- 2 Kings 2:11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that,

- behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.
- Genesis 5:24 And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him.
- Luke 16:23 (AV) And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.
- Luke 16:23 (NKJV) And being in torments in Hades, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.
- Numbers 14:11,22,23 And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke me? and how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them? 22 Because all those men which have seen My glory, and My miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted Me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to My voice; 23 Surely they shall not see the land which I sware unto their fathers, neither shall any of them that provoked Me see it:
- Strongs #86 hades *hah'-dace* AV-hell 10, grave 1; 11 1) name Hades or Pluto, the god of the lower regions 2) Orcus, the nether world, the realm of the dead 3) later use of this word: the grave, death, hell.
- In Biblical Greek it is associated with Orcus, the infernal regions, a dark and dismal place in the very depths of the earth, the common receptacle of disembodied spirits. Usually Hades is just the abode of the wicked, Lu 16:23; Re 20:13,14; a very uncomfortable place. TDNT.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- Luke 16:24 (AV) And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.
- Luke 16:24 (NKJV) Then he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.
- Isaiah 29:13 Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near Me with their mouth, and with their lips do honour Me, but have removed their heart far from Me, and their fear toward Me is taught by the precept of men:

- Luke 16:26 (AV) And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that *would come* from thence.
- Luke 16:26 (NKJV) And besides all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed, so that those who want to pass from here to you cannot, nor can those from there pass to us.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Luke 16:27 (AV) Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house:
- Luke 16:27 (NKJV) Then he said, I beg you therefore, father, that you would send him to my father's house,
- Luke 16:28 (AV) For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment.
- Luke 16:28 (NKJV) for I have five brothers, that he may testify to them, lest they also come to this place of torment.
- Referred to the 5 books of Moses.
- Summarized of Jonah. Jonah 2:9 But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that that I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD. Referred to many Prophets saying "Repent".
- Luke 16:29 (AV) Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.
- Luke 16:29 (NKJV) Abraham said to him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Luke 16:30 (AV) And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent.
- Luke 16:30 (NKJV) And he said, No, father Abraham; but if one goes to them from the dead, they will repent.
- Referred to Jesus cleaning out the temple twice.
- Mark 11:15-17 And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves; 16 And would not suffer that any man should carry any vessel

- through the temple. 17 And he taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Romans 13:12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

- Luke 16:31 (AV) And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.
- Luke 16:31 (NKJV) But he said to him, If they do not hear Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded though one rise from the dead.
- James 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.
- 1 Corinthians 15:4-6 And that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures: 5 And that He was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve: 6 After that, He was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.
- Matthew 11:23 And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to hell <86>: for if the mighty works, which have been done in thee, had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.
- Matthew 16:18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter(small rock, pebble), and upon this Rock (Jesus) I will build My church; and the gates of hell <86> shall not prevail against it.
- Luke 10:15 And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted to heaven, shalt be thrust down to hell <86>.
- Luke 16:23 And in hell <86> he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.
- Acts 2:27 Because Thou wilt not leave My soul in hell <86>, neither wilt Thou suffer Thine Holy One to see corruption.
- John 12:27 Now is My soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save Me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour.
- Acts 2:31 He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that His

- soul was not left in hell <86>, neither His flesh did see corruption.
- 1 Corinthians 15:55 O death, where *is* thy sting? O grave <86>, where *is* thy victory?
- Revelation 1:18 *I am* He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell <86> and of death.
- Revelation 6:8 And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell <86> followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.
- Revelation 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell <86> delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.
- Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God. Revelation 20:14 And death and hell <86> were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.
- Luke 23:43 And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with Me in <u>paradise</u>.
- Luke 23:42 And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom.
- Luke 23:46 And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.
- 2 Corinthians 12:4 How that he (John the Apostle) was caught up into <u>paradise</u>, and heard unspeakable Words, which it is not lawful for a man to utter.
- Revelation 1:1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto Him, to shew unto His servants things which must shortly come to pass; and He sent and signified it by His angel unto His servant John:
- Revelation 2:7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the <u>paradise</u> of God.
- Strongs #3857 paradeisos par-ad'-i-sos AV-paradise 3; 1) among the Persians a grand enclosure or preserve, hunting ground, park, shady and well watered, in which wild animals, were kept for the hunt; it was enclosed by walls and furnished with towers for the hunters 2) a garden, pleasure ground 2a) grove, park 3) the part of Hades which was thought by the later Jews to be the abode of the souls of pious until the resurrection: but some understand this to be a heavenly paradise 4) the upper regions of the heavens. According to the early church Fathers, the paradise in which our first parents dwelt before the fall still exists, neither on the earth or in the heavens, but above and beyond the world 5) heaven.

- Hebrews 3:15 While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation.
- Matthew 5:10 Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- Revelation 2:10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.
- Matthew 5:12 Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.
- Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
