## How Much Do You Value Jesus Christ - Luke 14C

- Luke 18:8 I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of Man cometh, shall He find faith on the earth?
- Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- Luke 14:17 And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come; for all things are now ready.
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.
- Luke 14:25-35 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 14:25 (AV) And there went great multitudes with Him: and He turned, and said unto them,
- Luke 14:25 (NKJV) Now great multitudes went with Him. And He turned and said to them,
- John 6:26 Jesus answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled.
- Luke 14:26 (AV) If any *man* come to Me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple.
- Luke 14:26 (NKJV) If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Strongs #3404 miseo *mis-eh'-o* AV-hate 41, hateful 1; 42 1) to hate, pursue with hatred, detest 2) to be hated, detested.
- Matthew 6:24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
- Summarized of modern persecuted Christians.
- Referred to Daniel & his friends persecuted.
- Daniel 3:16-18 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we are not careful to answer thee in this matter. 17 If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from

- the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. 18 But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.
- Acts 21:11,13 And when he was come unto us, he took Paul's girdle, and bound his own hands and feet, and said, Thus saith the Holy Ghost, So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man that owneth this girdle, and shall deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles. 13 Then Paul answered, What mean ye to weep and to break mine heart? for I am ready not to be bound only, but also to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus.
- Luke 16:23 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.
- Luke 14:27 (AV) And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after Me, cannot be My disciple.
- Luke 14:27 (NKJV) And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple.
- Strongs #941 bastazo *bas-tad'-zo* AV-bear 23, carry 3, take up 1; 27 1) to take up with the hands 2) to take up in order to carry or bear, to put upon one's self (something) to be carried 2a) to bear what is burdensome 3) to bear, to carry 3a) to carry on one's person 3b) to sustain, i.e. uphold, support 4) to bear away, carry off.
- Ephesians 4:28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.
- Matthew 15:8 This people draweth nigh unto Me with their mouth, and honoureth Me with their lips; but their heart is far from Me.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Summarizedof many bad names the religious leaders called Jesus.
- John 7:1 After these things Jesus walked in Galilee: for he would not walk in Jewry, because the Jews sought to kill him.
- Referred to Jesus cleaning out the temple twice.
- Mark 11:15-18 And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves; 16 And would not suffer that any man should carry any vessel through the temple. 17 And He taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves. 18 And the scribes and chief priests heard it, and sought how they might destroy Him: for they feared Him,

- because all the people was astonished at His doctrine.
- Summarized of Salvation by Jesus & the persecutions He went through on His way to the cross.
- Luke 14:28 (AV) For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have *sufficient* to finish *it*?
- Luke 14:28 (NKJV) For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and count the cost, whether he has *enough* to finish *it*?
- Matthew 7:24-27 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of Mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a Rock: 25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a Rock. 26 And every one that heareth these sayings of Mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: 27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.
- 1 Corinthians 10:4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Romans 2:21 Thou therefore which teachest another, teachest thou not thyself? thou that preachest a man should not steal, dost thou steal?
- Luke 14:29 (AV) Lest haply, after he hath laid the foundation, and is not able to finish *it*, all that behold *it* begin to mock him,
- Luke 14:29 (NKJV) lest, after he has laid the foundation, and is not able to finish, all who see *it* begin to mock him,
- Romans 13:12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. 12 For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth

- drive them out from before thee. 13 Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God. 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- Acts 19:18,19 And many that believed came, and confessed, and shewed their deeds. 19 Many of them also which used curious arts brought their books together, and burned them before all men: and they counted the price of them, and found it fifty thousand pieces of silver.
- Exodus 32 Summarized of Moses with God & Aaron making the golden calf & Moses' interceeding for them.
- Luke 14:30 (AV) Saying, This man began to build, and was not able to finish.
- Luke 14:30 (NKJV) saying, This man began to build and was not able to finish?
- Luke 8:11-14 Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God. 12

  Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the Word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. 13 They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the Word with joy; and these have no root, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away. 14 And that which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Psalms 23:3 He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for His Name's sake.
- Genesis 3:4-6 And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: 5 For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. 6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.
- Luke 14:31 (AV) Or what king, going to make war against another king, sitteth not down first, and consulteth whether he be able with ten thousand to meet him that cometh against him with twenty thousand?
- Luke 14:31 (NKJV) Or what king, going to make war against another king, does not sit down first and consider whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with twenty thousand?

- Luke 14:32 (AV) Or else, while the other is yet a great way off, he sendeth an ambassage, and desireth conditions of peace.
- Luke 14:32 (NKJV) Or else, while the other is still a great way off, he sends a delegation and asks conditions of peace.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Ephesians 6:11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.
- Ephesians 6:13-17 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; 15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God:
- Luke 14:33 (AV) So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be My disciple.
- Luke 14:33 (NKJV) So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has cannot be My disciple.
- Mark 10:17-22 And when He was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to Him, and asked Him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life? 18 And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou Me good? there is none good but one, that is, God. 19 Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother. 20 And he answered and said unto Him, Master, all these have I observed from my youth. 21 Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow Me. 22 And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: for he had great possessions.

Summarized of Jesus leaving heaven to live on earth to die for mankind. Luke 14:34 (AV) Salt *is* good: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be seasoned?

- Romans 12:1,2 (AV) & (NKJV)

- Romans 12:1 (NKJV) I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, Holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. (basic service)
- Romans 12:2 (AV) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Romans 12:2 (NKJV) And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
