- Matthew 3:2 And (John Baptist) saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Luke 19:38 Saying, Blessed be the King that cometh in the Name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest.
- Matthew 3:7 But when he (John Baptist) saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?
- Matthew 4:23,24 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them.
- Luke 20:1-19 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 20:1 (AV) And it came to pass, *that* on one of those days, as He taught the people in the temple, and preached the gospel, the chief priests and the scribes came upon *Him* with the elders,
- Luke 20:1 (NKJV) Now it happened on one of those days, as He taught the people in the temple and preached the gospel, *that* the chief priests and the scribes, together with the elders, confronted *Him*
- Mark 1:22 And they were astonished at His doctrine: for He taught them as one that had authority, and not as the scribes.
- John 14:1-3 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in Me. 2 In My Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- Revelation 20:10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.
- Luke 20:2 (AV) And spake unto Him, saying, Tell us, by what authority doest Thou these things? or Who is He that gave Thee this authority?
- Luke 20:2 (NKJV) and spoke to Him, saying, Tell us, by what authority are You doing these things? Or Who is He Who gave You this authority?

- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- John 5:19 Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He seeth the Father do: for what things soever He doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.
- Mark 7:13 Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- Luke 20:3 (AV) And He answered and said unto them, I will also ask you one thing; and answer Me:

- Luke 20:4 (AV) The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men?

 Luke 20:4 (NKJV) The baptism of John, was it from heaven or from men?

 Luke 1 Summarized of God's promise to Zachariah of his son John's birth & mission as fore-runner to Jesus.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Matthew 3:7 But when he (John Baptist) saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?
- Luke 20:5 (AV) And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; He will say, Why then believed ye him not?
- Luke 20:5 (NKJV) And they reasoned among themselves, saying, If we say, From heaven, He will say, Why then did you not believe him?
- Mark 1:15 And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.
- Mark 13:14 But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth

- understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains:
- Luke 20:6 (AV) But and if we say, Of men; all the people will stone us: for they be persuaded that John was a prophet.
- Luke 20:6 (NKJV) But if we say, From men, all the people will stone us, for they are persuaded that John was a prophet.
- Acts 5:3,5 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land? 5 And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things.
- John 18:6 As soon then as He had said unto them, I Am, they went backward, and fell to the ground.
- Luke 20:7 (AV) And they answered, that they could not tell whence it was.
- Luke 20:7 (NKJV) So they answered that they did not know where *it was* from.
- Luke 20:8 (AV) And Jesus said unto them, Neither tell I you by what authority I do these things.

 Luke 20:8 (NKJV) And Jesus said to them, Neither will I tell you by what authority I do these things.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 8:33 But when He had turned about and looked on His disciples, He rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind Me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.
- Luke 20:9 (AV) Then began He to speak to the people this parable; A certain man planted a vineyard, and let it forth to husbandmen, and went into a far country for a long time.
- Luke 20:9 (NKJV) Then He began to tell the people this parable: A certain man planted a vineyard, leased it to vinedressers, and went into a far country for a long time.
- Luke 20:10 (AV) And at the season he sent a servant to the husbandmen, that they should give him of the fruit of the vineyard: but the husbandmen beat him, and sent *him* away empty.
- Luke 20:10 (NKJV) Now at vintage-time he sent a servant to the vinedressers, that they might give him some of the fruit of the vineyard. But the vinedressers beat him and sent *him* away empty-handed.
- 1 Samuel 25:21 Now David had said, Surely in vain have I kept all that this fellow hath in the wilderness, so that nothing was missed of all that pertained unto him: and he hath requited me evil for good.
- Luke 20:11 (AV) And again he sent another servant: and they beat him also, and entreated *him* shamefully, and sent *him* away empty.
- Luke 20:11 (NKJV) Again he sent another servant; and they beat him also, treated *him* shamefully, and sent *him* away empty-handed.
- Luke 20:12 (AV) And again he sent a third: and they wounded him also, and

- cast him out. he sent a third; and they wounded him also and cast him out.
- Luke 20:13 (AV) Then said the lord of the vineyard, What shall I do? I will send my beloved son: it may be they will reverence him when they see him.
- Luke 20:13 (NKJV) Then the owner of the vineyard said, What shall I do? I will send my beloved son. Probably they will respect him when they see him.
- Luke 20:14 (AV) But when the husbandmen saw him, they reasoned among themselves, saying, This is the heir: come, let us kill him, that the inheritance may be ours.
- Luke 20:14 (NKJV) But when the vinedressers saw him, they reasoned among themselves, saying, This is the heir. Come, let us kill him, that the inheritance may be ours.
- Genesis 37 Summarized of Joseph & his brothers hating him & selling him off, etc.
- 2 Kings 9:26 Surely I have seen yesterday the blood of Naboth, and the blood of his sons, saith the LORD; and I will requite thee in this plat, saith the LORD. Now therefore take and cast him into the plat of ground, according to the Word of the LORD.
- Luke 20:15 (AV) So they cast him out of the vineyard, and killed him. What therefore shall the lord of the vineyard do unto them?
- Luke 20:15 (NKJV) So they cast him out of the vineyard and killed him. Therefore what will the owner of the vineyard do to them?
- Luke 20:16 (AV) He shall come and destroy these husbandmen, and shall give the vineyard to others. And when they heard it, they said, God forbid.
- Luke 20:16 (NKJV) He will come and destroy those vinedressers and give the vineyard to others. And when they heard it they said, Certainly not!
- Numbers 35:30 Whoso killeth any person, the murderer shall be put to death by the mouth of witnesses: but one witness shall not testify against any person to cause him to die.
- Luke 20:17 (AV) And He beheld them, and said, What is this then that is written, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner?
- Luke 20:17 (NKJV) Then He looked at them and said, What then is this that is written: The Stone which the builders rejected Has become the Chief **Cornerstone?**
- Psalms 118:22 (AV) The Stone which the builders refused is become the Head Stone of the corner.
- Psalms 118:22 The Stone which the builders rejected has become the Chief Cornerstone.
- Matthew 16:18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this

- Rock I will build My church; & the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Luke 20:18 (AV) Whosoever shall fall upon that Stone shall be broken; but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder.
- Luke 20:18 (NKJV) Whoever falls on that Stone will be broken; but on whomever it falls, it will grind him to powder.
- Matthew 3:9 And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, that God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.
- Luke 20:19 (AV) And the chief priests and the scribes the same hour sought to lay hands on Him; and they feared the people: for they perceived that He had spoken this parable against them.
- Luke 20:19 (NKJV) And the chief priests and the scribes that very hour sought to lay hands on Him, but they feared the people, for they knew He had spoken this parable against them.
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Luke 19:38 Saying, Blessed be the King that cometh in the Name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest. 39 And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto Him, Master, rebuke Thy disciples. 40 And He answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.
- Isaiah 55:12 For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

- Psalms 2:1,2 Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing? 2 The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against His anointed, *saying*,
- 1 Kings 22 Summarized V22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And He said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- Psalms 2:3-6 Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us. 4 He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh: the Lord shall have them in derision. 5 Then shall He speak unto them in His wrath, and vex them in His sore displeasure. 6 Yet have I set My King upon My Holy hill of

Zion.

- Revelation 19 Sunnarized of Jesus' return & 1000 year rule & total victory.
- Psalms 2:7 I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto Me, Thou *art* My Son; this day have I begotten Thee.
- Luke 20:13 (AV) Then said the lord of the vineyard, What shall I do? I will send My Beloved Son: it may be they will reverence *Him* when they see Him.
