- Matthew 11:28 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

- Luke 15:15 (AV) And he went and joined himself to a citizen of that country; and he sent him into his fields to feed swine.
- Luke 15:15 (NKJV) Then he went and joined himself to a citizen of that country, and he sent him into his fields to feed swine.
- Luke 15:16 (AV) And he would fain have filled his belly with the husks that the swine did eat: and no man gave unto him.
- Luke 15:16 (NKJV) And he would gladly have filled his stomach with the pods

- that the swine ate, and no one gave him anything.
- Job 2:9,10 Then said his wife unto him, Dost thou still retain thine integrity? curse God, and die. 10 But he said unto her, Thou speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. - Luke 15:20 (AV) And he arose, and came to his father. But when he was yet a great way off, his father saw him, and had compassion, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him.

  Luke 15:20 (NKJV) And he arose and came to his father. But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him & had compassion, & ran & fell on his neck & kissed him.
- Ephesians 4:28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.
- Strongs #4697 splagchnizomai *splangkh-nid'-zom-ahee* AV-have compassion 7, be moved with compassion 5; 12 1) to be moved as to one's bowels, hence to be moved with compassion, have compassion (for the bowels were thought to be the seat of love and pity).
- Romans 3:25 Whom God hath set forth to be a Propitiation through faith in His Blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;
- Hebrews 10:17 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.
- Micah 7:19 He will turn again, He will have compassion upon us; He will subdue our iniquities; and Thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea.
- Luke 15:21 (AV) And the son said unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and in thy sight, and am no more worthy to be called thy son.
- Luke 15:21 (NKJV) And the son said to him, Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight, and am no longer worthy to be called your son.
- Proverbs 13:20 He that walketh with wise men shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.
- Matthew 7:13,14 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: 14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

- Luke 15:26 (AV) And he called one of the servants, and asked what these things meant.

  Luke 15:26 (NKJV) So he called one of the servants and asked what these things meant.
- Luke 15:27 (AV) And he said unto him, Thy brother is come; and thy father hath killed the fatted calf, because he hath received him safe and sound.
- Luke 15:27 (NKJV) And he said to him, Your brother has come, and because he has received him safe and sound, your father has killed the fatted calf.
- Genesis 4:5,8 But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell. 8 And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.
- Luke 15:28 (AV) And he was angry, and would not go in: therefore came his father out, and intreated him.

- Luke 15:29 (AV) And he answering said to *his* father, Lo, these many years do I serve thee, neither transgressed I at any time thy commandment: and yet thou never gavest me a kid, that I might make merry with my friends:
- Luke 15:29 (NKJV) So he answered and said to *his* father, Lo, these many years I have been serving you; I never transgressed your commandment at any time; and yet you never gave me a young goat, that I might make merry with my friends.
- Luke 15:30 (AV) But as soon as this thy son was come, which hath devoured thy living with harlots, thou hast killed for him the fatted calf.
- Luke 15:30 (NKJV) But as soon as this son of yours came, who has devoured your livelihood with harlots, you killed the fatted calf for him.
- Genesis 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.
- Genesis 3 Summarized of the fall of mankind.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Luke 15:31 (AV) And he said unto him, Son, thou art ever with me, and all that I have is thine.

  Luke 15:31 (NKJV) And he said to him, Son, you are always with me, and all that I have is yours.

- Luke 15:7 I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repents, more than over 99 just persons, which need no repentance.

## **More Service Notes:**

- Luke 10:33 But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion *on him*,
- Matthew 9:36 But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with <u>compassion</u> on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.
- Matthew 14:14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with <u>compassion</u> toward them, and He healed their sick.
- Matthew 15:32 Then Jesus called His disciples *unto Him*, and said, I have <u>compassion</u> on the multitude, because they continue with Me now three days, and have nothing to eat: and I will not send them away fasting, lest they faint in the way.

- Matthew 18:27 Then the lord of that servant was moved with <u>compassion</u>, and loosed him, and forgave him the debt.
- Matthew 18:33 Shouldest not thou also have had <u>compassion</u> on thy fellowservant, even as I had pity on thee?
- Matthew 20:34 So Jesus had <u>compassion</u> on them, and touched their eyes: and immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed Him.
- Mark 1:41 And Jesus, moved with <u>compassion</u>, put forth *His* hand, and touched him, and saith unto him, I will; be thou clean.
- Mark 5:19 Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but saith unto him, Go home to thy friends, and tell them how great things the Lord hath done for thee, and hath had <u>compassion</u> on thee.
- Mark 6:34 And Jesus, when He came out, saw much people, and was moved with <u>compassion</u> toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and he began to teach them many things.
- Mark 8:2 I have <u>compassion</u> on the multitude, because they have now been with Me three days, and have nothing to eat:
- Mark 9:22 And ofttimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if Thou canst do any thing, have <u>compassion</u> on us, and help us.
- Luke 7:13 And when the Lord saw her, He had <u>compassion</u> on her, and said unto her, Weep not.
- Luke 15:20 And he arose, and came to his father. But when he was yet a great way off, his father saw him, and had <u>compassion</u>, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him.
- Romans 9:15 For he saith to Moses, I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have <u>compassion</u> on whom I will have <u>compassion</u>.
- Hebrews 5:2 Who can have <u>compassion</u> on the ignorant, and on them that are out of the way; for that he himself also is compassed with infirmity.
- Hebrews 10:34 For ye had <u>compassion</u> of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance.
- 1 Peter 3:8 Finally, *be ye* all of one mind, having <u>compassion</u> one of another, love as brethren, *be* pitiful, *be* courteous:
- 1 John 3:17 But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels *of <u>compassion</u>* from him, how dwelleth the love of God in him?
- Jude 1:22 And of some have <u>compassion</u>, making a difference:
