Blessed Is He - Luke 19B

- Luke 19 Referred to Zacchaeus saved at beginning of chapter.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Luke 19:28-48 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 19:28 (AV) And when He had thus spoken, He went before, ascending up to Jerusalem.
- Luke 19:28 (NKJV) When He had said this, He went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem.
- Luke 19:29 (AV) And it came to pass, when He was come nigh to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount called *the mount* of Olives, He sent two of His disciples,
- Luke 19:29 (NKJV) And it came to pass, when He came near to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mountain called Olivet, *that* He sent two of His disciples,
- Luke 19:30 (AV) Saying, Go ye into the village over against *you*; in the which at your entering ye shall find a colt tied, whereon yet never man sat: loose him, and bring *him hither*.
- Luke 19:30 (NKJV) saying, Go into the village opposite *you*, where as you enter you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. Loose it and bring *it here*.
- Luke 19:31 (AV) And if any man ask you, Why do ye loose *him*? thus shall ye say unto him, Because the Lord hath need of him.
- Luke 19:31 (NKJV) And if anyone asks you, Why are you loosing *it*? thus you shall say to him, Because the Lord has need of it.
- Luke 19:32 (AV) And they that were sent went their way, and found even as He had said unto them.
- Luke 19:32 (NKJV) So those who were sent went their way and found *it* just as He had said to them.
- Luke 19:33 (AV) And as they were loosing the colt, the owners thereof said unto them, Why loose ye the colt?
- Luke 19:33 (NKJV) But as they were loosing the colt, the owners of it said to them, Why are you loosing the colt?
- Luke 19:34 (AV) And they said, The Lord hath need of him.
- Luke 19:34 (NKJV) And they said, The Lord has need of him.
- Zechariah 4:10 For who hath despised the day of small things? for they shall rejoice, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those

- seven; they are the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Luke 18:38 he cried, saying, Jesus, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me.
- Mark 7:26 The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought him that he would cast forth the devil out of her daughter.
- Luke 19:35 (AV) And they brought him to Jesus: and they cast their garments upon the colt, and they set Jesus thereon.
- Luke 19:35 (NKJV) Then they brought him to Jesus. And they threw their own clothes on the colt, and they set Jesus on him.
- Luke 19:36 (AV) And as he went, they spread their clothes in the way.
- Luke 19:36 (NKJV) And as He went, many spread their clothes on the road.
- Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Luke 19:37 (AV) And when He was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen;
- Luke 19:37 (NKJV) Then, as He was now drawing near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen,
- Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Luke 19:38 (AV) Saying, Blessed *be* the King that cometh in the Name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest.
- Luke 19:38 (NKJV) saying: Blessed *is* the King Who comes in the Name of the LORD! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!
- Luke 2:14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.
- Revelation 17:14 These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for He is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with Him are called, and chosen, and faithful.
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

 Referred to Jesus' 1000 year rule.
- John 12:13 Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet Him, and

- cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the Name of the Lord.
- Luke 19:39 (AV) And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto Him, Master, rebuke Thy disciples.
- Luke 19:39 (NKJV) And some of the Pharisees called to Him from the crowd, Teacher, rebuke Your disciples.
- Numbers 11:4 the mixt multitude that was among them fell a lusting: and the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat?
- Romans 1:25 Who changed the Truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, Who is blessed for ever. Amen.
- Luke 19:40 (AV) And He answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.
- Luke 19:40 (NKJV) But He answered and said to them, I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out.
- Revelation 19:16 And He hath on His vesture and on His thigh a Name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.
- Isaiah 55:12 For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.
- Luke 19:41 (AV) And when He was come near, He beheld the city, and wept over it,
- Luke 19:41 (NKJV) Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it, Luke 19:42 (AV) Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things *which belong* unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes.
- Luke 19:42 (NKJV) saying, If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things *that make* for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes.
- John 10:38 But if I do, though ye believe not Me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in Me, and I in Him.
- Luke 19:43 (AV) For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side,
- Luke 19:43 (NKJV) For days will come upon you when your enemies will build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side,
- Mark 13:14 But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains:
- Luke 19:44 (AV) And shall lay thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation.
- Luke 19:44 (NKJV) and level you, and your children within you, to the ground;

- and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation.
- Luke 19:45 (AV) And He went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold therein, and them that bought;
- Luke 19:45 (NKJV) Then He went into the temple and began to drive out those who bought and sold in it,
- John 2:13-16 And the Jews' passover was at hand, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem, 14 And found in the temple those that sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the changers of money sitting: 15 And when He had made a scourge of small cords, He drove them all out of the temple, and the sheep, and the oxen; and poured out the changers' money, and overthrew the tables; 16 And said unto them that sold doves, Take these things hence; make not My Father's house an house of merchandise.
- Luke 19:46 (AV) Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Luke 19:46 (NKJV) saying to them, It is written, My house is a house of prayer, but you have made it a den of thieves.
- Matthew 3:5-7 Then went out to him (John Baptist) Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan, 6 And were baptized of him in Jordan, confessing their sins. 7 But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?
- Revelation 13:17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.
- Luke 19:47 (AV) And He taught daily in the temple. But the chief priests and the scribes and the chief of the people sought to destroy Him,
- Luke 19:47 (NKJV) And He was teaching daily in the temple. But the chief priests, the scribes, and the leaders of the people sought to destroy Him,
- Mark 1:22 And they were astonished at his doctrine: for he taught them as one that had authority, and not as the scribes.
- Luke 4 Referred to the devil miss-using the Word of God & Jesus corrected him.
- Amos 8:11 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the Words of the LORD:
- Luke 19:48 (AV) And could not find what they might do: for all the people were very attentive to hear Him.
- Luke 19:48 (NKJV) and were unable to do anything; for all the people were very attentive to hear Him.
- Matthew 26:3,4 Then assembled together the chief priests, and the scribes, and the elders of the people, unto the palace of the high priest, who was called Caiaphas, 4 And consulted that they might take Jesus by subtilty,

and kill him.

- Mark 11:18 And the scribes and chief priests heard it, and sought how they might destroy Him: for they feared him, because all the people was astonished at his doctrine.
- Psalms 96:11 Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof.
- Psalms 98:7-9 Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein. 8 Let the floods clap *their* hands: let the hills be joyful together 9 Before the LORD; for He cometh to judge the earth: with righteousness shall He judge the world, and the people with equity.
- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
- Psalms 114:1-3 When Israel went out of Egypt, the house of Jacob from a people of strange language; 2 Judah was His sanctuary, *and* Israel His dominion. 3 The sea saw *it*, and fled: Jordan was driven back.
- Joshua 3:15,16 And as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,) 16 That the waters which came down from above stood and rose up upon an heap very far from the city Adam, that is beside Zaretan: and those that came down toward the sea of the plain, even the salt sea, failed, and were cut off: and the people passed over right against Jericho.
- Psalms 114:4-7 The mountains skipped like rams, and the little hills like lambs. 5 What ailed thee, O thou sea, that thou fleddest? thou Jordan, that thou wast driven back? 6 Ye mountains, that ye skipped like rams; and ye little hills, like lambs? 7 Tremble, thou earth, at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Jacob;
- Exodus 19:16-19 And it came to pass on the third day in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount, and the voice of the trumpet exceeding loud; so that all the people that was in the camp trembled. 17 And Moses brought forth the people out of the camp to meet with God; and they stood at the nether part of the mount. 18 And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly. 19 And when the voice of the trumpet sounded long, and waxed louder and louder, Moses spake, and God answered him by a voice.
- Psalms 114:8 Which turned the rock *into* a standing water, the flint into a fountain of waters.
- Exodus 17:6 Behold, I will stand before thee there upon the rock in Horeb; and thou shalt smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that

the people may drink. And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel.

- Isaiah 55:12 For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap *their* hands.
- Habakkuk 2:11 For the stone shall cry out of the wall, and the beam out of the timber shall answer it.
- Revelation 19:11-13 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and He that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He doth judge and make war. 12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns; and He had a Name written, that no man knew, but He Himself. 13 And He was clothed with a vesture dipped in Blood: and His Name is called The Word of God.
- John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
- Revelation 19:14-16 And the armies which were in heaven followed Him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. 15 And out of His mouth goeth a sharp sword (the Word of God), that with it He should smite the nations: and He shall rule them with a rod of iron: and He treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And He hath on His vesture and on His thigh a Name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Job 1:21,22 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD. 22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.
