- Luke 9:44 (NKJV) Let these Words sink down into your ears, for the Son of Man is about to be betrayed into the hands of men.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
- Strongs #1228 diabolos dee-ab'-ol-os AV-devil 35, false accuser 2, slanderer 1; 38 1) prone to slander, slanderous, accusing falsely 1a) a calumniator, false accuser, slanderer, 2) metaph. applied to a man who, by opposing the cause of God, may be said to act the part of the devil or to side with him. Satan the prince of the demons, the author of evil, persecuting good men, estranging mankind from God and enticing them to sin, afflicting them with diseases by means of demons who take possession of their bodies at his bidding.
- Luke 9:45 (AV) But they understood not this saying, and it was hid from them, that they perceived it not: and they feared to ask Him of that saying.
- Luke 9:45 (NKJV) But they did not understand this saying, and it was hidden from them so that they did not perceive it; and they were afraid to ask Him about this saying.
- Matthew 13:10,11,13 And the disciples came, and said unto him, Why speakest thou unto them in parables? 11 He answered and said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given. 13 Therefore speak I to them in parables: because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not, neither do they understand.
