Jesus Christ - The Greatest Healer - Luke 14A

- Luke 18 Referred to being like the persistant widow when praying. V1 And He spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;
- Luke 14:1-6 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 14:1 (AV) And it came to pass, as He went into the house of one of the chief Pharisees to eat bread on the Sabbath day, that they watched Him.
- Luke 14:1 (NKJV) Now it happened, as He went into the house of one of the rulers of the Pharisees to eat bread on the Sabbath, that they watched Him closely.
- Mark 12:13 And they send unto Him certain of the Pharisees and of the Herodians, to catch Him in His Words.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Luke 14:2 (AV) And, behold, there was a certain man before Him which had the dropsy.
- Luke 14:2 (NKJV) And behold, there was a certain man before Him who had dropsy.
- Strongs #5203 hudropikos *hoo-dro-pik-os*'1) dropsical, suffering from dropsy.
- ISBE DROPSY drop'-si (hudropikos, "a man afflicted with hudrops or dropsy"): Both forms of this disease occur in Palestine, that in which the limbs and body are distended with water called anasarca, depending generally on cardiac or renal disease, and the form confined to the abdomen, usually the result of liver infection. The latter is the commoner, as liver disease is a frequent result of recurrent attacks of malarial fever. The man was evidently able to move about, as he had entered into the Pharisee's house (Luke 14:2).
- Heart or kidney or liver disease causing water retention Anasarca Edema.
- Luke 14:3 (AV) And Jesus answering spake unto the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath day?
- Luke 14:3 (NKJV) And Jesus, answering, spoke to the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?
- Luke 9:47 And Jesus, perceiving the thought of their heart, took a child, and set him by Him,
- Mark 11:30-33 The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men? answer

- Me. 31 And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; He will say, Why then did ye not believe him? 32 But if we shall say, Of men; they feared the people: for all men counted John, that he was a prophet indeed. 33 And they answered and said unto Jesus, We cannot tell. And Jesus answering saith unto them, Neither do I tell you by what authority I do these things.
- Luke 14:4 (AV) And they held their peace. And He took *him*, and healed him, and let him go;
- Luke 14:4 (NKJV) But they kept silent. And He took *him* and healed him, and let him go.
- Mark 12:20-24 Now there were seven brethren: and the first took a wife, and dying left no seed. 21 And the second took her, and died, neither left he any seed: and the third likewise. 22 And the seven had her, and left no seed: last of all the woman died also. 23 In the resurrection therefore, when they shall rise, whose wife shall she be of them? for the seven had her to wife. 24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God. (miss-used) In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just praying for healing.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the Name of the Lord:
- Mark 7:26,29 The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought him that he would cast forth the devil out of her daughter. 29 And he said unto her, For this saying go thy way; the devil is gone out of thy daughter.
- Luke 14:5 (AV) And answered them, saying, Which of you shall have an ass or an ox fallen into a pit, and will not straightway pull him out on the Sabbath day?
- Luke 14:5 (NKJV) Then He answered them, saying, Which of you, having a donkey or an ox that has fallen into a pit, will not immediately pull him out on the Sabbath day?
- Exodus 23:4,5 (AV) 4 If thou meet thine enemy's ox or his ass going astray, thou shalt surely bring it back to him again. 5 If thou see the ass of him that hateth thee lying under his burden, and wouldest forbear to help

- him, thou shalt surely help with him.
- Exodus 23:5 (NKJV) If you see the donkey of one who hates you lying under its burden, and you would refrain from helping it, you shall surely help him with it.
- Luke 14:6 (AV) And they could not answer Him again to these things.
- Luke 14:6 (NKJV) And they could not answer Him regarding these things.
- Matthew 26:3,4 Then assembled together the chief priests, and the scribes, and the elders of the people, unto the palace of the high priest, who was called Caiaphas, 4 And consulted that they might take Jesus by subtilty, and kill him.
- Revelation 13 Referred to the antichrist & his workings in the end thmes.
- Matthew 4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.
- Luke 4 Referred to Jesus reading Isaiah 61 at the beginning of His ministry.
- Strongs #3554 nosos *nos'-os* AV-disease 6, sickness 5, infirmity 1; 12 1) disease, sickness.
- Strongs #3119 malakia *mal-ak-ee'-ah* AV-disease 3; 1) softness 2) in the NT infirmity, debility, bodily weakness, sickness.
- Matthew 4:24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them.
- Matthew 10:5-8 These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into any city of the Samaritans enter ye not: 6 But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. 7 And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. 8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
- Leviticus Referred to the unclean lepers & their treatment.
- Mark 5:2,6 And when He was come out of the ship, immediately there met Him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit, 6 But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped Him,
- Referred to many raised from the dead in Old & New Testaments.
- Luke 7:12-15 Now when he came nigh to the gate of the city, behold, there was a dead man carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow: and much people of the city was with her. 13 And when the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her, and said unto her, Weep not. 14 And He came and touched the bier: and they that bare him stood still. And He said, Young man, I say unto thee, Arise. 15 And he that was dead sat up,

and began to speak. And He delivered him to his mother.

Luke 17:12-15 And as He entered into a certain village, there met Him ten men that were lepers, which stood afar off: 13 And they lifted up their voices, and said, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us. 14 And when He saw them, He said unto them, Go shew yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed. 15 And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God,

Mark 1:40-45

- Mark 1:40 And there came a leper to Him, beseeching Him, and kneeling down to Him, and saying unto Him, If Thou wilt, Thou canst make me clean.
- Matthew 6:9,10 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy Name. 10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.
- Mark 9:22-24 And ofttimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if thou canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us. 23 Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth. 24 And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief.
- Luke 18:7 And shall not God avenge His own elect, which cry day and night unto Him, though He bear long with them?
- Mark 1:41 And Jesus, moved with compassion, put forth *His* hand, and touched him, and saith unto him, I will; be thou clean.
- Matthew 14:14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and He healed their sick.
- Mark 1:42 And as soon as He had spoken, immediately the leprosy departed from him, and he was cleansed.
- Mark 8:23-25 And He took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when He had spit on his eyes, and put His hands upon him, He asked him if he saw ought. 24 And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking. 25 After that He put His hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly.
- John 11:43-45 And when He thus had spoken, He cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth. 44 And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go. 45 Then many of the Jews which came to Mary, and had seen the things which Jesus did, believed on him.

- John 12:10 But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;
- Matthew 12:3,4 But He said unto them, Have ye not read what David did, when he was an hungred, and they that were with him; 4 How he entered into the house of God, and did eat the shewbread, which was not lawful for him to eat, neither for them which were with him, but only for the priests?
- Mark 1:43-45 And He straitly charged him, and forthwith sent him away; 44 And saith unto him, See thou say nothing to any man: but go thy way, shew thyself to the priest, and offer for thy cleansing those things which Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them. 45 But he went out, and began to publish it much, and to blaze abroad the matter, insomuch that Jesus could no more openly enter into the city, but was without in desert places: and they came to Him from every quarter.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the Name of the Lord:
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Ezra 9:7 Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great trespass unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day.
- Psalms 23:3 He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for His Name's sake.
