- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Psalms 59:8 But Thou, O LORD, shalt laugh at them; Thou shalt have all the heathen in derision.
- Matthew 22:18 But Jesus perceived their wickedness, and said, Why tempt ye Me, ye hypocrites?
- Luke 20:23 But He perceived their craftiness, and said unto them, Why tempt ye Me?
- Luke 22:1 (AV) Now the Feast of Unleavened Bread drew nigh, which is called the Passover.

 Luke 22:1 (NKJV) Now the Feast of Unleavened Bread drew near, which is called Passover.
- Exodus 12:11-13 And thus shall ye eat it; with your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it is the LORD'S passover. 12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD. 13 And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt.
- Leviticus 23:5 In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is the LORD'S passover.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Luke 22:2 (AV) And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill Him; for they feared the people.

- 1 John 2:22 Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.

- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
- Mark 6:7,13 And He called unto Him the 12, and began to send them forth by 2 and 2; and gave them power over unclean spirits; 13 And they cast out many devils, and anointed with oil many that were sick, and healed them.
- Luke 22:3 Then <u>entered Satan</u> into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.
- John 13:27 And after the sop <u>Satan</u> entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly.
- Matthew 26:21 And as they did eat, He said, Verily I say unto you, that one of you shall betray Me.
- Genesis 3:1-6 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. - taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD. 22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.
- 2 Samuel 11:1 And it came to pass, after the year was expired, at the time when kings go forth to battle, that David sent Joab, and his servants with him, and all Israel; and they destroyed the children of Ammon, and besieged Rabbah. But David tarried still at Jerusalem. (Summarized of David's sin & God's judgement.)
- 2 Samuel 12:7-11 And Nathan said to David, Thou art the man. - 2 Chronicles 8:13 Even after a certain rate every day, offering according to the commandment of Moses, on the sabbaths, and on the new moons, and on the solemn feasts, three times in the year, even in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of tabernacles.
- Luke 22:12 (AV) And he shall shew you a large upper room furnished: there make ready.

- Matthew 16:21-23 From that time forth began Jesus to shew unto His disciples, how that He must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day. 22 Then Peter took Him, and began to rebuke Him, saying, Be it far from Thee, Lord: this shall not be unto Thee. 23 But He turned, & said unto Peter, Get thee behind Me, Satan: thou art an offence unto Me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

- Luke 22:16 (AV) For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God.
- Luke 22:16 (NKJV) for I say to you, I will no longer eat of it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God.
- Luke 22:17 (AV) And He took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide *it* among yourselves:

- Luke 22:18 (AV) For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come.

- Exodus 12:18-20 In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at even, ye shall eat unleavened bread, until the one and twentieth day of the month at even. 19 Seven days shall there be no leaven found in your houses: for whosoever eateth that which is leavened, even that soul shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he be a stranger, or born in the land. 20 Ye shall eat nothing leavened; in all your habitations shall ye eat unleavened bread.
