

Looks Can Be Deceiving - Luke 21A

Genesis 3 Referred to the devil as being the deceiver from the beginning.

Luke 20:23 But He perceived their craftiness, and said unto them, Why tempt ye Me?

Luke 21:1-8 (AV) & (NKJV)

Luke 21:1 (AV) And He looked up, and saw the rich men casting their gifts into the treasury. Luke 21:1 (NKJV) And He

looked up and saw the rich putting their gifts into the treasury,

Luke 21:2 (AV) And He saw also a certain poor widow casting in thither two mites.

Luke 21:2 (NKJV) and He saw also a certain poor widow putting in two mites.

Luke 18:10-14 Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, & the other a publican. 11 The Pharisee stood & prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. 12 I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess. 13 And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. 14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

Luke 21:3 (AV) And He said, Of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all:

Luke 21:3 (NKJV) So He said, Truly I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all;

Luke 21:4 (AV) For all these have of their abundance cast in unto the offerings of God: but she of her penury hath cast in all the living that she had.

Luke 21:4 (NKJV) for all these out of their abundance have put in offerings for God, but she out of her poverty put in all the livelihood that she had.

Matthew 23:23 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.

Strong's #5303 husterema *hoos-ter'-ay-mah* AV-which is lacking 3, want 3, which is behind 1, lack 1, penury 1; 9 1) deficiency, that which is lacking 2) in reference to property and resources, poverty, want, destitution.

Zechariah 7:10 oppress not the widow, nor the fatherless, the stranger, nor the poor; and let none of you imagine evil against his brother in your heart.

Luke 21:5 (AV) And as some spake of the temple, how it was adorned with goodly stones and gifts, He said,

Luke 21:5 (NKJV) Then, as some spoke of the temple, how it was adorned with beautiful stones and donations, He said,

Luke 21:6 (AV) *As for* these things which ye behold, the days will come, in the which there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.

Luke 21:6 (NKJV) These things which you see, the days will come in which not *one* stone shall be left upon another that shall not be thrown down.

Matthew 24 is a similar passage explaining more details.

Luke 21:7 (AV) And they asked Him, saying, Master, but when shall these things be? and what sign *will there be* when these things shall come to pass?

Luke 21:7 (NKJV) So they asked Him, saying, Teacher, but when will these things be? And what sign *will there be* when these things are about to take place?

2 Corinthians 11:14,15 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. 15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

Matthew 16:3,4 And in the morning, It will be foul weather to day: for the sky is red and lowring. O ye hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky; but can ye not discern the signs of the times? 4 A wicked and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given unto it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas. And he left them, and departed.

Luke 21:8 (AV) And He said, Take heed that ye be not deceived: for many shall come in My Name, saying, I am *Christ*; and the time draweth near: go ye not therefore after them.

Luke 21:8 (NKJV) And He said: Take heed that you not be deceived. For many will come in My Name, saying, I am *He*, and, The time has drawn near. Therefore do not go after them.

Mark 14:62 And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

Exodus 3:14 And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall

be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

1 Kings 22:20-23 And the LORD said, Who shall persuade Ahab, that he may go up and fall at Ramothgilead? And one said on this manner, and another said on that manner. 21 And there came forth a spirit, and stood before the LORD, and said, I will persuade him. 22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so. 23 Now therefore, behold, the LORD hath put a lying spirit in the mouth of all these thy prophets, and the LORD hath spoken evil concerning thee.

1 Kings 22:30,34 And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, I will disguise myself, and enter into the battle; but put thou on thy robes. And the king of Israel disguised himself, and went into the battle. 34 And a certain man drew a bow at a venture, and smote the king of Israel between the joints of the harness: wherefore he said unto the driver of his chariot, Turn thine hand, and carry me out of the host; for I am wounded.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Genesis 3:1-7 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? 2 And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: 3 But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. 4 And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: 5 For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat. 7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Joshua 9:12-15 This our bread we took hot for our provision out of our houses on the day we came forth to go unto you; but now, behold, it is dry, and it is mouldy: 13 And these bottles of wine, which we filled, were new; and, behold, they be rent: and these our garments and our shoes are become old by reason of the very long journey. 14 And the men took of their victuals, and asked not counsel at the mouth of the LORD. 15 And Joshua

made peace with them, and made a league with them, to let them live: and the princes of the congregation sware unto them.

Matthew 18:12,13 How think ye? if a man have an hundred sheep, and one of them be gone astray <4105>, doth he not leave the ninety and nine, and goeth into the mountains, and seeketh that which is gone astray <4105>?
13 And if so be that he find it, verily I say unto you, he rejoiceth more of that *sheep*, than of the ninety and nine which went <4105> not astray <4105>.

Matthew 22:29 Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err <4105>, not knowing the Scriptures, nor the power of God.

Matthew 22:23-28 The same day came to Him the Sadducees, which say that there is no resurrection, and asked Him, 24 Saying, Master, Moses said, If a man die, having no children, his brother shall marry his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother. 25 Now there were with us seven brethren: and the first, when he had married a wife, deceased, and, having no issue, left his wife unto his brother: 26 Likewise the second also, and the third, unto the seventh. 27 And last of all the woman died also. 28 Therefore in the resurrection whose wife shall she be of the seven? for they all had her.

Matthew 24:4,5 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive <4105> you. 5 For many shall come in My Name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive <4105> many.

Matthew 24:11 And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive <4105> many.

Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if *it were* possible, they shall deceive <4105> the very elect.

Mark 12:24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye <4105> not therefore err <4105>, because ye know not the Scriptures, neither the power of God?

Mark 12:27 He is not the God of the dead, but the God of the living: ye therefore do <4105> greatly err <4105>.

Mark 13:5,6 And Jesus answering them began to say, Take heed lest any *man* deceive <4105> you: 6 For many shall come in My Name, saying, I am *Christ*; and shall deceive <4105> many.

Luke 21:8 And He said, Take heed that ye be <4105> not deceived <4105>: for many shall come in My Name, saying, I am *Christ*; and the time draweth near: go ye not therefore after them.

John 7:12 And there was much murmuring among the people concerning Him: for some said, He is a Good Man: others said, Nay; but He deceiveth <4105> the people.

John 10:38 But if I do, though ye believe not Me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in Me, and I in Him.

John 7:47 Then answered them the Pharisees, Are <4105> ye also deceived <4105>?

1 Corinthians 6:9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be <4105> not deceived <4105>: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, **10** Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. **11** And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.

1 Corinthians 15:33 Be <4105> not deceived <4105>: evil communications corrupt good manners.

Matthew 13:22 He also that received seed among the thorns is he that heareth the Word; and the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word, and he becometh unfruitful.

Psalms 23:3A He restoreth my soul.

Galatians 6:7 Be <4105> not deceived <4105>; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

Deuteronomy 23:2 A bastard shall not enter into the congregation of the LORD; even to his tenth generation shall he not enter into the congregation of the LORD.

2 Timothy 3:13 But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving <4105>, and being deceived <4105>.

Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

Titus 3:3 For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived <4105>, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, *and* hating one another.

Hebrews 3:10 Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do <4105> alway err <4105> in *their* heart; and they have not known My ways.

Numbers 14:11 And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke Me? and how long will it be ere they believe Me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them?

Numbers 11:4 And the mixt multitude that was among them fell a lusting: and the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat?

Numbers 14:22 Because all those men which have seen My glory, and My

miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted Me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to My Voice;

Hebrews 5:2 Who can have compassion on the ignorant, and on them that are out of the way <4105>; for that He Himself also is compassed with infirmity.

Hebrews 11:38 (Of Whom the world was not worthy:) they wandered <4105> in deserts, and *in* mountains, and *in* dens and caves of the earth.

James 1:16 Do <4105> not err <4105>, my beloved brethren.

James 5:19 Brethren, if any of you do err <4105> from the truth, and one convert him;

Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

1 Peter 2:25 For ye were as sheep going astray <4105>; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.

2 Peter 2:15 Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray <4105>, following the way of Balaam *the son* of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness;

Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

1 John 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive <4105> ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

1 John 2:26 These *things* have I written unto you concerning them that seduce <4105> you.

2 John 1:7 For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.

1 John 3:7 Little children, let <4105> no man deceive <4105> you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as He is righteous.

Revelation 2:20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce <4105> My servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of

idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.

Revelation 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth <4105> the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Revelation 13:14 And deceiveth <4105> them that dwell on the earth by *the means of* those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.

2 Timothy 3:8 Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith.

Exodus 7:11 Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers: now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments.

Exodus 8:18 And the magicians did so with their enchantments to bring forth lice, but they could not: so there were lice upon man, and upon beast.

Revelation 18:23 And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in thee; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in thee: for thy merchants were the great men of the earth; for by thy sorceries were <4105> all nations deceived <4105>.

Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:

Revelation 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived <4105> them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

Revelation 20:3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive <4105> the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

Revelation 20:8 And shall go out to deceive <4105> the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom *is* as the sand of the sea.

Revelation 20:10 And the devil that deceived <4105> them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet *are*, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.
