- Mark 6:7 And He called unto Him the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and gave them power over unclean spirits;
- Luke 9:18-36 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 9:18 (AV) And it came to pass, as He was alone praying, His disciples were with Him: and He asked them, saying, Whom say the people that I am?
- Luke 9:18 (NKJV) And it happened, as He was alone praying, *that* His disciples joined Him, and He asked them, saying, Who do the crowds say that I am?
- Luke 9:19 (AV) They answering said, John the Baptist; but some *say*, Elias; and others *say*, that one of the old prophets is risen again.
- Luke 9:19 (NKJV) So they answered and said, John the Baptist, but some say Elijah; and others say that one of the old prophets has risen again.
- Matthew 3:2 And (John the Baptist) saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Luke 9:20 (AV) He said unto them, But Whom say ye that I am? Peter answering said, The Christ of God.
- Luke 9:20 (NKJV) He said to them, But Who do you say that I am? Peter answered and said, The Christ of God.
- Numbers 22-24 Summarized of Balak wanting Balaam to curse Israel, but God blessed them.
- Numbers 22:38 And Balaam said unto Balak, Lo, I am come unto thee: have I now any power at all to say any thing? the Word that God putteth in my mouth, that shall I speak.
- Luke 9:21 (AV) And He straitly charged them, and commanded *them* to tell no man that thing;

- Referred to Jesus cleaning out the temple twice.
- Matthew 21:13 And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- John 11:43 And when He thus had spoken, He cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.
- John 12:10 But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;
- Matthew 28:2 And, behold, there was a great earthquake: for the angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat upon it.

- Luke 9:25 (NKJV) For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and is himself destroyed or lost?
- Luke 12:18,20 And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater; and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods. 20 But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?
- Matthew 19:23 Then said Jesus unto his disciples, Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven.
- Mark 10:15 Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child, he shall not enter therein.
- Luke 9:26 (AV) For whosoever shall be ashamed of Me and of My Words, of him shall the Son of Man be ashamed, when He shall come in His Own glory, and *in His* Father's, and of the Holy angels.

- Luke 9:27 (AV) But I tell you of a truth, there be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the kingdom of God.
- Luke 9:27 (NKJV) But I tell you truly, there are some standing here who

- shall not taste death till they see the kingdom of God.
- Acts 2:3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.
- Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Luke 9:28 (AV) And it came to pass about an eight days after these sayings, He took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to pray.
- Luke 9:28 (NKJV) Now it came to pass, about eight days after these sayings, that He took Peter, John, and James and went up on the mountain to pray.
- Exodus 19:16-18 And it came to pass on the third day in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount, and the voice of the trumpet exceeding loud; so that all the people that was in the camp trembled. 17 And Moses brought forth the people out of the camp to meet with God; and they stood at the nether part of the mount. 18 And all the people saw the thunderings, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw it, they removed, and stood afar off.

- Luke 9:30 (AV) And, behold, there talked with him two men, which were Moses and Elias:
- Luke 9:30 (NKJV) And behold, two men talked with Him, who were Moses and Elijah,
- Luke 9:31 (AV) Who appeared in glory, and spake of His decease which He should accomplish at Jerusalem.
- Luke 9:31 (NKJV) who appeared in glory and spoke of His decease which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem.
- John 10:17 Therefore doth My Father love Me, because I lay down My life, that I might take it again.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.
- John 15:13 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.
- Luke 9:32 (AV) But Peter and they that were with Him were heavy with sleep: and when they were awake, they saw His glory, and the two men

- that stood with Him.
- Luke 9:32 (NKJV) But Peter and those with him were heavy with sleep; and when they were fully awake, they saw His glory and the two men who stood with Him.
- Luke 9:33 (AV) And it came to pass, as they departed from Him, Peter said unto Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for Thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias: not knowing what he said.
- Luke 9:33 (NKJV) Then it happened, as they were parting from Him, *that*Peter said to Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here; and let us make three tabernacles: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah not knowing what he said.
- Luke 9:34 (AV) While he thus spake, there came a cloud, and overshadowed them: and they feared as they entered into the cloud.
- Luke 9:34 (NKJV) While he was saying this, a cloud came and overshadowed them; and they were fearful as they entered the cloud.
- Luke 9:35 (AV) And there came a Voice out of the cloud, saying, This is My beloved Son: hear Him.
- Luke 9:35 (NKJV) And a Voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!
- Matthew 3:17 And Io a Voice from heaven, saying, This is My beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased.
- Matthew 15:11 Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a man; but that which cometh out of the mouth, this defileth a man.
- Mark 2:28 Therefore the Son of Man is Lord also of the Sabbath.
- Mark 3:4 And He saith unto them, Is it lawful to do good on the Sabbath days, or to do evil? to save life, or to kill? But they held their peace.
- John 20:1 The first day of the week cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre.

- Luke 9:36 (NKJV) When the Voice had ceased, Jesus was found alone. But they kept quiet, and told no one in those days any of the things they had seen.

- Matthew 4:23,24 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them.
- John 3:7-10 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. 8 The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit. 9 Nicodemus answered and said unto him, How can these things be? 10 Jesus answered and said unto him, Art thou a master of Israel, and knowest not these things?
- Revelation 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and He that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He doth judge and make war.
- Revelation 20:2-10 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, 3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season. 4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the Word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. 5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. 6 Blessed and Holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years. 7 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, 8 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea. 9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them. 10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Genesis 3 Summarized of the devil deceiving Eve & Adam, their sin & the

fall of mankind.

Revelation 13 Referred to those taking the mark of the beast.

- James 1:25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.
