Jesus' Compassion For Women - Luke 8D

John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed. Luke 8:35-40 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to

- Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid. 36 They also which saw it told them by what means he that was possessed of the devils was healed. 37 Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought Him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and He went up into the ship, and returned back again. 38 Now the man out of whom the devils were departed besought Him that he might be with Him: but Jesus sent him away, saying, 39 Return to thine own house, and shew how great things God hath done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things Jesus had done for him. 40 And it came to pass, that, when Jesus was returned, the people gladly received Him: for they were all waiting for Him.
- John 4:28-30 The woman then left her waterpot, and went her way into the city, and saith to the men, 29 Come, see a Man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ? 30 Then they went out of the city, and came unto Him.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- Luke 8:41-56 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 8:41 (AV) And, behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue: and he fell down at Jesus' feet, and besought Him that He would come into his house:
- Luke 8:41 (NKJV) And behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue. And he fell down at Jesus' feet and begged Him to come to his house,
- Mark 7:26,29 The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought Him that He would cast forth the devil out of her daughter. 29 And He said unto her, For this saying go thy way; the devil is gone out of thy daughter.
- Genesis 2:21,22 And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead

- thereof; 22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made He a woman, and brought her unto the man.
- God did not make woman from a toe-nail for Adam to rule over her. God did not make woman from a hair to rule over Adam. God made woman from a rib near Adam's heart to love her & work together with her.
- Genesis 2:24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.
- Leviticus 24:20 Breach for breach, eye for eye, tooth for tooth: as he hath caused a blemish in a man, so shall it be done to him again.
- Matthew 5:38 Ye have heard that it hath been said, An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth: 39 But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also.
- Luke 8:2,3 And certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities, Mary called Magdalene, out of whom went seven devils, 3 And Joanna the wife of Chuza Herod's steward, and Susanna, and many others, which ministered unto Him of their substance.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ... 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Luke 8:42 (AV) For he had one only daughter, about twelve years of age, and she lay a dying. But as He went the people thronged Him.
- Luke 8:42 (NKJV) for he had an only daughter about twelve years of age, and she was dying. But as He went, the multitudes thronged Him.
- Luke 8:43 (AV) And a woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed of any,
- Luke 8:43 (NKJV) Now a woman, having a flow of blood for twelve years, who had spent all her livelihood on physicians and could not be healed by any,
- Acts 17:22,23 Then Paul stood in the midst of Mars' hill, and said, Ye men of Athens, I perceive that in all things ye are too superstitious. 23 For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you.
- Leviticus 15:25 And if a woman have an issue of her blood many days out of

- the time of her separation, or if it run beyond the time of her separation; all the days of the issue of her uncleanness shall be as the days of her separation: she shall be unclean.
- Luke 8:44 (AV) Came behind *Him*, and touched the border of His garment: and immediately her issue of blood stanched.
- Luke 8:44 (NKJV) came from behind and touched the border of His garment. And immediately her flow of blood stopped.
- Mark 10:48,49 And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. 49 And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; He calleth thee.
- Mark 5:6 But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped Him, Mark 2:3 And they come unto Him, bringing one sick of the palsy, which was borne of four.
- Luke 8:45 (AV) And Jesus said, Who touched Me? When all denied, Peter and they that were with Him said, Master, the multitude throng Thee and press *Thee*, and sayest Thou, Who touched Me?
- Luke 8:45 (NKJV) And Jesus said, Who touched Me? When all denied it, Peter and those with him said, Master, the multitudes throng and press You, and You say, Who touched Me?
- Luke 8:46 (AV) And Jesus said, Somebody hath touched Me: for I perceive that virtue is gone out of Me.
- Luke 8:46 (NKJV) But Jesus said, Somebody touched Me, for I perceived power going out from Me.
- Matthew 8:16 When the even was come, they brought unto Him many that were possessed with devils: and He cast out the spirits with His Word, and healed all that were sick:
- Matthew 4:23,24 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.
- Luke 8:47 (AV) And when the woman saw that she was not hid, she came trembling, and falling down before Him, she declared unto Him before all the people for what cause she had touched Him, and how she was

- healed immediately.
- Luke 8:47 (NKJV) Now when the woman saw that she was not hidden, she came trembling; and falling down before Him, she declared to Him in the presence of all the people the reason she had touched Him and how she was healed immediately.
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Luke 8:48 (AV) And He said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace.
- Luke 8:48 (NKJV) And He said to her, Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well. Go in peace.
- Numbers 8:21 And the Levites were purified, and they washed their clothes; and Aaron offered them as an offering before the LORD; and Aaron made an atonement for them to cleanse them.
- Luke 8:49 (AV) While He yet spake, there cometh one from the ruler of the synagogue's *house*, saying to him, Thy daughter is dead; trouble not the Master.
- Luke 8:49 (NKJV) While He was still speaking, someone came from the ruler of the synagogue's *house*, saying to him, Your daughter is dead. Do not trouble the Teacher.
- Luke 8:50 (AV) But when Jesus heard *it*, He answered him, saying, Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole.
- Luke 8:50 (NKJV) But when Jesus heard *it*, He answered him, saying, Do not be afraid; only believe, and she will be made well.
- Summarized of many times God said "fear not" or "be not afraid".
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- 1 Samuel 16:14,23 But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him. 23 And it came to pass, when the

- evil spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.
- John 14:2,3 In My Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- Luke 8:51 (AV) And when He came into the house, He suffered no man to go in, save Peter, and James, and John, and the father and the mother of the maiden.
- Luke 8:51 (NKJV) When He came into the house, He permitted no one to go in except Peter, James, and John, and the father and mother of the girl.
- Luke 8:52 (AV) And all wept, and bewailed her: but He said, Weep not; she is not dead, but sleepeth.
- Luke 8:52 (NKJV) Now all wept and mourned for her; but He said, Do not weep; she is not dead, but sleeping.
- Mark 8:38 Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of Me and of My Words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of Man be ashamed, when He cometh in the glory of His Father with the Holy angels.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Luke 8:53 (AV) And they laughed Him to scorn, knowing that she was dead. Luke 8:53 (NKJV) And they ridiculed Him, knowing that she was dead.
- Matthew 27:41,42 Likewise also the chief priests mocking Him, with the scribes and elders, said, 42 He saved others; Himself He cannot save. If He be the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe Him.
- Matthew 21:12,13 And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves, 13 And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Luke 8:54 (AV) And He put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise.
- Luke 8:54 (NKJV) But He put them all outside, took her by the hand and called, saying, Little girl, arise.
- Luke 8:55 (AV) And her spirit came again, and she arose straightway: and

- He commanded to give her meat.
- Luke 8:55 (NKJV) Then her spirit returned, and she arose immediately. And He commanded that she be given *something* to eat.
- John 11:43 And when He thus had spoken, He cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.
- Luke 16:26 And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence.
- Mark 8:2,3 I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now been with Me three days, and have nothing to eat: 3 And if I send them away fasting to their own houses, they will faint by the way: for divers of them came from far.
- Exodus 13:17 And it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that God led them not through the way of the land of the Philistines, although that was near; for God said, Lest peradventure the people repent when they see war, and they return to Egypt:
- Luke 8:56 (AV) And her parents were astonished: but He charged them that they should tell no man what was done.
- Luke 8:56 (NKJV) And her parents were astonished, but He charged them to tell no one what had happened.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- 1 Peter 3:1 Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the Word, they also may without the Word be won by the conversation of the wives; 2 While they behold your chaste conversation coupled with fear.
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
