## **Invited To The Feast - Luke 14B**

- Referred to the final wedding feast of Jesus & His Bride the Church.
- Matthew 22:12 And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless.
- Luke 14:2,5 And, behold, there was a certain man before him which had the dropsy. 5 And answered them, saying, Which of you shall have an ass or an ox fallen into a pit, & will not straightway pull him out on the sabbath day? Luke 14:7-24 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 14:7 (AV) And He put forth a parable to those which were bidden, when He marked how they chose out the chief rooms; saying unto them,
- Luke 14:7 (NKJV) So He told a parable to those who were invited, when He noted how they chose the best places, saying to them:
- Luke 15:9 And when she hath found it, she calleth her friends and her neighbours together, saying, Rejoice with me; for I have found the piece which I had lost.
- Matthew 23:3 All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do; but do not ye after their works: for they say, and do not.
- Luke 14:8 (AV) When thou art bidden of any *man* to a wedding, sit not down in the highest room; lest a more honourable man than thou be bidden of him;
- Luke 14:8 (NKJV) When you are invited by anyone to a wedding feast, do not sit down in the best place, lest one more honorable than you be invited by him;
- Luke 14:9 (AV) And he that bade thee and him come and say to thee, Give this man place; and thou begin with shame to take the lowest room.
- Luke 14:9 (NKJV) and he who invited you and him come and say to you, Give place to this man, & then you begin with shame to take the lowest place.
- Luke 14:10 (AV) But when thou art bidden, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that bade thee cometh, he may say unto thee, Friend, go up higher: then shalt thou have worship in the presence of them that sit at meat with thee.

  Luke 14:10 (NKJV) But when you are invited, go and sit down in the lowest place, so that when he
  - who invited you comes he may say to you, Friend, go up higher. Then you will have glory in the presence of those who sit at the table with you.
- Esther 6 Referred to Haman thinking he'd be honoured but the King had Mordecai honoured by Haman.
- Luke 14:11 (AV) For whosoever exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- Luke 14:11 (NKJV) For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.
- Mark 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

- Summarized modern word faith errors miss-using the Scriptures.
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God. (Miss-used)
- Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the Scriptures,
- **Proverbs 25:6,7 (AV) & (NKJV)**
- Proverbs 25:6 (AV) Put not forth thyself in the presence of the king, and stand not in the place of great *men*:
- Proverbs 25:6 (NKJV) Do not exalt yourself in the presence of the king, And do not stand in the place of the great;
- Luke 14:10 (AV) But when thou art bidden, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that bade thee cometh, he may say unto thee, Friend, go up higher: then shalt thou have worship in the presence of them that sit at meat with thee.
- Proverbs 25:7 (AV) For better *it is* that it be said unto thee, Come up hither; than that thou shouldest be put lower in the presence of the prince whom thine eyes have seen.

  Proverbs 25:7 (NKJV) For *it is* better that he say to you, Come up here, Than that you should be put lower in the presence of the prince, Whom your eyes have seen.
- Luke 14:12 (AV) Then said He also to him that bade Him, When thou makest a dinner or a supper, call not thy friends, nor thy brethren, neither thy kinsmen, nor *thy* rich neighbours; lest they also bid thee again, and a recompence be made thee.
- Luke 14:12 (NKJV) Then He also said to him who invited Him, When you give a dinner or a supper, do not ask your friends, your brothers, your relatives, nor rich neighbors, lest they also invite you back, and you be repaid.
- Luke 14:13 (AV) But when thou makest a feast, call the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind:

  Luke 14:13 (NKJV) But when you give a feast, invite *the* poor, *the* maimed, *the* lame, *the* blind.
- Mark 10:46 And they came to Jericho: and as He went out of Jericho with His disciples and a great number of people, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the highway side begging.
- Luke 14:14 (AV) And thou shalt be blessed; for they cannot recompense thee: for thou shalt be recompensed at the resurrection of the just.
- Luke 14:14 (NKJV) And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you; for you shall be repaid at the resurrection of the just.
- Luke 14:15 (AV) And when one of them that sat at meat with Him heard these things, he said unto Him, Blessed *is* he that shall eat bread in the kingdom of God.

  Luke 14:15 (NKJV) Now
  - when one of those who sat at the table with Him heard these things, he said to Him, Blessed *is* he who shall eat bread in the kingdom of God!
- Luke 14:16 (AV) Then said He unto him, A certain man made a great supper, and bade many:

  Luke 14:16 (NKJV) Then

- He said to him, A certain man gave a great supper and invited many,
- Luke 14:17 (AV) And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come; for all things are now ready.
- Luke 14:17 (NKJV) and sent his servant at supper time to say to those who were invited, Come, for all things are now ready.
- Esther 6:14 And while they were yet talking with him, came the king's chamberlains, and hasted to bring Haman unto the banquet that Esther had prepared.
- Luke 14:18 (AV) And they all with one *consent* began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused.
- Luke 14:18 (NKJV) But they all with one *accord* began to make excuses. The first said to him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must go and see it. I ask you to have me excused.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- 1 Samuel 15:22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.
- **Exodus 20:16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.**
- John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- Luke 14:19 (AV) And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused.
- Luke 14:19 (NKJV) And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I am going to test them. I ask you to have me excused.
- Luke 14:20 (AV) And another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.

  Luke 14:20 (NKJV) Still another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.
- Luke 14:21 (AV) So that servant came, and shewed his lord these things. Then the master of the house being angry said to his servant, Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in hither the poor, and the maimed, and the halt, and the blind.
- Luke 14:21 (NKJV) So that servant came and reported these things to his master. Then the master of the house, being angry, said to his servant, Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in here *the* poor and *the* maimed and *the* lame and *the* blind.
- Luke 14:22 (AV) And the servant said, Lord, it is done as thou hast commanded, and yet there is room.

  Luke 14:22 (NKJV) And the servant said, Master, it is done as you commanded, and still there is room.
- Matthew 7:21,23 Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter

- into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven. 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from Me, ye that work iniquity.
- Luke 14:23 (AV) And the lord said unto the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel *them* to come in, that my house may be filled.
- Luke 14:23 (NKJV) Then the master said to the servant, Go out into the highways & hedges, and compel *them* to come in, that my house may be filled.
- Romans 15:16 That I should be the minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the Holy Ghost.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Luke 14:24 (AV) For I say unto you, That none of those men which were bidden shall taste of my supper.
- Luke 14:24 (NKJV) For I say to you that none of those men who were invited shall taste my supper.
- Luke 8:35-39 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid. 36 They also which saw it told them by what means he that was possessed of the devils was healed. 37 Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought Him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and He went up into the ship, and returned back again. 38 Now the man out of whom the devils were departed besought Him that he might be with Him: but Jesus sent him away, saying, 39 Return to thine own house, and shew how great things God hath done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things Jesus had done unto him.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Acts 28:3,5 And when Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks, and laid them on the fire, there came a viper out of the heat, and fastened on his hand. 5 And he shook off the beast into the fire, and felt no harm.
- Matthew 22:1-14 And Jesus answered and spake unto them again by parables, and said, 2 The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son, 3 And sent forth his servants to call them that were bidden to the wedding: and they would not come. 4 Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, Tell them which are bidden, Behold, I have prepared my dinner: my oxen and my fatlings are killed, and all things are ready: come unto the marriage. 5 But they made light of it, and

went their ways, one to his farm, another to his merchandise: 6 And the remnant took his servants (prophets), and entreated *them* spitefully, and slew *them*. 7 But when the king heard *thereof*, he was wroth: and he sent forth his armies, and destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city. 8 Then saith he to his servants, The wedding is ready, but they which were bidden were not worthy. 9 Go ye therefore into the highways, and as many as ye shall find, bid to the marriage. 10 So those servants went out into the highways, and gathered together all as many as they found, both bad and good: and the wedding was furnished with guests. 11 And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment: 12 And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless. 13 Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast *him* into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. 14 For many are called, but few *are* chosen.

- John 7:1 After these things Jesus walked in Galilee: for He would not walk in Jewry, because the Jews sought to kill Him.
- John 6:66-68 From that time many of His disciples went back, and walked no more with Him. 67 Then said Jesus unto the twelve, Will ye also go away? 68 Then Simon Peter answered Him, Lord, to whom shall we go? Thou hast the Words of eternal life.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- John 4:10 Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and Who it is that saith to thee, Give Me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of Him, and He would have given thee living water.
- Exodus 15:23,25 And when they came to Marah, they could not drink of the waters of Marah, for they were bitter: therefore the name of it was called Marah. 25 And he cried unto the LORD; and the LORD shewed him a tree, which when he had cast into the waters, the waters were made sweet: there He made for them a statute and an ordinance, and there He proved them,

Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.

Matthew 7:13,14 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: 14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
