- Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus cursing the religious hypocrites.
- Exodus 20 God gave laws for His people coming out of bondage in Egypt &

- expanded it in the following chapters.
- Matthew 14:14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and He healed their sick.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- John 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.
- 1 John 4:19 We love Him, because He first loved us.
- Luke 11:43 (AV) Woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye love the uppermost seats in the synagogues, and greetings in the markets.

- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. (miss-used) Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the
 - same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:

 Luke 11:52 (NKJV) Woe to you lawyers! For you have taken away the key of knowledge. You did not enter in yourselves, and those who were entering in you hindered.
- Matthew 27:17,20 Therefore when they were gathered together, Pilate said unto them, Whom will ye that I release unto you? Barabbas, or Jesus which is called Christ? 20 But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
- John 15:1 I am the true vine, and My Father is the husbandman.

- John 11:50 Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation perish not.
- Luke 11:54 (AV) Laying wait for Him, and seeking to catch something out of His mouth, that they might accuse Him.
- Luke 11:54 (NKJV) lying in wait for Him, and seeking to catch Him in something He might say, that they might accuse Him.
- Mark 7:13 Making the Word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- Luke 18:9-11 And He spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others: 10 Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican. 11 The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men *are*, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.
- Luke 11:29 And when the people were gathered thick together, He began to say, This is an evil generation: they seek a sign; and there shall no sign be given it, but the sign of Jonas the prophet.
- Luke 18:12 I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess.
- Matthew 6:17 But thou, when thou fastest, anoint thine head, and wash thy face;
- Luke 18:13 And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner.
