- Mark 12 Referred to the Pharisees trying to trick Jesus with the question of 7 brothers & 1 wife V24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?
- Luke 10:26 (AV) He said unto him, What is written in the Law? how readest thou?
- Luke 10:26 (NKJV) He said to him, What is written in the Law? What is your reading *of it*?
- Luke 20:4 The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men?
- John 4 Summarized of Jesus & the woman at the well V25 The woman saith unto Him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when He is come, He will tell us all things. 26 Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am He.
- Luke 10:27 (AV) And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.

- Matthew 4:23,24 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them.

- Ezekiel & Jeremiah Referred to the passages of the bad shepherds not caring for the flock.
- Luke 10:32 (AV) And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked *on him*, and passed by on the other side.
- Luke 10:32 (NKJV) Likewise a Levite, when he arrived at the place, came and looked, and passed by on the other side.
- Mark 4:19 And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the Word, and it becometh unfruitful.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

- Luke 10:35 (NKJV) On the next day, when he departed, he took out two denarii, gave *them* to the innkeeper, and said to him, Take care of him; and whatever more you spend, when I come again, I will repay you.
- Luke 10:36 (AV) Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves?
- Luke 10:36 (NKJV) So which of these three do you think was neighbor to him who fell among the thieves?
- Luke 10:37 (AV) And he said, He that shewed mercy on him. Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise.
- Luke 10:37 (NKJV) And he said, He who showed mercy on him. Then Jesus said to him, Go and do likewise.
- Psalms 136 Every second line is "for His mercy endureth for ever."
- Job 11:6 And that He would shew thee the secrets of wisdom, that they are double to that which is! Know therefore that God exacteth of thee less than thine iniquity deserveth.
