Leaven And Hypocrisy - Luke 12A

- John 3:1,2 There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews: 2 The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto Him, Rabbi, we know that Thou art a Teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that Thou doest, except God be with Him.
- John 19:38 And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave him leave. He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.
- Luke 12:1-12 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 12:1 (AV) In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, He began to say unto His disciples first of all, Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.
- Luke 12:1 (NKJV) In the meantime, when an innumerable multitude of people had gathered together, so that they trampled one another, He began to say to His disciples first *of all*, Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.
- Matthew 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.
- Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- Strongs #2219 zume *dzoo'-may* AV-leaven 13; 1) leaven 2) metaph. of inveterate mental and moral corruption, viewed in its tendency to infect others.
- Leaven is applied to that which, though small in quantity, yet by its influence thoroughly pervades a thing; either in a good sense as in the parable Mt 13:33; or in a bad sense, of a pernicious influence, "a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump".
- Exodus 12:19 Seven days shall there be no leaven found in your houses: for whosoever eateth that which is leavened, even that soul shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he be a stranger, or born in the land.
- Galatians 5:9 A little leaven leaveneth the whole lump.
- Strongs #5272 hupokrisis *hoop-ok'-ree-sis* AV-hypocrisy 5, dissimulation 1, condemnation 1; 7 1) an answering 2) an answer 3) the acting of a stage player 4) dissimulation, hypocrisy.

- John 11:49 And one of them, named Caiaphas, being the high priest that same year, said unto them, Ye know nothing at all,
- Luke 12:2 (AV) For there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; neither hid, that shall not be known.
- Luke 12:2 (NKJV) For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed, nor hidden that will not be known.
- Ezekiel 8 Summarized of God's Knothole Ezekiel seeing all the ungodly doings in the temple.
- Luke 12:3 (AV) Therefore whatsoever ye have spoken in darkness shall be heard in the light; and that which ye have spoken in the ear in closets shall be proclaimed upon the housetops.
- Luke 12:3 (NKJV) Therefore whatever you have spoken in the dark will be heard in the light, and what you have spoken in the ear in inner rooms will be proclaimed on the housetops.

- Strongs #1067 geenna gheh'-en-nah AV-hell 9, hell fire + 3588 + 4442 3; 12

 1) Hell is the place of the future punishment call "Gehenna" or "Gehenna of fire".
- Acts 5 Summarized of God dealing with Annanias & Saphira for lying to the Holy Spirit.
- Luke 16 Summarized of Lazarus & the Rich man. V24 And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Luke 12:6 (AV) Are not five sparrows sold for two farthings (penny), and not

- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Luke 12:8 (AV) Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess Me before men, him shall the Son of Man also confess before the angels of God:
- Luke 12:8 (NKJV) Also I say to you, whoever confesses Me before men, him the Son of Man also will confess before the angels of God.
- Luke 11:33 No man, when he hath lighted a candle, putteth it in a secret place, neither under a bushel, but on a candlestick, that they which come in may see the light.
- Matthew 5:14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.
- Luke 12:9 (AV) But he that denieth Me before men shall be denied before the angels of God.
- Luke 12:9 (NKJV) But he who denies Me before men will be denied before the angels of God.

Leaven of the Pharisees:

- Matthew 16:6 Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the <u>leaven of the Pharisees</u> and of the Sadducees.
- Matthew 16:11 How is it that ye do not understand that I spake *it* not to you concerning bread, that ye should beware of the <u>leaven</u> of <u>the Pharisees</u> and of the Sadducees?
- Matthew 16:8 Which when Jesus perceived, he said unto them, O ye of little faith, why reason ye among yourselves, because ye have brought no bread?
- Matthew 23:15 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.
- Mark 8:15 And he charged them, saying, Take heed, beware of the <u>leaven</u> of the <u>Pharisees</u>, and of the leaven of Herod.
- Luke 23:8,9 And when Herod saw Jesus, he was exceeding glad: for he was desirous to see Him of a long season, because he had heard many things of Him; and he hoped to have seen some miracle done by Him. 9 Then he questioned with Him in many words; but He answered him nothing.
- Luke 12:1 In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, He began to say unto His disciples first of all, Beware ye of the <u>leaven of the Pharisees</u>, which is hypocrisy.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
