

## **Jesus Christ vs god kings - Luke 13D**

**The Fear of the Lord vs the fear of man.**

**Malachi 1:6 A son honoureth his father, and a servant his master: if then I be a Father, where is Mine honour? and if I be a Master, where is My fear (reverence)? saith the LORD of hosts unto you, O priests, that despise My Name. And ye say, Wherein have we despised Thy Name?**

**Luke 13:31-35 (AV) & (NKJV)**

**Luke 13:31 (AV) The same day there came certain of the Pharisees, saying unto Him, Get Thee out, and depart hence: for Herod will kill Thee.**

**Luke 13:31 (NKJV) On that very day some Pharisees came, saying to Him, Get out and depart from here, for Herod wants to kill You.**

**John 7:1 After these things Jesus walked in Galilee: for He would not walk in Jewry, because the Jews sought to kill Him.**

**Luke 13:32 (AV) And He said unto them, Go ye, and tell that fox, Behold, I cast out devils, and I do cures to day and to morrow, and the third *day* I shall be perfected.**

**Luke 13:32 (NKJV) And He said to them, Go, tell that fox, Behold, I cast out demons and perform cures today and tomorrow, and the third *day* I shall be perfected.**

**Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.**

**Luke 22:19 And He took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is My body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of Me.**

**Luke 13:33 (AV) Nevertheless I must walk to day, and to morrow, and the *day* following: for it cannot be that a prophet perish out of Jerusalem.**

**Luke 13:33 (NKJV) Nevertheless I must journey today, tomorrow, and the *day* following; for it cannot be that a prophet should perish outside of Jerusalem.**

**Luke 13:34 (AV) O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets, and stonest them that are sent unto thee; how often would I have gathered thy children together, as a hen *doth gather* her brood under *her* wings, and ye would not!**

**Luke 13:34 (NKJV) O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the one who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen *gathers* her brood under *her* wings, but you were not willing!**

**Luke 13:35 (AV) Behold, your house is left unto you desolate: and verily I say**

unto you, Ye shall not see Me, until *the time* come when ye shall say,  
Blessed *is* He that cometh in the Name of the Lord.

Luke 13:35 (NKJV) See! Your house is left to you desolate; and assuredly, I  
say to you, you shall not see Me until *the time* comes when you say,  
Blessed is He Who comes in the Name of the LORD!

1 Corinthians 15:4-7 And that He was buried, and that He rose again the third  
day according to the Scriptures: 5 And that He was seen of Cephas, then  
of the twelve: 6 After that, He was seen of above five hundred brethren at  
once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are  
fallen asleep. 7 After that, He was seen of James; then of all the apostles.

Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now  
commandeth all men every where to repent:

Revelation 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the  
Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,

Explained about the modern chinese ruler being considered the dragon god.

Luke 18:8 I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when  
the Son of Man cometh, shall He find faith on the earth?

1 Kings 19:1-18 (AV)

1 Kings 19:1-4 And Ahab told Jezebel all that Elijah had done, and withal how  
he had slain all the prophets with the sword. 2 Then Jezebel sent a  
messenger unto Elijah, saying, So let the gods do *to me*, and more also, if I  
make not thy life as the life of one of them by to morrow about this time. 3  
And when he saw *that*, he arose, and went for his life, and came to  
Beersheba, which *belongeth* to Judah, and left his servant there. 4 But he  
himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down  
under a juniper tree: and he requested for himself that he might die; and  
said, It is enough; now, O LORD, take away my life; for I *am* not better than  
my fathers.

1 Kings 18:38-40 Then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt  
sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the  
water that was in the trench. 39 And when all the people saw it, they fell  
on their faces: and they said, The LORD, He is The God; the LORD, He is  
The God. 40 And Elijah said unto them, Take the prophets of Baal; let not  
one of them escape. And they took them: and Elijah brought them down to  
the brook Kishon, and slew them there.

1 Kings 19:5-18 And as he lay and slept under a juniper tree, behold, then an  
angel touched him, and said unto him, Arise *and* eat. 6 And he looked, and,  
behold, *there was* a cake baken on the coals, and a cruse of water at his  
head. And he did eat and drink, and laid him down again. 7 And the angel  
of the LORD came again the second time, and touched him, and said, Arise  
*and* eat; because the journey *is* too great for thee. 8 And he arose, and did  
eat and drink, and went in the strength of that meat forty days and forty

nights unto Horeb the mount of God. 9 And he came thither unto a cave, and lodged there; and, behold, the word of the LORD *came* to him, and he said unto him, What doest thou here, Elijah? 10 And he said, I have been very jealous for the LORD God of hosts: for the children of Israel have forsaken thy covenant, thrown down thine altars, and slain thy prophets with the sword; and I, *even* I only, am left; and they seek my life, to take it away. 11 And he said, Go forth, and stand upon the mount before the LORD. And, behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind rent the mountains, and brake in pieces the rocks before the LORD; *but* the LORD *was* not in the wind: and after the wind an earthquake; *but* the LORD *was* not in the earthquake: 12 And after the earthquake a fire; *but* the LORD *was* not in the fire: and after the fire a still small voice. 13 And it was *so*, when Elijah heard *it*, that he wrapped his face in his mantle, and went out, and stood in the entering in of the cave. And, behold, *there came* a Voice unto him, and said, What doest thou here, Elijah? 14 And he said, I have been very jealous for the LORD God of hosts: because the children of Israel have forsaken Thy covenant, thrown down Thine altars, and slain Thy prophets with the sword; and I, *even* I only, am left; and they seek my life, to take it away. 15 And the LORD said unto him, Go, return on thy way to the wilderness of Damascus: and when thou comest, anoint Hazael *to be* king over Syria: 16 And Jehu the son of Nimshi shalt thou anoint *to be* king over Israel: and Elisha the son of Shaphat of Abelmeholah shalt thou anoint *to be* prophet in thy room. 17 And it shall come to pass, *that* him that escapeth the sword of Hazael shall Jehu slay: and him that escapeth from the sword of Jehu shall Elisha slay. 18 Yet I have left *Me* seven thousand in Israel, all the knees which have not bowed unto Baal, and every mouth which hath not kissed him.

**2 Kings 1** Referred to Elijah calling down fire from heaven.

**Daniel 6:10** Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.

**Daniel 3:16-18** Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we are not careful to answer thee in this matter. 17 If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. 18 But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

**Daniel 4:34** And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the Most High, and I praised and honoured Him that liveth for ever, Whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and His kingdom is from generation

to generation:

**Revelation 13:1-18 (AV)**

**Revelation 13:1-5** And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy. 2 And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as *the feet* of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority. 3 And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast. 4 And they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who *is* like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him? 5 And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty *and* two months.

**Matthew 18:18** Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

**Revelation 13:6** And he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme his name, and his tabernacle, and them that dwell in heaven.

**Referred to Christians persecuted & killed in North Korea for not worshipping their ruler god.**

**Revelation 13:7-18** And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations. 8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. 9 If any man have an ear, let him hear. 10 He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints. 11 And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon. 12 And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed. (god king scenario) 13 And he doeth great wonders, so that he maketh fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men, 14 And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by *the means of* those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live. 15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed. 16 And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in

their right hand, or in their foreheads: 17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. 18 Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number *is* Six hundred threescore *and* six.

**Acts 14:8-18 (AV)**

**Acts 14:8-17** And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked: 9 The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed, 10 Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked. 11 And when the people saw what Paul had done, they lifted up their voices, saying in the speech of Lycaonia, The gods are come down to us in the likeness of men. 12 And they called Barnabas, Jupiter; and Paul, Mercurius, because he was the chief speaker. 13 Then the priest of Jupiter, which was before their city, brought oxen and garlands unto the gates, and would have done sacrifice with the people. 14 *Which* when the apostles, Barnabas and Paul, heard *of*, they rent their clothes, and ran in among the people, crying out, 15 And saying, Sirs, why do ye these things? We also are men of like passions with you, and preach unto you that ye should turn from these vanities unto the Living God, which made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all things that are therein: 16 Who in times past suffered all nations to walk in their own ways. 17 Nevertheless He left not Himself without witness, in that He did good, and gave us rain from heaven, and fruitful seasons, filling our hearts with food and gladness.

**Deuteronomy 10:20** Thou shalt fear the LORD thy God; Him shalt thou serve, and to Him shalt thou cleave, and swear by His Name.

**Acts 14:18** And with these sayings scarce restrained they the people, that they had not done sacrifice unto them.

**Acts 12:20-25 (AV)**

**Acts 12:20-24** And Herod was highly displeased with them of Tyre and Sidon: but they came with one accord to him, and, having made Blastus the king's chamberlain their friend, desired peace; because their country was nourished by the king's *country*. 21 And upon a set day Herod, arrayed in royal apparel, sat upon his throne, and made an oration unto them. 22 And the people gave a shout, *saying*, *It is* the voice of a god, and not of a man. 23 And immediately the angel of the Lord smote him, because he gave not God the glory: and he was eaten of worms, and gave up the ghost. 24 But the Word of God grew and multiplied.

**Acts 5:10,11** Then fell she down straightway at his feet, and yielded up the ghost: and the young men came in, and found her dead, and, carrying her forth, buried her by her husband. (Ananias & Sapphira) 11 And great fear

came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things.

**Acts 12:25** And Barnabas and Saul returned from Jerusalem, when they had fulfilled *their* ministry, & took with them John, whose surname was Mark.

**Acts 19:13-18 (AV)** Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the Name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth. 14 And there were seven sons of one Sceva, a Jew, and chief of the priests, which did so. 15 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye? 16 And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded. 17 And this was known to all the Jews and Greeks also dwelling at Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the Name of the Lord Jesus was magnified. 18 And many that believed came, and confessed, and shewed their deeds.

**Matthew 14:29,30** And He said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus. 30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.

**Matthew 7:21-23** Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven. 22 Many will say to Me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Thy Name? and in Thy Name have cast out devils? and in Thy Name done many wonderful works? 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from Me, ye that work iniquity.

**Romans 12:2** And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

**Matthew 24:12** because iniquity shall abound the love of many shall wax cold

**Numbers 26:61** And Nadab and Abihu died, when they offered strange fire before the LORD.

**1 Peter 1:16** Because it is written, Be ye Holy; for I am Holy.

**1 John 3:3** And every man that hath this hope in Him purifieth himself, even as He is pure.

**Exodus 30:21** So they (priests) shall wash their hands and their feet, that they die not: and it shall be a statute for ever to them, even to him and to his seed throughout their generations.

**Romans 13:12** The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.
