Matthew 4:23,24 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them.

Luke 14 Summarized excuses to not go to wedding feast.

Matthew 9:9 And as Jesus passed forth from thence, He saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and He saith unto him, Follow Me. And he arose, and followed Him.

Matthew 4:18-22 (Summarized) And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers. 19 And He saith unto them, Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men. 20 And they straightway left their nets, and followed Him. 21 And going on from thence, He saw other two brethren, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in a ship with Zebedee their father, mending their nets; and He called them. 22 And they immediately left the ship and their father, and followed Him.

Matthew 3:2 (John) saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. Ezra 1:2 Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, The LORD God of heaven hath given me all the kingdoms of the earth; and he hath charged me to build him an house at Jerusalem, which is in Judah.

Ezra 7:10 For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do *it*, and to teach in Israel statutes and judgments.

Luke 10:1 (AV) After these things the Lord appointed other 70 also, and sent them two and two before His face into every city and place, whither He Himself would come.

Luke 10:1 (NKJV) After these

- things the Lord appointed 70 others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go.
- Exodus 18 & Numbers 11 Referred to Moses' father-in-law telling Moses to set up helpers to judge Israel. God annointed 70 man.
- John 19:6 When the chief priests therefore and officers saw Him, they cried out, saying, Crucify Him, crucify Him. Pilate saith unto them, Take ye Him, and crucify Him: for I find no fault in Him.
- Mark 8:29 And He saith unto them, But Whom say ye that I am? And Peter answereth and saith unto Him, Thou art the Christ.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.
- Matthew 18:16 But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.
- Luke 10:2 (AV) Therefore said He unto them, The harvest truly *is* great, but the labourers *are* few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the Harvest, that He would send forth labourers into His harvest.
- Luke 10:2 (NKJV) Then He said to them, The harvest truly *is* great, but the laborers *are* few; therefore pray the Lord of the Harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.
- Matthew 20 & Mark 10 Referred to blind men Jesus healed by Jericho.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before Me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- Matthew 20:1-14 (Summarized) For the kingdom of heaven is like unto a man that is an householder, which went out early in the morning to hire labourers into his vineyard. 2 And when he had agreed with the labourers for a penny a day, he sent them into his vineyard. 3 And he went out about the third hour, and saw others standing idle in the marketplace, 4 And said unto them; Go ye also into the vineyard, and whatsoever is right I will give you. And they went their way. 5 Again he went out about the sixth and ninth hour, and did likewise. 6 And about the eleventh hour he went out, and found others standing idle, and saith unto them, Why stand ye here all the day idle? 7 They say unto him, Because no man hath hired us. He saith unto them, Go ye also into the vineyard; and whatsoever is right, that shall ye receive. 8 So when even was come, the lord of the vineyard saith unto his steward, Call the labourers, and give them their hire, beginning from the last unto the first. 9 And when they came that were hired about the eleventh hour, they received every man a penny. 10 But when the first came, they supposed that they should have received more; and they likewise received every man a penny. 11 And when they had received it, they murmured against the goodman of the house, 12 Saying, These last

- have wrought but one hour, and thou hast made them equal unto us, which have borne the burden and heat of the day. 13 But he answered one of them, and said, Friend, I do thee no wrong: didst not thou agree with me for a penny? 14 Take that thine is, and go thy way: I will give unto this last, even as unto thee.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Luke 10:3 (AV) Go your ways: behold, I send you forth as lambs among wolves.

 Luke 10:3 (NKJV) Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs among wolves.
- Luke 10:4 (AV) Carry neither purse, nor scrip, nor shoes: and salute no man by the way.

 Luke 10:4 (NKJV) Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals; and greet no one along the road.
- 1 Kings 13 Summarized of the man of God warning Jeroboam & the old prophet deceiving him.
- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- Genesis 3 Summarized of the sin & fall of mankind. Jonah Summarized.
- Luke 10:5 (AV) And into whatsoever house ye enter, first say, Peace *be* to this house.

 Luke 10:5 (NKJV) But whatever house you enter, first say, Peace to this house.
- Luke 10:6 (AV) And if the son of peace be there, your peace shall rest upon it: if not, it shall turn to you again.
- Luke 10:6 (NKJV) And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you.

- 1 Timothy 5:18 For the Scripture saith, (Deuteronomy 25:4) Thou shalt not muzzle the ox that treadeth out the corn. And, The labourer is worthy of his reward.
- Luke 10:8 (AV) And into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you:
- Luke 10:8 (NKJV) Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you.
- Luke 10:9 (AV) And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.
- Luke 10:9 (NKJV) And heal the sick there, and say to them, The kingdom of God has come near to you.

- Acts 28 Summarized of Paul in the ship wreck by Isle of Malta.
- Acts 17:23 For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you.
- Acts 5:15 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.

- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- Luke 10:11 (AV) Even the very dust of your city, which cleaveth on us, we do wipe off against you: notwithstanding be ye sure of this, that the kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.

 Luke 10:11 (NKJV) The very dust of your city which clings to us we wipe off against you.

 Nevertheless know this, that the kingdom of God has come near you.
- Luke 8:37 Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and He went up into the ship, and returned back again.
- Matthew 14:34-36 And when they were gone over, they came into the land of Gennesaret. 35 And when the men of that place had knowledge of Him, they sent out into all that country round about, and brought unto Him all that were diseased; 36 And besought Him that they might only touch the hem of His garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole.
- Luke 10:12 (AV) But I say unto you, that it shall be more tolerable in that day for Sodom, than for that city.

 Luke 10:12 (NKJV) But I say to you that it will be more tolerable in that Day for Sodom than for that city.
- Luke 10:13 (AV) Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works had been done in Tyre and Sidon, which have been done in you, they had a great while ago repented, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.
- Luke 10:13 (NKJV) Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the

- mighty works which were done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.
- Matthew 12:41 The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here.
- Luke 10:14 (AV) But it shall be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment, than for you.

 Luke 10:14 (NKJV) But it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment than for you.
- Luke 10:15 (AV) And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted to heaven, shalt be thrust down to hell.

 Luke 10:15 (NKJV) And you,
 Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades.
- Luke 4:29 And rose up, and thrust Him out of the city, and led Him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast Him down headlong.
- Mark 6:5,6 And He could there do no mighty work, save that He laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them. 6 And He marvelled because of their unbelief. And He went round about the villages, teaching.
- Numbers 14:11 And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke Me? and how long will it be ere they believe Me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them?
- Mark 16:14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.
- Luke 10:16 (AV) He that heareth you heareth Me; and he that despiseth you despiseth Me; and he that despiseth Me despiseth Him that sent Me.
- Luke 10:16 (NKJV) He who hears you hears Me, he who rejects you rejects Me, and he who rejects Me rejects Him who sent Me.
- 1 John 2:23 Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.
- Luke 8:12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the Word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.
- Mark 10:21 Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow Me. 22 And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: for he had great possessions. 23 And Jesus looked round about, and saith unto His disciples, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God!
