- Matthew 6 Referred to the parallel Lord's Prayer passage.
- Matthew 6:7 But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.
- John 16:23 And in that day ye shall ask Me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in My Name, He will give it you.
- James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- Luke 18 Referred to the persistant widow.
- Deuteronomy 3:25-27 I pray thee, let me go over, and see the good land that is beyond Jordan, that goodly mountain, and Lebanon. 26 But the LORD was wroth with me for your sakes, and would not hear me: and the LORD said unto me, Let it suffice thee; speak no more unto Me of this matter. 27 Get thee up into the top of Pisgah, and lift up thine eyes westward, and northward, and southward, and eastward, and behold it with thine eyes: for thou shalt not go over this Jordan.

- Luke 11:1 (AV) And it came to pass, that, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, one of His disciples said unto Him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.
- Luke 11:1 (NKJV) Now it came to pass, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, *that* one of His disciples said to Him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.
- Luke 6:12,13 And it came to pass in those days, that He went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God. 13 And when it was day, He called unto Him His disciples: and of them He chose twelve, whom also He named apostles;
- Luke 11:2 (AV) And He said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy Name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.
- Luke 11:2 (NKJV) So He said to them, When you pray, say: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your Name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as *it is* in heaven.
- John 16:26 At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you:
- Luke 2:14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

- James 1:13 Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth He any man:
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- 1 Peter 4:4 Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you:
- Strongs #4190 poneros pon-ay-ros' AV-evil 51, wicked 10, wicked one 6, evil things 2, misc 7; 76 1) full of labours, annoyances, hardships 1a) pressed and harassed by labours 1b) bringing toils, annoyances, perils; of a time full of peril to Christian faith and steadfastness; causing pain and trouble 2) bad, of a bad nature or condition 2a) in a physical sense: diseased or blind 2b) in an ethical sense: evil wicked, bad
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

- Acts 19:12 So that from his (Paul) body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.
- Luke 11:5 (AV) And He said unto them, Which of you shall have a friend, and shall go unto him at midnight, and say unto him, Friend, lend me three loaves;
- Luke 11:5 (NKJV) And He said to them, Which of you shall have a friend, and go to him at midnight and say to him, Friend, lend me three loaves;
- Luke 11:6 (AV) For a friend of mine in his journey is come to me, and I have nothing to set before him?
- Luke 11:6 (NKJV) for a friend of mine has come to me on his journey, and I have nothing to set before him;
- Luke 11:7 (AV) And he from within shall answer and say, Trouble me not: the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give thee.
- Luke 11:7 (NKJV) and he will answer from within and say, Do not trouble me; the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give to you?
- Matthew 8:21 And another of His disciples said unto Him, Lord, suffer me first to go and bury my father.
- Matthew 9:9 And as Jesus passed forth from thence, He saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and He saith unto him, Follow Me. And he arose, and followed Him.
- Matthew 4:18-22 And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers. 19 And He saith unto them, Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men. 20 And they straightway left their nets, and followed Him. 21 And going on from thence, He saw other two brethren, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in a ship with Zebedee their father, mending their nets; and He called them. 22 And they immediately left the ship and their father, and followed Him.
- Mark 10:49-52 And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; He calleth thee. 50 And he, casting away his garment, rose, and came to Jesus. 51 And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight. 52 And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.
- Luke 11:8 (AV) I say unto you, Though he will not rise and give him, because he is his friend, yet because of his importunity he will rise and give him as

- many as he needeth.
- Luke 11:8 (NKJV) I say to you, though he will not rise and give to him because he is his friend, yet because of his persistence he will rise and give him as many as he needs.
- Luke 11:9 (AV) And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.
- Luke 11:9 (NKJV) So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.
- 1 Kings 18-19 Summarized of Elijah running from Jezebel after a big victory.
- Luke 15:8,9 Either what woman having ten pieces of silver, if she lose one piece, doth not light a candle, and sweep the house, and seek diligently till she find it? 9 And when she hath found it, she calleth her friends and her neighbours together, saying, Rejoice with me; for I have found the piece which I had lost.
- Luke 11:10 (AV) For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.
- Luke 11:10 (NKJV) For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.
- Luke 11:11 (AV) If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if *he ask* a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent?
- Luke 11:11 (NKJV) If a son asks for bread from any father among you, will he give him a stone? Or if *he asks* for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish?
- Luke 4:3 And the devil said unto Him, If Thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread.
- Luke 11:12 (AV) Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion?
- Luke 11:12 (NKJV) Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion?
- Luke 11:13 (AV) If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall *your* Heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask Him?
- Luke 11:13 (NKJV) If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will *your* Heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!
- Exodus 16 Referred to the preparation of bread from Manna.
- Numbers 11 Summarized of God sending flesh to eat until Israel was sick.
