- Genesis 3 Referred to the fall of mankind.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Mark 4:19 And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the Word, and it becometh unfruitful.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Luke 18:18-43 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 18:18 (AV) And a certain ruler asked Him, saying, Good Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?
- Luke 18:18 (NKJV) Now a certain ruler asked Him, saying, Good Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?
- Luke 18:38 (AV) And he cried, saying, Jesus, *Thou* Son of David, have mercy on me.
- Luke 18:19 (AV) And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou Me good? none *is* good, save one, *that is*, God.
- Luke 18:19 (NKJV) So Jesus said to him, Why do you call Me good? No one *is* good but One, *that is*, God.
- Ephesians 2:5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)
- Luke 18:20 (AV) Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother.
- Luke 18:20 (NKJV) You know the commandments: Do not commit adultery, Do not murder, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honor your father and your mother.
- Exodus 20 Referred to the second half of the 10 Commandments dealing with relationships with people.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;

- John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.

- Luke 18:22 (AV) Now when Jesus heard these things, He said unto him, Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, follow Me.
- Luke 18:22 (NKJV) So when Jesus heard these things, He said to him, You still lack one thing. Sell all that you have and distribute to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me.
- Exodus 20:17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- Matthew 6:20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

- Mark 4:19 And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the Word, and it becometh unfruitful.
- Luke 18:24 (AV) And when Jesus saw that he was very sorrowful, He said, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God!
- Luke 18:24 (NKJV) And when Jesus saw that he became very sorrowful, He said, How hard it is for those who have riches to enter the kingdom of God!
- 2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, Who is the Image of God, should shine unto them.
- Luke 18:25 (AV) For it is easier for a camel to go through a needle's eye, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.
- Luke 18:25 (NKJV) For it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God.

Explained the "Eye of the Needle" gate.

Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.

- Referred to the 10 Commandments Exodus 20 & the Biatitudes Matthew 5.
- Luke 18:28 (AV) Then Peter said, Lo, we have left all, and followed Thee.
- Luke 18:28 (NKJV) Then Peter said, See, we have left all and followed You.
- Luke 18:29 (AV) And He said unto them, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or parents, or brethren, or wife, or children, for the kingdom of God's sake,
- Luke 18:29 (NKJV) So He said to them, Assuredly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or parents or brothers or wife or children, for the sake of the kingdom of God,
- Luke 18:30 (AV) Who shall not receive manifold more in this present time, and in the world to come life everlasting.
- Luke 18:30 (NKJV) who shall not receive many times more in this present time, and in the age to come eternal life.

- Psalms 22 & Isaiah 53 Referred to some prophesies of Jesus' sufferings.
- Luke 18:32 (AV) For He shall be delivered unto the Gentiles, and shall be mocked, and spitefully entreated, and spitted on:
- Luke 18:32 (NKJV) For He will be delivered to the Gentiles and will be mocked and insulted and spit upon.
- Mark 8:31-33 And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and of the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again. 32 And he spake that saying openly. And Peter took him, and began to rebuke him. 33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.

- Luke 18:33 (AV) And they shall scourge *Him*, and put Him to death: and the third day He shall rise again.
- Luke 18:33 (NKJV) They will scourge *Him* and kill Him. And the third day He will rise again.
- Matthew 12:40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.
- Mark 16:9 Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, He appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils. Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Luke 18:34 (AV) And they understood none of these things: and this saying was hid from them, neither knew they the things which were spoken.
- Luke 18:34 (NKJV) But they understood none of these things; this saying was hidden from them, and they did not know the things which were spoken.
- Luke 18:35 (AV) And it came to pass, that as He was come nigh unto Jericho, a certain blind man sat by the way side begging:
- Luke 18:35 (NKJV) Then it happened, as He was coming near Jericho, that a certain blind man sat by the road begging.
- Luke 18:36 (AV) And hearing the multitude pass by, he asked what it meant.
- Luke 18:36 (NKJV) And hearing a multitude passing by, he asked what it meant.
- Luke 18:37 (AV) And they told him, that Jesus of Nazareth passeth by.
- Luke 18:37 (NKJV) So they told him that Jesus of Nazareth was passing by.
- Luke 18:38 (AV) And he cried, saying, Jesus, *Thou* Son of David, have mercy on me.
- Luke 18:38 (NKJV) And he cried out, saying, Jesus, Son of David, (Messiah) have mercy on me!
- **Explained God's Mercy vs God's Grace.**
- Luke 10:31,32 And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. 32 And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side.
- Luke 18:39 (AV) And they which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace: but he cried so much the more, *Thou* Son of David, have mercy on me.
- Luke 18:39 (NKJV) Then those who went before warned him that he should be quiet; but he cried out all the more, Son of David, have mercy on me! Mark 7:26,29 The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she

- besought Him that He would cast forth the devil out of her daughter. 29 And He said unto her, For this saying go thy way; the devil is gone out of thy daughter.
- Luke 18:40 (AV) And Jesus stood, and commanded him to be brought unto Him: and when he was come near, He asked him,
- Luke 18:40 (NKJV) So Jesus stood still and commanded him to be brought to Him. And when he had come near, He asked him,
- Mark 10:49,50 And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; He calleth thee. 50 And he, casting away his garment, rose, and came to Jesus.
- Luke 18:41 (AV) Saying, What wilt thou that I shall do unto thee? And he said, Lord, that I may receive my sight.
- Luke 18:41 (NKJV) saying, What do you want Me to do for you? He said, Lord, that I may receive my sight.
- Luke 18:42 (AV) And Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee.
- Luke 18:42 (NKJV) Then Jesus said to him, Receive your sight; your faith has made you well.
- John 11:43 And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.
- Luke 18:43 (AV) And immediately he received his sight, and followed Him, glorifying God: and all the people, when they saw *it*, gave praise unto God.
- Luke 18:43 (NKJV) And immediately he received his sight, and followed Him, glorifying God. And all the people, when they saw *it*, gave praise to God.
- Luke 7:22 Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
