Jesus Christ vs Religious Spies - Luke 20B

- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- Galatians 2:4 And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage:
- Numbers 11:4 And the mixt multitude that was among them fell a lusting: and the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat?
- Jude 1:4 For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.
- Acts 15:19,20 Wherefore my sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God: 20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Luke 20:20-47 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 20:20 (AV) And they watched *Him*, and sent forth spies, which should feign themselves just men, that they might take hold of His Words, that so they might deliver Him unto the power and authority of the governor.
- Luke 20:20 (NKJV) So they watched *Him*, and sent spies who pretended to be righteous, that they might seize on His Words, in order to deliver Him to the power and the authority of the governor.

- Luke 20:21 (AV) And they asked Him, saying, Master, we know that Thou sayest and teachest rightly, neither acceptest Thou the person *of any*, but teachest the way of God truly:
- Luke 20:21 (NKJV) Then they asked Him, saying, Teacher, we know that You say and teach rightly, and You do not show personal favoritism, but teach the way of God in truth:
- Luke 20:22 (AV) Is it lawful for us to give tribute unto Caesar, or no?
- Luke 20:22 (NKJV) Is it lawful for us to pay taxes to Caesar or not?
- John 8 Referred to the incident of the adultrous woman V7 So when they continued asking Him, He lifted up Himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.
- Luke 20:23 (AV) But He perceived their craftiness, and said unto them, Why tempt ye Me?
- Luke 20:23 (NKJV) But He perceived their craftiness, and said to them, Why do you test Me?
- Matthew 22:18 But Jesus perceived their wickedness, and said, Why tempt ye Me, ye hypocrites?
- Luke 20:24 (AV) Shew Me a penny. Whose image and superscription hath it? They answered and said, Caesar's.
- Luke 20:24 (NKJV) Show Me a denarius. Whose image and inscription does it have? They answered and said, Caesar's.
- Luke 20:4-7 The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men? 5 And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say, Why then believed ye him not? 6 But and if we say, Of men; all the people will stone us: for they be persuaded that John was a prophet. 7 And they answered, that they could not tell whence it was.
- Luke 20:25 (AV) And He said unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which be Caesar's, and unto God the things which be God's.
- Luke 20:25 (NKJV) And He said to them, Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's.
- Mark 12:30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.
- Matthew 23:23 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.
- Luke 20:26 (AV) And they could not take hold of His Words before the

- people: and they marvelled at His answer, and held their peace.
- Luke 20:26 (NKJV) But they could not catch Him in His Words in the presence of the people. And they marveled at His answer and kept silent.
- Luke 20:27 (AV) Then came to *Him* certain of the Sadducees, which deny that there is any resurrection; and they asked Him,
- Luke 20:27 (NKJV) Then some of the Sadducees, who deny that there is a resurrection, came to *Him* and asked Him,
- Mark 12:13 And they send unto Him certain of the Pharisees and of the Herodians, to catch Him in His Words.
- Luke 20:28 (AV) Saying, Master, Moses wrote unto us, If any man's brother die, having a wife, and he die without children, that his brother should take his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother.
- Luke 20:28 (NKJV) saying: Teacher, Moses wrote to us *that* if a man's brother dies, having a wife, and he dies without children, his brother should take his wife and raise up offspring for his brother.
- Luke 20:29 (AV) There were therefore seven brethren: and the first took a wife, and died without children.
- Luke 20:29 (NKJV) Now there were seven brothers. And the first took a wife, and died without children.
- 1 Kings 21:13 And there came in two men, children of Belial, and sat before him: and the men of Belial witnessed against him, even against Naboth, in the presence of the people, saying, Naboth did blaspheme God and the king. Then they carried him forth out of the city, and stoned him with stones, that he died.
- 2 Kings 9:26 Surely I have seen yesterday the blood of Naboth, and the blood of his sons, saith the LORD; and I will requite thee in this plat, saith the LORD. Now therefore take and cast him into the plat of ground, according to the Word of the LORD.
- Luke 20:30 (AV) And the second took her to wife, and he died childless.
- Luke 20:30 (NKJV) And the second took her as wife, and he died childless.
- Luke 20:31 (AV) And the third took her; and in like manner the seven also: and they left no children, and died.
- Luke 20:31 (NKJV) Then the third took her, and in like manner the seven also; and they left no children, and died.
- Luke 20:32 (AV) Last of all the woman died also.
- Luke 20:32 (NKJV) Last of all the woman died also.
- Luke 20:33 (AV) Therefore in the resurrection whose wife of them is she? for seven had her to wife.
- Luke 20:33 (NKJV) Therefore, in the resurrection, whose wife does she

- become? For all seven had her as wife.
- Luke 20:34 (AV) And Jesus answering said unto them, The children of this world marry, and are given in marriage:
- Luke 20:34 (NKJV) And Jesus answered and said to them, The sons of this age marry and are given in marriage.
- Matthew 22:29 (AV) Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the Scriptures, nor the power of God.
- Matthew 22:29 (NKJV) Jesus answered and said to them, You are mistaken, not knowing the Scriptures nor the power of God.
- John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- 2 Timothy 3:5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. 12 For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee. 13 Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God. 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- Genesis 2:20-23 And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him. 21 And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; 22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. 23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.
- God did not make woman from a hair to rule over Adam. God did not make woman from a toe-nail for Adam to rule over her. God made woman from a rib near Adam's heart to love her & work together with her.
- Luke 20:35 (AV) But they which shall be accounted worthy to obtain that world, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry, nor are given in

marriage:

- Luke 20:35 (NKJV) But those who are counted worthy to attain that age, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry nor are given in marriage;
- Revelation 20:12,15 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the Book of Life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.
- Luke 20:36 (AV) Neither can they die any more: for they are equal unto the angels; and are the children of God, being the children of the resurrection.
- Luke 20:36 (NKJV) nor can they die anymore, for they are equal to the angels and are sons of God, being sons of the resurrection.
- Luke 20:37 (AV) Now that the dead are raised, even Moses shewed at the bush, when he calleth the Lord the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.
- Luke 20:37 (NKJV) But even Moses showed in the *burning* bush *passage* that the dead are raised, when he called the Lord the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.
- Exodus 3:3-6 And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. 4 And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I. 5 And he said, Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground. 6 Moreover he said, I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.
- Luke 20:38 (AV) For He is not a God of the dead, but of the living: for all live unto Him.
- Luke 20:38 (NKJV) For He is not the God of the dead but of the living, for all live to Him.
- Matthew 3:9 And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, that God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.
- Luke 20:39 (AV) Then certain of the scribes answering said, Master, Thou hast well said.
- Luke 20:39 (NKJV) Then some of the scribes answered and said, Teacher, You have spoken well.
- Luke 20:40 (AV) And after that they durst not ask Him any question at all.

- Luke 20:40 (NKJV) But after that they dared not question Him anymore.
- Matthew 26:14-16 Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went unto the chief priests, 15 And said unto them, What will ye give me, and I will deliver Him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver. 16 And from that time he sought opportunity to betray Him.
- Luke 20:41 (AV) And He said unto them, How say they that Christ is David's son?
- Luke 20:41 (NKJV) And He said to them, How can they say that the Christ is the Son of David?
- Luke 20:42 (AV) And David himself saith in the book of Psalms, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit Thou on My right hand,
- Luke 20:42 (NKJV) Now David himself said in the Book of Psalms: The LORD said to my Lord, Sit at My right hand,
- Psalms 110:1 A Psalm of David. The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit Thou at My right hand, until I make Thine enemies Thy footstool.
- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
- Luke 20:43 (AV) Till I make Thine enemies thy footstool.
- Luke 20:43 (NKJV) Till I make Your enemies Your footstool.
- Luke 20:44 (AV) David therefore calleth Him Lord, how is He then his Son?
- Luke 20:44 (NKJV) Therefore David calls Him Lord; how is He then his Son?
- Luke 20:45 (AV) Then in the audience of all the people He said unto His disciples,
- Luke 20:45 (NKJV) Then, in the hearing of all the people, He said to His disciples,
- Luke 20:46 (AV) Beware of the scribes, which desire to walk in long robes, and love greetings in the markets, and the highest seats in the synagogues, and the chief rooms at feasts;
- Luke 20:46 (NKJV) Beware of the scribes, who desire to go around in long robes, love greetings in the marketplaces, the best seats in the synagogues, and the best places at feasts,
- 2 Timothy 3:5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.
- Luke 20:47 (AV) Which devour widows' houses, and for a shew make long prayers: the same shall receive greater damnation.
- Luke 20:47 (NKJV) who devour widows' houses, and for a pretense make long prayers. These will receive greater condemnation.
