The Dumb Spirit - Luke 11B

- Luke 11:14 (AV) And He was casting out a devil, and it was dumb. And it came to pass, when the devil was gone out, the dumb spake; and the people wondered.
- Luke 11:14 (NKJV) And He was casting out a demon, and it was mute. So it was, when the demon had gone out, that the mute spoke; and the multitudes marveled.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater *works* than these shall he do; because I go unto My Father.
- Joshua 7 Summarized of Achan's sin causing many to die.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just praying for healing.
- John 9:2,3 And His disciples asked Him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind? 3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.
- Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of *our* faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Joshua 9 referred to Gibeon deceiving Israel. V14,15 And the men took of their victuals, and asked not *counsel* at the mouth of the LORD. 15 And Joshua made peace with them, and made a league with them, to let them live: and the princes of the congregation sware unto them.
- Strongs #2974 kophos *ko-fos'* AV-dumb 8, deaf 5, speechless 1; 14 1) blunted, dull 1a) blunted (or lamed) in tongue, dumb 1b) blunted, dull in hearing 1c) deaf.
- Luke 1:64 And his mouth was opened immediately, and his tongue *loosed*, and he spake, and praised God.
- Mark 10:49-52 And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; He calleth thee. 50 And he, casting away his garment, rose, and came to Jesus. 51 And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight. 52 And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.

- Ezra 7:10 For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do *it*, and to teach in Israel statutes and judgments.
- Matthew 9:32,33 As they went out, behold, they brought to Him a dumb <2974> man possessed with a devil. 33 And when the devil was cast out, the dumb <2974> spake: and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel.
- Matthew 11:5 The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf <2974> hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them.
- Matthew 12:22 Then was brought unto Him one possessed with a devil, blind, and dumb <2974>: and He healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb <2974> both spake and saw.
- Matthew 15:30,31 And great multitudes came unto Him, having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb <2974>, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and He healed them: 31 Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb <2974> to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.
- Mark 7:32 And they bring unto Him one that was deaf <2974>, and had an impediment in his speech; & they beseech Him to put His hand upon him.
- Mark 7:37 And were beyond measure astonished, saying, He hath done all things well: He makes both the deaf <2974> to hear, & the dumb to speak.
- Mark 9:25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, He rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, *Thou* dumb and deaf <2974> spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.
- Mark 9:28,29 And when He was come into the house, His disciples asked Him privately, Why could not we cast him out? 29 And He said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
- Ezra 1:2 Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, The LORD God of heaven hath given me all the kingdoms of the earth; and He hath charged me to build Him an house at Jerusalem, which *is* in Judah.
- Ezra 9 Referred to that many priests sanctified not themselves until later.
- Luke 1:22 And when he came out, he could not speak unto them: and they perceived that he had seen a vision in the temple: for he beckoned unto them, and remained speechless <2974>.
- Luke 1:63,64 And he asked for a writing table, and wrote, saying, His name is John. And they marvelled all. 64 And his mouth was opened immediately, and his tongue *loosed*, and he spake, and praised God.
- Luke 7:22 Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf <2974> hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached.

- Luke 11:14 And He was casting out a devil, and it was dumb <2974>. And it came to pass, when the devil was gone out, the dumb <2974> spake; and the people wondered.
- Strongs #216 alalos *al'-al-os* AV-dumb 3; 1) speechless, dumb, wanting the faculty of speech.
- Exodus 4:11 And the LORD said unto him, Who hath made man's mouth? or Who maketh the <u>dumb</u>, or deaf, or the seeing, or the blind? have not I the LORD? Exodus 4:10,12 And Moses said unto the LORD, O my Lord, I *am* not eloquent, neither heretofore, nor since thou hast spoken unto thy servant: but I *am* slow of speech, and of a slow tongue. 12 Now therefore go, & I will be with thy mouth, & teach thee what thou shalt say.
- Psalms 38:13 But I, as a deaf *man*, heard not; and *I was* as a <u>dumb</u> man *that* openeth not his mouth.
- Psalms 39:2 I was <u>dumb</u> with silence, I held my peace, *even* from good; and my sorrow was stirred.
- Psalms 39:9 I was <u>dumb</u>, I opened not my mouth; because Thou didst *it*.
- Proverbs 31:8 Open thy mouth for the <u>dumb</u> in the cause of all such as are appointed to destruction. (Pray for the needy.)
- Isaiah 35:6 Then shall the lame *man* leap as an hart, and the tongue of the <u>dumb</u> sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert.
- Deuteronomy 8:15 Who led thee through that great and terrible wilderness, wherein were fiery serpents, and scorpions, and drought, where there was no water; who brought thee forth water out of the rock of flint;
- Isaiah 53:7 He was oppressed, and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth: He is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is <u>dumb</u>, so He openeth not His mouth.
- Isaiah 56:10,11 His watchmen *are* blind: they are all ignorant, they *are* all dumb dogs, they cannot bark; sleeping, lying down, loving to slumber. 11 Yea, they are greedy dogs which can never have enough, and they are shepherds that cannot understand: they all look to their own way, every one for his gain, from his quarter.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- Joel 3:9 Proclaim ye this among the Gentiles; Prepare war, wake up the mighty men, let all the men of war draw near; let them come up:
- Ezekiel 3:26 And I will make thy tongue cleave to the roof of thy mouth, that thou shalt be <u>dumb</u>, and shalt not be to them a reprover: for they *are* a rebellious house.
- Matthew 3:2 And (John Baptist) saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Ezekiel 24:27 In that day shall thy mouth be opened to him which is escaped, and thou shalt speak, and be no more <u>dumb</u>: and thou shalt be a sign unto them; and they shall know that I *am* the LORD.
- Ezekiel 33:22 Now the hand of the LORD was upon me in the evening, afore he that was escaped came; and had opened my mouth, until he came to me in the morning; and my mouth was opened, and I was no more <u>dumb</u>.
- Daniel 10:15 And when he had spoken such words unto me, I set my face toward the ground, and I became <u>dumb</u>.
- Habakkuk 2:18 What profiteth the graven image that the maker thereof hath graven it; the molten image, and a teacher of lies, that the maker of his work trusteth therein, to make <u>dumb</u> idols?
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Ezekiel 13:17-23 Likewise, thou son of man, set thy face against the daughters of thy people, which prophesy out of their own heart; and prophesy thou against them, 18 And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Woe to the women that sew pillows to all armholes, and make kerchiefs upon the head of every stature to hunt souls! Will ye hunt the souls of my people, and will ye save the souls alive that come unto you? 19 And will ye pollute me among my people for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, to slay the souls that should not die, and to save the souls alive that should not live, by your lying to my people that hear your lies? 20 Wherefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against your pillows, wherewith ye there hunt the souls to make them fly, and I will tear them from your arms, and will let the souls go, even the souls that ye hunt to make them fly. 21 Your kerchiefs also will I tear, and deliver my people out of your hand, and they shall be no more in your hand to be hunted; and ye shall know that I am the LORD. 22 Because with lies ye have made the heart of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad; and strengthened the hands of the wicked, that he should not return from his wicked way, by promising him life: 23 Therefore ye shall see no more vanity, nor divine divinations: for I will deliver my people out of your hand: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- Habakkuk 2:19 Woe unto him that saith to the wood, Awake; to the <u>dumb</u> stone, Arise, it shall teach! Behold, it *is* laid over with gold and silver, and *there is* no breath at all in the midst of it.
- Strongs #0483 'illem *il-lame'* AV-dumb 6; 1) mute, silent, dumb, unable to

- speak.
- Strongs #0481 'alam *aw-lam'* AV-dumb 7, put to silence 1, binding 1; 9 1) to bind 1a) (Niphal) 1a1) to be dumb 1a2) to be bound 1b) (Piel) binding (part.).
- Strongs #02795 cheresh *khay-rashe'* AV-deaf 9; 1) deaf.
- Strongs #01748 duwmam *doo-mawm'* AV-silent 1, quietly wait 1, dumb 1; 3 n m 1) silence adv 2) in silence, silently.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Prayer suggestions.
- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third & fourth *generation* of them that hate Me;
- Daniel 9:4-6 And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love Him, and to them that keep His commandments; 5 We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from Thy precepts and from Thy judgments: 6 Neither have we hearkened unto thy servants the prophets, which spake in thy name to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, and to all the people of the land.
- 1 Chronicles 21 Summarized of David numbering Israel & many people died because of his sin.
- Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but *rather* give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance *is* mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.
- Mark 3:27 No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- Luke 18 Referred to the persistant widow. V1 And He spake a parable unto them *to this end*, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;
- Mark 7:35 And straightway his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spake plain.
