## **Jesus Christ Changes Lives - Luke 19A**

- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Luke 18 Referred to the Pharisee vs the Publican.
- Matthew 9:9 And as Jesus passed forth from thence, He saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and He saith unto him, Follow Me. And he arose, and followed Him.
- Ezekiel 11:19 & 36:26 And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh:

  Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Luke 19:1-27 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 19:1 (AV) And Jesus entered and passed through Jericho.
- Luke 19:1 (NKJV) Then *Jesus* entered and passed through Jericho.
- Luke 18:39-43 And they which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace: but he cried so much the more, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. 40 And Jesus stood, and commanded him to be brought unto Him: and when he was come near, He asked him, 41 Saying, What wilt thou that I shall do unto thee? And he said, Lord, that I may receive my sight. 42 And Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee. 43 And immediately he received his sight, and followed Him, glorifying God: and all the people, when they saw it, gave praise unto God.
- Luke 18:1 And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;
- Luke 19:2 (AV) And, behold, *there was* a man named Zacchaeus, which was the chief among the publicans, and he was rich.
- Luke 19:2 (NKJV) Now behold, *there was* a man named Zacchaeus who was a chief tax collector, and he was rich.
- Referred to Joshua & Jericho's walls falling down.
- Strongs #2195 Zakchaios dzak-chah'-ee-yos AV- Zacchaeus = pure 1) a chief tax collector.
- Acts 9 Summarized of Saul saved by Jesus & becoming Paul the Apostle.
- John 2:15,16 And when He had made a scourge of small cords, He drove them all out of the temple, and the sheep, and the oxen; and poured out the changers' money, and overthrew the tables; 16 And said unto them that sold doves, Take these things hence; make not My Father's house an house of merchandise.

  Mark 11:15-17 And they come
  - to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves; 16 And would not

- suffer that any man should carry any vessel through the temple. 17 And He taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Luke 19:3 (AV) And he sought to see Jesus Who He was; and could not for the press, because he was little of stature.
- Luke 19:3 (NKJV) And he sought to see Who Jesus was, but could not because of the crowd, for he was of short stature.
- Luke 18:39 And they which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace: but he cried so much more, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me.
- Luke 19:4 (AV) And he ran before, and climbed up into a sycomore tree to see Him: for He was to pass that *way*.
- Luke 19:4 (NKJV) So he ran ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see Him, for He was going to pass that *way*.
- Luke 19:5 (AV) And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up, and saw him, and said unto him, Zacchaeus, make haste, and come down; for to day I must abide at thy house.

  Luke 19:5 (NKJV) And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up and saw him, and said to him, Zacchaeus, make haste & come down, for today I must stay at your house.
- Luke 10:30-32 And Jesus answering said, A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead. 31 And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. 32 And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side.
- Luke 7:36 And one of the Pharisees desired Him that He would eat with him. And He went into the Pharisee's house, and sat down to meat.
- Revelation 3:20 I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.
- Luke 19:6 (AV) And he made haste, and came down, and received Him joyfully.

  Luke 19:6 (NKJV) So he made haste and came down, and received Him joyfully.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, & pray, & seek My face, & turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Luke 19:7 (AV) And when they saw *it*, they all murmured, saying, That He was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner.
- Luke 19:7 (NKJV) But when they saw *it*, they all complained, saying, He has gone to be a guest with a man who is a sinner.
- John 8:3,4,10,11 And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst, 4 They say unto him, Master, this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act. 10 When Jesus had lifted up Himself, and saw none but the woman, He said unto

- her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee? 11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- Mark 11:30-33 The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men? answer Me. 31 And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; He will say, Why then did ye not believe him? 32 But if we shall say, Of men; they feared the people: for all men counted John, that he was a prophet indeed. 33 And they answered and said unto Jesus, We cannot tell. And Jesus answering saith unto them, Neither do I tell you by what authority I do these things.
- Luke 18:11 The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank Thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.
- Luke 19:8 (AV) Zacchaeus stood, & said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; & if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore *him* fourfold. Luke 19:8 (NKJV) Zacchaeus stood & said to the Lord, Look, Lord, I give half of my goods to the poor; & if I have taken anything from anyone by false accusation, I restore 4fold.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.**
- Exodus 20:17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.
- Luke 18:22-24 Now when Jesus heard these things, he said unto him, Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, follow Me. 23 And when he heard this, he was very sorrowful: for he was very rich. 24 And when Jesus saw that he was very sorrowful, he said, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God!
- Luke 12:17,18,20 And he thought within himself, saying, What shall I do, because I have no room where to bestow my fruits? 18 And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater; and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods. 20 But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?

  Exodus 20:15 Thou shalt not steal.
- Luke 19:9 (AV) And Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house, forsomuch as he also is a son of Abraham.
- Luke 19:9 (NKJV) And Jesus said to him, Today salvation has come to this house, because he also is a son of Abraham;
- Luke 3:8 Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of repentance, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.
- Romans 12:1-3 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that

- ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. 3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.
- Luke 19:10 (AV) For the Son of Man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

  Luke 19:10 (NKJV) for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.
- Luke 19:11 (AV) And as they heard these things, He added and spake a parable, because He was nigh to Jerusalem, and because they thought that the kingdom of God should immediately appear.
- Luke 19:11 (NKJV) Now as they heard these things, He spoke another parable, because He was near Jerusalem and because they thought the kingdom of God would appear immediately.
- Referred to these Israelites seeking the Conquering King rather than as Jesus came to them as the Suffering Servant.
- Luke 19:12 (AV) He said therefore, A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom, and to return.
- Luke 19:12 (NKJV) Therefore He said: A certain nobleman (Jesus) went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom and to return.
- Luke 19:13 (AV) And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, Occupy till I come.
- Luke 19:13 (NKJV) So he called ten of his servants, delivered to them ten minas, and said to them, Do business till I come.
- Strongs #4231 pragmateuomai *prag-mat-yoo'-om-ahee* AV-occupy 1; 1) to be occupied in anything 2) to carry on a business 3) to carry on the business of a banker or a trader.
- Luke 19:14 (AV) But his citizens hated him, and sent a message after him, saying, We will not have this *man* to reign over us.
- Luke 19:14 (NKJV) But his citizens hated him, and sent a delegation after him, saying, We will not have this *man* to reign over us.
- 1 Samuel 8:4-7 Then all the elders of Israel gathered themselves together, and came to Samuel unto Ramah, 5 And said unto him, Behold, thou art old, and thy sons walk not in thy ways: now make us a king to judge us like all the nations. 6 But the thing displeased Samuel, when they said, Give us a king to judge us. And Samuel prayed unto the LORD. 7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them.
- 1 Chronicles 10:13 So Saul died for his transgression which he committed

- against the LORD, even against the Word of the LORD, which he kept not, & also for asking counsel of one that had a familiar spirit, to enquire of it;
- Matthew 27:17,20 Therefore when they were gathered together, Pilate said unto them, Whom will ye that I release unto you? Barabbas, or Jesus which is called Christ? 20 But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus.
- Luke 19:15 (AV) And it came to pass, that when he was returned, having received the kingdom, then he commanded these servants to be called unto him, to whom he had given the money, that he might know how much every man had gained by trading.

  Luke 19:15 (NKJV) And so it was that when he returned, having received the kingdom, he then commanded these servants, to whom he had given the money, to be called to him, that he might know how much every man had gained by trading.
- Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

  Luke 19:16 (AV) Then came the first, saying, Lord, thy pound hath gained ten
  pounds.

  Luke 19:16 (NKJV) Then
  came the first, saying, Master, your mina has earned ten minas.
- Luke 19:17 (AV) And he said unto him, Well, thou good servant: because thou hast been faithful in a very little, have thou authority over ten cities.
- Luke 19:17 (NKJV) And he said to him, Well *done*, good servant; because you were faithful in a very little, have authority over ten cities.
- Matthew 5:12 Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.
- Luke 19:18 (AV) And the second came, saying, Lord, thy pound hath gained five pounds.

  Luke 19:18 (NKJV) And the second came, saying, Master, your mina has earned five minas.
- Luke 19:19 (AV) And he said likewise to him, Be thou also over five cities.
- Luke 19:19 (NKJV) Likewise he said to him, You also be over five cities.
- Luke 19:20 (AV) And another came, saying, Lord, behold, *here is* thy pound, which I have kept laid up in a napkin:
- Luke 19:20 (NKJV) Then another came, saying, Master, here is your mina, which I have kept put away in a handkerchief.
- Luke 19:21 (AV) For I feared thee, because thou art an austere man: thou takest up that thou layedst not down, and reapest that thou didst not sow.
- Luke 19:21 (NKJV) For I feared you, because you are an austere man. You collect what you did not deposit, and reap what you did not sow.
- Strongs #840 austeros *ow-stay-ros'* AV-austere 2; 1) of mind and manners: harsh, rough, rigid.
- Mark 1:6 And John was clothed with camel's hair, and with a girdle of a skin about his loins; and he did eat locusts and wild honey;
- Luke 19:22 (AV) And he saith unto him, Out of thine own mouth will I judge thee, *thou* wicked servant. Thou knewest that I was an austere man,

- taking up that I laid not down, and reaping that I did not sow:
- Luke 19:22 (NKJV) And he said to him, Out of your own mouth I will judge you, *you* wicked servant. You knew that I was an austere man, collecting what I did not deposit and reaping what I did not sow.
- Luke 19:23 (AV) Wherefore then gavest not thou my money into the bank, that at my coming I might have required mine own with usury?
- Luke 19:23 (NKJV) Why then did you not put my money in the bank, that at my coming I might have collected it with interest?
- Luke 19:24 (AV) And he said unto them that stood by, Take from him the pound, and give *it* to him that hath ten pounds.
- Luke 19:24 (NKJV) And he said to those who stood by, Take the mina from him, and give *it* to him who has ten minas.
- Luke 19:25 (AV) (And they said unto him, Lord, he hath ten pounds.)
- Luke 19:25 (NKJV) (But they said to him, Master, he has ten minas.)
- Luke 19:26 (AV) For I say unto you, That unto every one which hath shall be given; and from him that hath not, even that he hath shall be taken away from him.

  Luke 19:26 (NKJV) For I say to you, that to everyone who has will be given; and from him who does
  - not have, even what he has will be taken away from him.
- Matthew 20:11-15 And when they had received it, they murmured against the goodman of the house, 12 Saying, These last have wrought but one hour, and thou hast made them equal unto us, which have borne the burden and heat of the day. 13 But he answered one of them, and said, Friend, I do thee no wrong: didst not thou agree with me for a penny? 14 Take that thine is, and go thy way: I will give unto this last, even as unto thee. 15 Is it not lawful for me to do what I will with mine own? Is thine eye evil, because I am good?
- Luke 19:27 (AV) But those mine enemies, which would not that I should reign over them, bring hither, and slay *them* before me.
- Luke 19:27 (NKJV) But bring here those enemies of mine, who did not want me to reign over them, and slay *them* before me.
- Matthew 13:40-43 As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world. 41 The Son of Man shall send forth His angels, and they shall gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity; 42 And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth. 43 Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.
