

Life Is More Than Food - Luke 12C

Matthew 28:6 He is not here: for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.

John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

1 Samuel 7:3 And Samuel spake unto all the house of Israel, saying, If ye do return unto the LORD with all your hearts, then put away the strange gods and Ashtaroath from among you, and prepare your hearts unto the LORD, and serve Him only: and He will deliver you out of the hand of the Philistines.

Psalms 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.

Luke 6:12 And it came to pass in those days, that he went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God.

Luke 12:19,20 And I will say to my soul, Soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years; take thine ease, eat, drink, and be merry. **20** But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?

Matthew 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Luke 12:22-40 (AV) & (NKJV)

Luke 12:22 (AV) And He said unto His disciples, Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat; neither for the body, what ye shall put on.

Luke 12:22 (NKJV) Then He said to His disciples, Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat; nor about the body, what you will put on.

Matthew 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.

Luke 12:23 (AV) The life is more than meat, and the body *is more* than raiment.

Luke 12:23 (NKJV) Life is more than food, and the body *is more* than clothing.

John 6:15 When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take Him by force, to make Him a King, He departed again into a mountain Himself alone.

John 6:26 Jesus answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek Me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the

loaves, and were filled.

Luke 12:24 (AV) Consider the ravens: for they neither sow nor reap; which neither have storehouse nor barn; and God feedeth them: how much more are ye better than the fowls?

Luke 12:24 (NKJV) Consider the ravens, for they neither sow nor reap, which have neither storehouse nor barn; and God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds?

1 Kings 17:4,6 And it shall be, that thou shalt drink of the brook; and I have commanded the ravens to feed thee there. 6 And the ravens brought him bread and flesh in the morning, and bread and flesh in the evening; and he drank of the brook.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Luke 12:25 (AV) And which of you with taking thought can add to his stature one cubit?

Luke 12:25 (NKJV) And which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature?

Luke 12:26 (AV) If ye then be not able to do that thing which is least, why take ye thought for the rest?

Luke 12:26 (NKJV) If you then are not able to do *the* least, why are you anxious for the rest?

Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:

Exodus 14:12,13 Is not this the word that we did tell thee in Egypt, saying, Let us alone, that we may serve the Egyptians? For it had been better for us to serve the Egyptians, than that we should die in the wilderness. 13 And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which He will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever.

Exodus 14:19-21 And the Angel of God, which went before the camp of Israel, removed and went behind them; and the pillar of the cloud went from before their face, and stood behind them: 20 And it came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel; and it was a cloud and darkness to them, but it gave light by night to these: so that the one came not near the other all the night. 21 And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided.

Luke 12:27 (AV) Consider the lilies how they grow: they toil not, they spin not; and yet I say unto you, that Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.

Luke 12:27 (NKJV) Consider the lilies, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; and yet I say to you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.

Luke 12:28 (AV) If then God so clothe the grass, which is to day in the field,

and to morrow is cast into the oven; how much more *will He clothe* you, O ye of little faith?

Luke 12:28 (NKJV) If then God

so clothes the grass, which today is in the field and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, how much more *will He clothe* you, O you of little faith?

Deuteronomy 29:5 And I have led you 40 years in the wilderness: your clothes are not waxen old upon you, and thy shoe is not waxen old upon thy foot.

1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

Luke 12:29 (AV) And seek not ye what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink, neither be ye of doubtful mind.

Luke 12:29 (NKJV) And do not seek what you should eat or what you should drink, nor have an anxious mind.

Romans 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, & hearing by the Word of God.

2 Thessalonians 3:10 For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.

Luke 12:30 (AV) For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knoweth that ye have need of these things.

Luke 12:30 (NKJV) For all these things the nations of the world seek after, and your Father knows that you need these things.

Matthew 6:8 Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask Him.

Luke 18:3,5 And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary. 5 Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me.

Luke 12:31 (AV) But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Luke 12:31 (NKJV) But

seek the kingdom of God, and all these things shall be added to you.

Luke 12:32 (AV) Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

Luke 12:32 (NKJV) Do not fear,

little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.

Luke 12:33 (AV) Sell that ye have, and give alms; provide yourselves bags which wax not old, a treasure in the heavens that faileth not, where no thief approacheth, neither moth corrupteth.

Luke 12:33 (NKJV) Sell what you have and give alms; provide yourselves money bags which do not grow old, a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches nor moth destroys.

Mark 10 Summarized of the rich young ruler coming to Jesus. V20-22 And he answered and said unto him, Master, all these have I observed from my youth. 21 Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross,

and follow Me. 22 And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: for he had great possessions.

Acts 3:3 Who seeing Peter & John about to go into the temple asked an alms.

Matthew 6:24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other.

Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Luke 12:34 (AV) For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

Luke 12:34 (NKJV) For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Acts 8:1 And Saul was consenting unto his death. And at that time there was a great persecution against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered abroad throughout the regions of Judaea and Samaria, except the apostles.

Luke 12:35 (AV) Let your loins be girded about, and *your* lights burning;

Luke 12:35 (NKJV) Let your waist be girded and *your* lamps burning;

Exodus 12:11 And thus shall ye eat it; with your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it is the LORD'S passover.

Luke 12:36 (AV) And ye yourselves like unto men that wait for their lord, when he will return from the wedding; that when he cometh and knocketh, they may open unto him immediately.

Luke 12:36 (NKJV) and you yourselves be like men who wait for their master, when he will return from the wedding, that when he comes and knocks they may open to him immediately.

Matthew 25 Summarized of the 10 virgins V8,9 And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out. 9 But the wise answered, saying, Not so; lest there be not enough for us and you: but go ye rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves.

Luke 18:8 I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?

Luke 12:37 (AV) Blessed *are* those servants, whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching: verily I say unto you, that he shall gird himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them.

Luke 12:37 (NKJV) Blessed *are* those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down *to eat*, and will come and serve them.

Mark 13:32 But of that day and that hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father.

Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.

Luke 12:38 (AV) And if he shall come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find *them* so, blessed are those servants.

Luke 12:38 (NKJV) And if he should come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find *them* so, blessed are those servants.

Luke 12:39 (AV) And this know, that if the goodman of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched, and not have suffered his house to be broken through.

Luke 12:39 (NKJV) But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

Psalms 34:7 The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear Him, and delivereth them.

Hebrews 1:14 Are they (god's angels) not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

Luke 12:40 (AV) Be ye therefore ready also: for the Son of Man cometh at an hour when ye think not.

Luke 12:40 (NKJV) Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.

Luke 22:19 And He took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is My body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of Me.

1 Corinthians 11:24,25 And when He had given thanks, He brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is My body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of Me. 25 After the same manner also He took the cup, when He had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in My Blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of Me.

Matthew 12:40 For as Jonas was 3 days and 3 nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be 3 days and 3 nights in the heart of the earth.

Mark 16:9 Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, He appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom He had cast seven devils.

Summarized of Jesus crucifixion burial & resurrection.
