No Demon Is Too Big For Jesus - Luke 8C

- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Genesis 3 Summarized the devil's deception & enticing Eve to doubt the Word of God.
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- Luke 8:22-40 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 8:22 (AV) Now it came to pass on a certain day, that He went into a ship with His disciples: and He said unto them, Let us go over unto the other side of the lake. And they launched forth.
- Luke 8:22 (NKJV) Now it happened, on a certain day, that He got into a boat with His disciples. And He said to them, Let us cross over to the other side of the lake. And they launched out.
- Luke 8:23 (AV) But as they sailed He fell asleep: and there came down a storm of wind on the lake; and they were filled *with water*, and were in jeopardy.
- Luke 8:23 (NKJV) But as they sailed He fell asleep. And a windstorm came down on the lake, and they were filling with water, and were in jeopardy.
- Mark 14:38 Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit truly is ready, but the flesh is weak.
- Luke 8:24 (AV) And they came to Him, and awoke Him, saying, Master, Master, we perish. Then He arose, and rebuked the wind and the raging of the water: and they ceased, and there was a calm.
- Luke 8:24 (NKJV) And they came to Him and awoke Him, saying, Master, Master, we are perishing! Then He arose and rebuked the wind and the raging of the water. And they ceased, and there was a calm.
- Matthew 8:26 And He saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith? Then He arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm.
- Ephesians 2:2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:
- Luke 4:13 And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from Him for a season.

- Numbers 14:11 And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke me? and how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them?
- Luke 8:25 (AV) And He said unto them, Where is your faith? And they being afraid wondered, saying one to another, What manner of man is this! for He commandeth even the winds and water, and they obey Him.
- Luke 8:25 (NKJV) But He said to them, Where is your faith? And they were afraid, and marveled, saying to one another, Who can this be? For He commands even the winds and water, and they obey Him!
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- Matthew 16:16 And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the Living God.
- In the Gospel of John Jesus reveals Himself first as a Good Man, then as a Prophet, then as the Messiah.
- Luke 8:26 (AV) And they arrived at the country of the Gadarenes, which is over against Galilee.
- Luke 8:26 (NKJV) Then they sailed to the country of the Gadarenes, which is opposite Galilee.
- Luke 8:27 (AV) And when He went forth to land, there met Him out of the city a certain man, which had devils long time, and ware no clothes, neither abode in *any* house, but in the tombs.
- Luke 8:27 (NKJV) And when He stepped out on the land, there met Him a certain man from the city who had demons for a long time. And he wore no clothes, nor did he live in a house but in the tombs.
- Luke 8:28 (AV) When he saw Jesus, he cried out, and fell down before Him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, *Thou* Son of God Most High? I beseech Thee, torment me not.

- Luke 8:28 (NKJV) When he saw Jesus, he cried out, fell down before Him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beg You, do not torment me!
- Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. ...
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Summarized of the torments of the demons through the religious leaders, Herod's soldiers, & Pilate's soldiers afflicting Jesus.
- Mark 7:21-21 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, 22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: 23 All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.
- Luke 8:29 (AV) (For He had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.)
- Luke 8:29 (NKJV) For He had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For it had often seized him, and he was kept under guard, bound with chains and shackles; and he broke the bonds and was driven by the demon into the wilderness.
- Mark 9:18 And wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth him: and he foameth, and gnasheth with his teeth, and pineth away: and I spake to Thy disciples that they should cast him out; and they could not.
- Mark 9:28,29 And when He was come into the house, His disciples asked Him privately, Why could not we cast him out? 29 And He said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
- Matthew 12:43-45 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none. 44 Then he saith, I will return into my house from whence I came out; and when he is come, he findeth it empty, swept, and garnished. 45 Then goeth he, and taketh with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there; and the last state of that man is worse than the first.

- Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation.
- Luke 8:30 (AV) And Jesus asked him, saying, What is thy name? And he said, Legion: because many devils were entered into him.
- Luke 8:30 (NKJV) Jesus asked him, saying, What is your name? And he said, Legion, because many demons had entered him.
- Luke 8:2 And certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities, Mary called Magdalene, out of whom went seven devils,
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Leviticus 10:10 And that ye may put difference between Holy and unholy, and between unclean and clean;
- Luke 8:31 (AV) And they be sought Him that He would not command them to go out into the deep.
- Luke 8:31 (NKJV) And they begged Him that He would not command them to go out into the abyss.
- 2 Peter 2:4 For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;
- Strongs #5020 tartaroo tar-tar-o'-o from Tartaros (the deepest abyss of Hell); AV-cast down to hell 1; 1) the name of the subterranean region, doleful and dark, regarded by the ancient Greeks as the abode of the wicked dead, where they suffer punishment for their evil deeds; it answers to Gehenna of the Jews 2) to thrust down to Tartarus, to hold captive in Tartarus
- Luke 8:32 (AV) And there was there an herd of many swine feeding on the mountain: and they be sought Him that He would suffer them to enter into them. And He suffered them.
- Luke 8:32 (NKJV) Now a herd of many swine was feeding there on the mountain. So they begged Him that He would permit them to enter them. And He permitted them.
- Luke 8:33 (AV) Then went the devils out of the man, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the lake, and were choked.
- Luke 8:33 (NKJV) Then the demons went out of the man and entered the swine, and the herd ran violently down the steep place into the lake and

drowned.

- Luke 8:34 (AV) When they that fed *them* saw what was done, they fled, and went and told *it* in the city and in the country.
- Luke 8:34 (NKJV) When those who fed *them* saw what had happened, they fled and told *it* in the city and in the country.
- Luke 8:35 (AV) Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.
- Luke 8:35 (NKJV) Then they went out to see what had happened, and came to Jesus, and found the man from whom the demons had departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed and in his right mind. And they were afraid.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Luke 8:36 (AV) They also which saw *it* told them by what means he that was possessed of the devils was healed.
- Luke 8:36 (NKJV) They also who had seen *it* told them by what means he who had been demon-possessed was healed.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just praying for healing.
- Luke 8:37 (AV) Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought Him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and He went up into the ship, and returned back again.
- Luke 8:37 (NKJV) Then the whole multitude of the surrounding region of the Gadarenes asked Him to depart from them, for they were seized with great fear. And He got into the boat and returned.
- John 8:48 Then answered the Jews, and said unto Him, Say we not well that Thou art a Samaritan, and hast a devil?
- Luke 8:38 (AV) Now the man out of whom the devils were departed besought Him that he might be with Him: but Jesus sent him away, saying,
- Luke 8:38 (NKJV) Now the man from whom the demons had departed begged Him that he might be with Him. But Jesus sent him away, saying,
- Mark 10:52 And Jesus said unto him (Bartemaus), Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.
- John 4 Summarized of Jesus ministering to the woman at the well & she brought the whole town to Jesus.
- Luke 8:39 (AV) Return to thine own house, and shew how great things God hath done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things Jesus had done unto him.
- Luke 8:39 (NKJV) Return to your own house, and tell what great things God

- has done for you. And he went his way and proclaimed throughout the whole city what great things Jesus had done for him.
- John 11:43-45 43 And when He thus had spoken, He cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth. 44 And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go. 45 Then many of the Jews which came to Mary, and had seen the things which Jesus did, believed on Him.
- John 12:10 But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;
- Luke 8:40 (AV) And it came to pass, that, when Jesus was returned, the people *gladly* received Him: for they were all waiting for Him.
- Luke 8:40 (NKJV) So it was, when Jesus returned, that the multitude welcomed Him, for they were all waiting for Him.
- More Service Notes: Luke 10:17-20 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 10:17 (AV) And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through Thy Name.
- Luke 10:17 (NKJV) Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your Name.
- Luke 10:18 (AV) And He said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.
- Luke 10:18 (NKJV) And He said to them, I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven.
- Luke 10:19 (AV) Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Luke 10:19 (NKJV) Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Luke 10:20 (AV) Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.
- Luke 10:20 (NKJV) Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.
