their neighbours, but mischief *is* in their hearts. (con-artist)
- Proverbs 26:24,25 He that hateth dissembleth with his lips, and layeth up deceit within him; 25 When he speaketh fair, believe him not: for there are seven abominations in his heart.
- Psalms 36:12 There are the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u> fallen: they are cast down, and shall not be able to rise.

- Proverbs 15:16 Better is little with the fear of the LORD than great treasure and trouble therewith.
- Psalms 37:1 « *A Psalm* of David. » Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u>.
- Psalms 53:4 Have the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u> no knowledge? who eat up my people *as* they eat bread: they have not called upon God.
- Psalms 59:2 Deliver me from the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u>, and save me from bloody men.
- Matthew 6:13 And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.
- Psalms 64:2 Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; from the insurrection of the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u>:
- Matthew 5:15,16 Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. 16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
- Psalms 92:7 When the wicked spring as the grass, and when all the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u> do flourish; *it is* that they shall be destroyed for ever:
- Revelation 19:11 Summarized of Jesus' return & 1000 year rule to end of evil.
- Psalms 92:9 For, lo, thine enemies, O LORD, for, lo, thine enemies shall perish; all the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u> shall be scattered.
- Psalms 94:4 *How long* shall they utter *and* speak hard things? *and* all the workers of iniquity boast themselves?
- Psalms 94:16 Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? *or* who will stand up for me against the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u>?
- The Old Testament battle was done on the physical rhelm. Now in the New Covenant we fight in the heavenlies.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Summarized various occult practices used in the world like in sports.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of

- idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Psalms 125:5 As for such as turn aside unto their crooked ways, the LORD shall lead them forth with the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u>: *but* peace *shall be* upon Israel.
- Philippians 4:7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
- Psalms 141:4 Incline not my heart to *any* evil thing, to practise wicked <u>works</u> with men that <u>work</u> iniquity: and let me not eat of their dainties.
- Psalms 141:9 Keep me from the snares *which* they have laid for me, and the gins of the workers of iniquity.
- Proverbs 10:29 The way of the LORD *is* strength to the upright: but destruction *shall be* to the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u>.
- Proverbs 21:15 *It is* joy to the just to do judgment: but destruction *shall be* to the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u>.
- Isaiah 31:2 Yet He also *is* wise, and will bring evil, and will not call back His Words: but will arise against the house of the evildoers, and against the help of them that <u>work iniquity</u>.
- Isaiah 32:6 For the vile person will speak villany, and his heart will work iniquity, to practise hypocrisy, and to utter error against the LORD, to make empty the soul of the hungry, and he will cause the drink of the thirsty to fail.
- Mark 7:21 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, ...
- **Ezekiel 13 Referred to the ungodly cursing God's people.**
- John 4:10 Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the Gift of God, and Who it is that saith to thee, Give Me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of Him, and He would have given thee living water.
- Jeremiah 2:13 For my people have committed two evils; they have forsaken me the fountain of living waters, and hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water.
- Isaiah 59:6 Their webs shall not become garments, neither shall they cover themselves with their <u>works</u>: their <u>works</u> are <u>works</u> of <u>iniquity</u>, and the act of violence *is* in their hands.
- Isaiah 65:7 Your <u>iniquities</u>, and the <u>iniquities</u> of your fathers together, saith the LORD, which have burned incense upon the mountains, and blasphemed Me upon the hills: therefore will I measure their former <u>work</u> into their bosom.
- Daniel 9:8 O Lord, to us belongeth confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have sinned against thee.
- Hosea 6:8 Gilead is a city of them that work iniquity, and is polluted with

blood.

Eastons Revised Dictionary - Ramoth-gilead - Heights of Gilead, a city of refuge on the east of Jordan; called "Ramoth in Gilead" De 4:43 Jos 20:8 21:38 Here Ahab, who joined Jehoshaphat in an endeavour to rescue it from the hands of the king of Syria, was mortally wounded 1Ki 22:1-36 A similar attempt was afterwards made by Ahaziah and Joram, when the latter was wounded 2Ki 8:28 In this city Jehu, the son of Jehoshaphat, was anointed by one of the sons of the prophets 2Ki 9:1,4 It has with probability been identified with Reimun, on the northern slope of the Jabbok, about 5 miles west of Jerash or Gerasa, one of the cities of Decapolis. Others identify it with Gerosh, about 25 miles north-east of es-Salt, with which also many have identified it.
