- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Referred to the Last Supper & the Garden of Gethsemane.
- Luke 22:3 Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.
- Mark 8:31-33 And He began to teach them, that the Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and of the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again. 32 And He spake that saying openly. And Peter took Him, and began to rebuke Him. 33 But when He had turned about and looked on His disciples, He rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind Me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.
- Luke 22:21 (AV) But, behold, the hand of him that betrayeth Me *is* with Me on the table.
- Luke 22:21 (NKJV) But behold, the hand of My betrayer *is* with Me on the table.
- Matthew 1:21 And she shall bring forth a Son, and thou shalt call His Name JESUS: for He shall save His people from their sins.
- Luke 22:22 (AV) And truly the Son of Man goeth, as it was determined: but woe unto that man by whom He is betrayed!
- Luke 22:22 (NKJV) And truly the Son of Man goes as it has been determined, but woe to that man by whom He is betrayed!
- Luke 22:23 (AV) And they began to enquire among themselves, which of them it was that should do this thing.
- Luke 22:23 (NKJV) Then they began to question among themselves, which of them it was who would do this thing.
- Luke 22:24 (AV) And there was also a strife among them, which of them should be accounted the greatest.
- Luke 22:24 (NKJV) Now there was also a dispute among them, as to which of them should be considered the greatest.
- Luke 22:25 (AV) And He said unto them, The kings of the Gentiles exercise

- lordship over them; and they that exercise authority upon them are called benefactors.
- Luke 22:25 (NKJV) And He said to them, The kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them, and those who exercise authority over them are called benefactors.
- Luke 22:26 (AV) But ye *shall* not *be* so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve.
- Luke 22:26 (NKJV) But not so *among* you; on the contrary, he who is greatest among you, let him be as the younger, and he who governs as he who serves.
- 1 Samuel 16:11-13 And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all thy children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: for we will not sit down till he come hither. 12 And he sent, and brought him in. Now he was ruddy, and withal of a beautiful countenance, and goodly to look to. And the LORD said, Arise, anoint him: for this is he. 13 Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. - Luke 22:27 (AV) For whether *is* greater, he that sitteth at meat, or he that serveth? *is* not he that sitteth at meat? but I am among you as He that serveth.
- Luke 22:27 (NKJV) For who *is* greater, he who sits at the table, or he who serves? *Is* it not he who sits at the table? Yet I am among you as the One Who serves.
- Luke 22:28 (AV) Ye are they which have continued with Me in My temptations.
- Luke 22:28 (NKJV) But you are those who have continued with Me in My trials.
- Luke 4:29,30 And rose up, and thrust Him out of the city, and led Him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast Him down headlong. 30 But He passing through the midst of them went His way,
- John 8:59 Then took they up stones to cast at Him: but Jesus hid Himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.
- John 10:39 Therefore they sought again to take Him: but He escaped out of their hand,
- Mark 14:38 Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit truly is ready, but the flesh is weak.
- Luke 22:29 (AV) And I appoint unto you a kingdom, as My Father hath

- appointed unto Me;
- Luke 22:29 (NKJV) And I bestow upon you a kingdom, just as My Father bestowed *one* upon Me,
- Luke 22:30 (AV) That ye may eat and drink at My table in My kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
- Luke 22:30 (NKJV) that you may eat and drink at My table in My kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
- Zechariah 13:7 Awake, O sword, against My shepherd, and against the Man that is My Fellow, saith the LORD of hosts: smite the Shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered: and I will turn Mine hand upon the little ones.
- Luke 22:31 (AV) And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired *to have* you, that he may sift *you* as wheat:
- Luke 22:31 (NKJV) And the Lord said, Simon, Simon! Indeed, Satan has asked for you, that he may sift *you* as wheat.
- Job 1&2 Referred to the devil asking God to be able to test Job.
- Job 1:10-12 Hast not Thou made an hedge about him, and about his house, and about all that he hath on every side? Thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his substance is increased in the land. 11 But put forth Thine hand now, and touch all that he hath, and he will curse Thee to Thy face. 12 And the LORD said unto Satan, Behold, all that he hath is in thy power; only upon himself put not forth thine hand. So Satan went forth from the presence of the LORD.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- Ephesians 6:11,13-17 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; 15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God:

- 2 Corinthians 1: 3,4 Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort; 4 Who comforteth us in

- all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God.
- Luke 22:33 (AV) And he said unto Him, Lord, I am ready to go with Thee, both into prison, and to death.
- Luke 22:33 (NKJV) But he said to Him, Lord, I am ready to go with You, both to prison and to death.
- Luke 14:27,28 And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after Me, cannot be My disciple. 28 For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have sufficient to finish it?
- Luke 22:34 (AV) And He said, I tell thee, Peter, the cock shall not crow this day, before that thou shalt thrice deny that thou knowest Me.
- Luke 22:34 (NKJV) Then He said, I tell you, Peter, the rooster shall not crow this day before you will deny three times that you know Me.
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- Isaiah 11:2 And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the (Godly) fear of the LORD;
- Luke 22:35 (AV) And He said unto them, When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye any thing? And they said, Nothing.
- Luke 22:35 (NKJV) And He said to them, When I sent you without money bag, knapsack, and sandals, did you lack anything? So they said, Nothing.
- Luke 22:36 (AV) Then said He unto them, But now, he that hath a purse, let him take *it*, and likewise *his* scrip: and he that hath no sword, let him sell his garment, and buy one.
- Luke 22:36 (NKJV) Then He said to them, But now, he who has a money bag, let him take *it*, and likewise a knapsack; and he who has no sword, let him sell his garment and buy one.
- Luke 22:37 (AV) For I say unto you, that this that is Written must yet be accomplished in Me, And He was reckoned among the transgressors: for the things concerning Me have an end.
- Luke 22:37 (NKJV) For I say to you that this which is Written must still be accomplished in Me: And He was numbered with the transgressors. For the things concerning Me have an end.
- Isaiah 53:12 Therefore will I divide Him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong; because He hath poured out His soul unto death: and He was numbered with the transgressors; and He bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.
- Luke 22:38 (AV) And they said, Lord, behold, here *are* two swords. And He said unto them, It is enough.

- Luke 22:38 (NKJV) So they said, Lord, look, here *are* two swords. And He said to them, It is enough.
- Luke 22:39 (AV) And He came out, and went, as He was wont, to the mount of Olives; and His disciples also followed Him.
- Luke 22:39 (NKJV) Coming out, He went to the Mount of Olives, as He was accustomed, and His disciples also followed Him.
- Luke 22:40 (AV) And when He was at the place, He said unto them, Pray that ye enter not into temptation.
- Luke 22:40 (NKJV) When He came to the place, He said to them, Pray that you may not enter into temptation.
- Luke 22:32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.
- Luke 22:41 (AV) And He was withdrawn from them about a stone's cast, and kneeled down, and prayed,
- Luke 22:41 (NKJV) And He was withdrawn from them about a stone's throw, and He knelt down and prayed,
- Luke 22:42 (AV) Saying, Father, if Thou be willing, remove this cup from Me: nevertheless not My will, but Thine, be done.
- Luke 22:42 (NKJV) saying, Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done.
- Matthew 16:23 But He turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind Me, Satan: thou art an offence unto Me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.
- Luke 22:43 (AV) And there appeared an angel unto Him from heaven, strengthening Him.
- Luke 22:43 (NKJV) Then an angel appeared to Him from heaven, strengthening Him.
- Luke 22:44 (AV) And being in an agony He prayed more earnestly: and His sweat was as it were great drops of Blood falling down to the ground.
- Luke 22:44 (NKJV) And being in agony, He prayed more earnestly. Then His sweat became like great drops of Blood falling down to the ground.
- Explained how the blood pressure being really high it can cause the blood to flow out with the sweat.
- Luke 22:45 (AV) And when He rose up from prayer, and was come to His disciples, He found them sleeping for sorrow,
- Luke 22:45 (NKJV) When He rose up from prayer, and had come to His disciples, He found them sleeping from sorrow.
- Luke 22:46 (AV) And said unto them, Why sleep ye? rise and pray, lest ye enter into temptation.
- Luke 22:46 (NKJV) Then He said to them, Why do you sleep? Rise and pray, lest you enter into temptation.

- Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.
- Luke 22:47 (AV) And while He yet spake, behold a multitude, and he that was called Judas, one of the twelve, went before them, and drew near unto Jesus to kiss Him.
- Luke 22:47 (NKJV) And while He was still speaking, behold, a multitude; and he who was called Judas, one of the twelve, went before them and drew near to Jesus to kiss Him.
- Matthew 26:43 And He came and found them asleep again: for their eyes were heavy.
- Luke 22:48 (AV) But Jesus said unto him, Judas, betrayest thou the Son of Man with a kiss?
- Luke 22:48 (NKJV) But Jesus said to him, Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?
- Luke 22:49 (AV) When they which were about Him saw what would follow, they said unto Him, Lord, shall we smite with the sword?
- Luke 22:49 (NKJV) When those around Him saw what was going to happen, they said to Him, Lord, shall we strike with the sword?
- Daniel 10 Referred to the spiritual battle in the heavenlies.
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Luke 22:50 (AV) And one of them smote the servant of the high priest, and cut off his right ear.
- Luke 22:50 (NKJV) And one of them struck the servant of the high priest and cut off his right ear.
- Luke 22:51 (AV) And Jesus answered and said, Suffer ye thus far. And He touched his ear, and healed him.
- Luke 22:51 (NKJV) But Jesus answered and said, Permit even this. And He touched his ear and healed him.
- Matthew 5:44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;
- Luke 22:52 (AV) Then Jesus said unto the chief priests, and captains of the temple, and the elders, which were come to Him, Be ye come out, as against a thief, with swords and staves?
- Luke 22:52 (NKJV) Then Jesus said to the chief priests, captains of the temple, and the elders who had come to Him, Have you come out, as against a robber, with swords and clubs?
- Luke 22:53 (AV) When I was daily with you in the temple, ye stretched forth no hands against Me: but this is your hour, and the power of darkness.

- Luke 22:53 (NKJV) When I was with you daily in the temple, you did not try to seize Me. But this is your hour, and the power of darkness.
- Luke 22:54 (AV) Then took they Him, and led *Him*, and brought Him into the high priest's house. And Peter followed afar off.
- Luke 22:54 (NKJV) Having arrested Him, they led *Him* and brought Him into the high priest's house. But Peter followed at a distance.
- Luke 22:33 And he said unto Him, Lord, I am ready to go with Thee, both into prison, and to death.
- Luke 22:55 (AV) And when they had kindled a fire in the midst of the hall, and were set down together, Peter sat down among them.
- Luke 22:55 (NKJV) Now when they had kindled a fire in the midst of the courtyard and sat down together, Peter sat among them.
- Luke 22:56 (AV) But a certain maid beheld him as he sat by the fire, and earnestly looked upon him, and said, This man was also with Him.
- Luke 22:56 (NKJV) And a certain servant girl, seeing him as he sat by the fire, looked intently at him and said, This man was also with Him.
- Luke 22:57 (AV) And he denied him, saying, Woman, I know Him not.
- Luke 22:57 (NKJV) But he denied Him, saying, Woman, I do not know Him.
- Acts 26:10,11 Which thing I (Saul/Paul) also did in Jerusalem: and many of the saints did I shut up in prison, having received authority from the chief priests; and when they were put to death, I gave my voice against them. 11 And I punished them oft in every synagogue, and compelled them to blaspheme; and being exceedingly mad against them, I persecuted them even unto strange cities.
- Luke 22:58 (AV) And after a little while another saw him, and said, Thou art also of them. And Peter said, Man, I am not.
- Luke 22:58 (NKJV) And after a little while another saw him and said, You also are of them. But Peter said, Man, I am not!
- Luke 22:59 (AV) And about the space of one hour after another confidently affirmed, saying, Of a truth this *fellow* also was with Him: for he is a Galilaean.
- Luke 22:59 (NKJV) Then after about an hour had passed, another confidently affirmed, saying, Surely this *fellow* also was with Him, for he is a Galilean.
- Luke 22:60 (AV) And Peter said, Man, I know not what thou sayest. And immediately, while he yet spake, the cock crew.
- Luke 22:60 (NKJV) But Peter said, Man, I do not know what you are saying! Immediately, while he was still speaking, the rooster crowed.
- Luke 22:61 (AV) And the Lord turned, and looked upon Peter. And Peter remembered the Word of the Lord, how He had said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny Me thrice.
- Luke 22:61 (NKJV) And the Lord turned and looked at Peter. And Peter

- remembered the Word of the Lord, how He had said to him, Before the rooster crows, you will deny Me three times.
- Luke 22:62 (AV) And Peter went out, and wept bitterly.
- Luke 22:62 (NKJV) So Peter went out and wept bitterly.
- Luke 22:63 (AV) And the men that held Jesus mocked Him, and smote Him.
- Luke 22:63 (NKJV) Now the men who held Jesus mocked Him and beat Him.
- Luke 22:64 (AV) And when they had blindfolded Him, they struck Him on the face, and asked Him, saying, Prophesy, who is it that smote Thee?
- Luke 22:64 (NKJV) And having blindfolded Him, they struck Him on the face and asked Him, saying, Prophesy! Who is the one who struck You?
- Luke 22:65 (AV) And many other things blasphemously spake they against Him.
- Luke 22:65 (NKJV) And many other things they blasphemously spoke against Him.
- Matthew 12:24 But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, This fellow doth not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils.
- Luke 22:66 (AV) And as soon as it was day, the elders of the people and the chief priests and the scribes came together, and led Him into their council, saying,
- Luke 22:66 (NKJV) As soon as it was day, the elders of the people, both chief priests and scribes, came together and led Him into their council, saying,
- Matthew 4:3,6 And when the tempter came to Him, he said, If Thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread., 6 And saith unto Him, If Thou be the Son of God, cast Thyself down: for it is written, He shall give His angels charge concerning Thee: and in their hands they shall bear Thee up, lest at any time Thou dash Thy foot against a stone.
- John 8:4-11 They say unto Him, Master, this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act. 5 Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest Thou? 6 This they said, tempting Him, that they might have to accuse Him. But Jesus stooped down, and with His finger wrote on the ground, as though He heard them not. 7 So when they continued asking Him, He lifted up Himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her. 8 And again He stooped down, and wrote on the ground. 9 And they which heard it, being convicted by their own conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, even unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst. 10 When Jesus had lifted up Himself, and saw none but the woman, He said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee? 11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- Luke 22:67 (AV) Art Thou the Christ? tell us. And He said unto them, If I tell

- you, ye will not believe:
- Luke 22:67 (NKJV) If You are the Christ, tell us. But He said to them, If I tell you, you will by no means believe.
- John 10:38 But if I do, though ye believe not Me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in Me, and I in Him.
- Luke 22:68 (AV) And if I also ask *you*, ye will not answer Me, nor let *Me* go.
- Luke 22:68 (NKJV) And if I also ask *you*, you will by no means answer Me or let *Me* go.
- Mark 11:30-33 The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men? answer Me. 31 And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; He will say, Why then did ye not believe him? 32 But if we shall say, Of men; they feared the people: for all men counted John, that he was a prophet indeed. 33 And they answered and said unto Jesus, We cannot tell. And Jesus answering saith unto them, Neither do I tell you by what authority I do these things.
- Luke 22:69 (AV) Hereafter shall the Son of Man sit on the right hand of the power of God.
- Luke 22:69 (NKJV) Hereafter the Son of Man will sit on the right hand of the power of God.
- 1 Corinthians 15:25,26 For He must reign, till He hath put all enemies under His feet. 26 The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.
- Luke 22:70 (AV) Then said they all, Art Thou then the Son of God? And He said unto them, Ye say that I am.
- Luke 22:70 (NKJV) Then they all said, Are You then the Son of God? So He said to them, You *rightly* say that I am.
- Luke 22:71 (AV) And they said, What need we any further witness? for we ourselves have heard of His own mouth.
- Luke 22:71 (NKJV) And they said, What further testimony do we need? For we have heard it ourselves from His own mouth.
- Matthew 21:13 And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;
- Mark 14:38 Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit truly is ready, but the flesh is weak.
