## Refusal To Believe Jesus - Luke 23

- Luke 22:3 Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.
- Mark 16:15-18 And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Referred to persecutions of Christians over the centuries.
- Luke 23:1 (AV) & the whole multitude of them arose, and led Him unto Pilate.
- Luke 23:1 (NKJV) Then the whole multitude of them arose and led Him to Pilate.
- Leviticus 19:15 Ye shall do no unrighteousness in judgment: thou shalt not respect the person of the poor, nor honour the person of the mighty: but in righteousness shalt thou judge thy neighbour.
- Luke 23:2 (AV) And they began to accuse Him, saying, We found this *Fellow* perverting the nation, and forbidding to give tribute to Caesar, saying that He Himself is Christ a King.
- Luke 23:2 (NKJV) And they began to accuse Him, saying, We found this *Fellow* perverting the nation, and forbidding to pay taxes to Caesar, saying that He Himself is Christ, a King.
- Matthew 22:17-21 Tell us therefore, What thinkest Thou? Is it lawful to give tribute unto Caesar, or not? 18 But Jesus perceived their wickedness, and said, Why tempt ye Me, ye hypocrites? 19 Shew Me the tribute money. And they brought unto Him a penny. 20 And He saith unto them, Whose is this image and superscription? 21 They say unto Him, Caesar's. Then saith He unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's; and unto God the things that are God's.
- Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Matthew 2:1,2 Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, 2 Saying, Where is He that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen His star in the east, and are come to worship Him.
- Luke 23:3 (AV) And Pilate asked Him, saying, Art Thou the King of the Jews? And He answered him and said, Thou sayest *it*.

- Luke 23:3 (NKJV) Then Pilate asked Him, saying, Are You the King of the Jews? He answered him and said, *It is as* you say.
- Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?
- Luke 23:4 (AV) Then said Pilate to the chief priests and *to* the people, I find no fault in this Man.
- Luke 23:4 (NKJV) So Pilate said to the chief priests and the crowd, I find no fault in this Man.
- John 10:37,38 If I do not the works of My Father, believe Me not. 38 But if I do, though ye believe not Me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father *is* in Me, and I in Him.
- Referred to Jesus raising Lazarus, Jairus' daughter, the widow's son.
- Referred to Jesus Healing many & doing Miracles.
- Matthew 8:4 And Jesus saith unto him, See thou tell no man; but go thy way, shew thyself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.
- Luke 17:12 And as He entered into a certain village, there met Him ten men that were lepers, which stood afar off: 13 And they lifted up their voices, and said, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us. 14 And when He saw them, He said unto them, Go shew yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed. 15 And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God,
- Mark 11:17 And He taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Luke 23:5 (AV) And they were the more fierce, saying, He stirreth up the people, teaching throughout all Jewry, beginning from Galilee to this place.

  Luke 23:5 (NKJV) But they were the more fierce, saying, He stirs up the people, teaching throughout all Judea, beginning from Galilee to this place.
- Matthew 1:21 And she shall bring forth a Son, and thou shalt call His Name JESUS: for He shall save His people from their sins.
- Luke 23:6 (AV) When Pilate heard of Galilee, he asked whether the Man were a Galilaean.

  Luke 23:6 (NKJV) When Pilate heard of Galilee, he asked if the Man were a Galilean.
- Luke 23:7 (AV) And as soon as he knew that He belonged unto Herods jurisdiction, he sent Him to Herod, who himself also was at Jerusalem at that time.

  Luke 23:7 (NKJV) And as soon as he knew that He belonged to Herods jurisdiction, he sent Him to Herod, who was also in Jerusalem at that time.
- Luke 23:8 (AV) And when Herod saw Jesus, he was exceeding glad: for he was desirous to see Him of a long *season*, because he had heard many

things of Him; and he hoped to have seen some miracle done by Him.

- Luke 23:8 (NKJV) Now when Herod saw Jesus, he was exceedingly glad; for he had desired for a long *time* to see Him, because he had heard many things about Him, and he hoped to see some miracle done by Him.
- Explained how the kingdom of Israel was split among Herod Tetrark's sons.
- Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
- Hebrews 5:12-14 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. 13 For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the Word of righteousness: for he is a babe. 14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Luke 23:9 (AV) Then he questioned with Him in many words; but He answered him nothing.

  Luke 23:9 (NKJV) Then he questioned Him with many words, but He answered him nothing.
- Matthew 14 Summarized of Herod beheadding John the Baptist.
- Luke 23:10 (AV) And the chief priests and scribes stood and vehemently accused Him.

  Luke 23:10 (NKJV) And the chief priests and scribes stood and vehemently accused Him.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:22 Abstain from all appearance of evil.
- Luke 23:11 (AV) And Herod with his men of war set Him at nought, and mocked *Him*, and arrayed Him in a gorgeous robe, and sent Him again to Pilate.
- Luke 23:11 (NKJV) Then Herod, with his men of war, treated Him with contempt and mocked *Him*, arrayed Him in a gorgeous robe, and sent Him back to Pilate.
- Luke 23:12 (AV) And the same day Pilate and Herod were made friends together: for before they were at enmity between themselves.
- Luke 23:12 (NKJV) That very day Pilate and Herod became friends with each other, for previously they had been at enmity with each other.
- Luke 23:13 (AV) And Pilate, when he had called together the chief priests and the rulers and the people,
- Luke 23:13 (NKJV) Then Pilate, when he had called together the chief priests, the rulers, and the people,
- Luke 23:14 (AV) Said unto them, Ye have brought this Man unto me, as one that perverteth the people: and, behold, I, having examined *Him* before you, have found no fault in this Man touching those things whereof ye accuse Him:
- Luke 23:14 (NKJV) said to them, You have brought this Man to me, as one who misleads the people. And indeed, having examined *Him* in your

- presence, I have found no fault in this Man concerning those things of which you accuse Him;
- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
- Luke 23:15 (AV) No, nor yet Herod: for I sent you to him; and, Io, nothing worthy of death is done unto Him.
- Luke 23:15 (NKJV) no, neither did Herod, for I sent you back to him; and indeed nothing deserving of death has been done by Him.
- Luke 23:16 (AV) I will therefore chastise Him, and release Him.
- Luke 23:16 (NKJV) I will therefore chastise Him and release *Him*.
- Luke 23:17 (AV) (For of necessity he must release one unto them at the feast.)

  Luke 23:17 (NKJV) (for it was necessary for him to release one to them at the feast).
- Luke 23:18 (AV) And they cried out all at once, saying, Away with this *Man*, and release unto us Barabbas:
- Luke 23:18 (NKJV) And they all cried out at once, saying, Away with this *Man*, and release to us (Jesus) Barabbas,
- Matthew 27:17 Therefore when they were gathered together, Pilate said unto them, Whom will ye that I release unto you? Barabbas, or Jesus which is called Christ?
- Luke 23:19 (AV) (Who for a certain sedition made in the city, and for murder, was cast into prison.)
- Luke 23:19 (NKJV) who had been thrown into prison for a certain rebellion made in the city, and for murder.
- Luke 23:20 (AV) Pilate therefore, willing to release Jesus, spake again to them.

  Luke 23:20 (NKJV) Pilate, therefore, wishing to release Jesus, again called out to them.
- Acts 19:34,40 But when they knew that he was a Jew, all with one voice about the space of two hours cried out, Great is Diana of the Ephesians. 40 For we are in danger to be called in question for this day's uproar, there being no cause whereby we may give an account of this concourse.
- Luke 23:21 (AV) But they cried, saying, Crucify Him, crucify Him.
- Luke 23:21 (NKJV) But they shouted, saying, Crucify Him, crucify Him!
- Luke 23:22 (AV) And he said unto them the third time, Why, what evil hath He done? I have found no cause of death in Him: I will therefore chastise Him, and let *Him* go.
- Luke 23:22 (NKJV) Then he said to them the third time, Why, what evil has He done? I have found no reason for death in Him. I will therefore chastise Him and let *Him* go.
- Luke 23:23 (AV) And they were instant with loud voices, requiring that He might be crucified. And the voices of them and of the chief priests

- they were insistent, demanding with loud voices that He be crucified. And the voices of these men and of the chief priests prevailed.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Luke 23:24 (AV) And Pilate gave sentence that it should be as they required.
- Luke 23:24 (NKJV) So Pilate gave sentence that it should be as they requested.
- **Exodus 32 Referred to Moses interceding for sinful Israel.**
- Luke 23:25 (AV) And he released unto them him that for sedition and murder was cast into prison, whom they had desired; but he delivered Jesus to their will.

  Luke 23:25 (NKJV) And
  - he released to them the one they requested, who for rebellion and murder had been thrown into prison; but he delivered Jesus to their will.
- Luke 23:26 (AV) And as they led Him away, they laid hold upon one Simon, a Cyrenian, coming out of the country, and on him they laid the cross, that he might bear *it* after Jesus.
- Luke 23:26 (NKJV) Now as they led Him away, they laid hold of a certain man, Simon a Cyrenian, who was coming from the country, and on him they laid the cross that he might bear *it* after Jesus.
- Luke 4 Referred to Jesus tempted yet not miss-using His priviledge.
- Luke 23:27 (AV) And there followed Him a great company of people, and of women, which also bewailed and lamented Him.
- Luke 23:27 (NKJV) And a great multitude of the people followed Him, and women who also mourned and lamented Him.
- Luke 23:28 (AV) But Jesus turning unto them said, Daughters of Jerusalem, weep not for Me, but weep for yourselves, and for your children.
- Luke 23:28 (NKJV) But Jesus, turning to them, said, Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for Me, but weep for yourselves and for your children.
- Luke 23:29 (AV) For, behold, the days are coming, in the which they shall say, Blessed *are* the barren, and the wombs that never bare, and the paps which never gave suck.
- Luke 23:29 (NKJV) For indeed the days are coming in which they will say, Blessed *are* the barren, wombs that never bore, and breasts which never nursed!
- Mark 13:14-16 But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains: 15 And let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house, neither enter therein, to take any thing out of his house: 16 And let him that is in the field not turn back again for to take up his garment.

- Luke 23:30 (AV) Then shall they begin to say to the mountains, Fall on us; and to the hills, Cover us.
- Luke 23:30 (NKJV) Then they will begin to say to the mountains, Fall on us! and to the hills, Cover us!
- Luke 23:31 (AV) For if they do these things in a green tree, what shall be done in the dry?
- Luke 23:31 (NKJV) For if they do these things in the green wood, what will be done in the dry?
- Luke 23:32 (AV) And there were also two other, malefactors, led with Him to be put to death.

  Luke 23:32 (NKJV) There were also two others, criminals, led with Him to be put to death.
- Luke 23:33 (AV) And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left.
- Luke 23:33 (NKJV) And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other on the left.
- Luke 23:34 (AV) Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.
- Luke 23:34 (NKJV) Then Jesus said, Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do. And they divided His garments and cast lots.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Acts 15:1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.
- Mark 16:9 Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.
- Philippians 3:2 Beware of dogs, beware of evil workers, beware of the concision. 3 For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the Spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh.
- Mark 7:13 Making the Word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- Luke 23:35 (AV) And the people stood beholding. And the rulers also with them derided *Him*, saying, He saved others; let Him save Himself, if He be Christ, the Chosen of God.
- Luke 23:35 (NKJV) And the people stood looking on. But even the rulers with them sneered, saying, He saved others; let Him save Himself if He is the Christ, the Chosen of God.
- 2 Kings 1:10 (12) And Elijah answered and said to the captain of fifty, If I be a man of God, then let fire come down from heaven, and consume thee and

- thy fifty. And there came down fire from heaven, and consumed him and his fifty.
- 2 Kings 2:24 And he turned back, and looked on them, and cursed them in the name of the LORD. And there came forth two she bears out of the wood, and tare forty and two children of them.
- Mark 8:33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.
- 2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's "in perils of" chapter.
- Job 1:21,22 21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD. 22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.
- Luke 23:36 (AV) And the soldiers also mocked Him, coming to Him, and offering Him vinegar,
- Luke 23:36 (NKJV) The soldiers also mocked Him, coming and offering Him sour wine,
- Luke 23:37 (AV) And saying, If Thou be the King of the Jews, save Thyself.
- Luke 23:37 (NKJV) and saying, If You are the King of the Jews, save Yourself.
- Acts 10:19-21 While Peter thought on the vision, the Spirit said unto him, Behold, three men seek thee. 20 Arise therefore, and get thee down, and go with them, doubting nothing: for I have sent them. 21 Then Peter went down to the men which were sent unto him from Cornelius; and said, Behold, I am he whom ye seek: what is the cause wherefore ye are come?
- Luke 23:38 (AV) And a superscription also was written over Him in letters of Greek, and Latin, and Hebrew, THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.
- Luke 23:38 (NKJV) And an inscription also was written over Him in letters of Greek, Latin, and Hebrew: THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.
- Luke 23:39 (AV) And one of the malefactors which were hanged railed on Him, saying, If Thou be Christ, save Thyself and us.
- Luke 23:39 (NKJV) Then one of the criminals who were hanged blasphemed Him, saying, If You are the Christ, save Yourself and us.
- Luke 23:40 (AV) But the other answering rebuked him, saying, Dost not thou fear God, seeing thou art in the same condemnation?
- Luke 23:40 (NKJV) But the other, answering, rebuked him, saying, Do you not even fear God, seeing you are under the same condemnation?
- Luke 23:41 (AV) And we indeed justly; for we receive the due reward of our deeds: but this Man hath done nothing amiss.
- Luke 23:41 (NKJV) And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong.
- Luke 23:42 (AV) And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when Thou

- comest into thy kingdom.
- Luke 23:42 (NKJV) Then he said to Jesus, Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom.
- Luke 23:43 (AV) And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with Me in paradise.
- Luke 23:43 (NKJV) And Jesus said to him, Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- John 14:2,3 In My Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- Luke 23:44 (AV) And it was about the sixth hour, and there was a darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour.
- Luke 23:44 (NKJV) Now it was about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour.
- Luke 23:45 (AV) And the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was rent in the midst.

- Genesis 4:4 And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering:
- Luke 23:47 (AV) Now when the centurion saw what was done, He glorified God, saying, Certainly this was a Righteous Man.
- Luke 23:47 (NKJV) So when the centurion saw what had happened, he glorified God, saying, Certainly this was a Righteous Man!
- Colossians 2:8 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.
- Luke 23:48 (AV) And all the people that came together to that sight, beholding the things which were done, smote their breasts, and returned.
- Luke 23:48 (NKJV) And the whole crowd who came together to that sight, seeing what had been done, beat their breasts and returned.
- Luke 23:49 (AV) And all His acquaintance, and the women that followed Him

- from Galilee, stood afar off, beholding these things.
- Luke 23:49 (NKJV) But all His acquaintances, and the women who followed Him from Galilee, stood at a distance, watching these things.
- Luke 23:50 (AV) And, behold, *there was* a man named Joseph, a counsellor; and he was a good man, and a just:
- Luke 23:50 (NKJV) Now behold, *there was* a man named Joseph, a council member, a good and just man.
- Luke 23:51 (AV) (The same had not consented to the counsel and deed of them;) *he was* of Arimathaea, a city of the Jews: who also himself waited for the kingdom of God.
- Luke 23:51 (NKJV) He had not consented to their decision and deed. *He was* from Arimathea, a city of the Jews, who himself was also waiting for the kingdom of God.
- John 3:4,7 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? 7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Luke 23:52 (AV) This man went unto Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus.
- Luke 23:52 (NKJV) This man went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus.
- Luke 23:53 (AV) And he took It down, and wrapped It in linen, and laid It in a sepulchre that was hewn in stone, wherein never man before was laid.
- Luke 23:53 (NKJV) Then he took It down, wrapped It in linen, and laid It in a tomb *that was* hewn out of the rock, where no one had ever lain before.
- Luke 23:54 (AV) And that day was the Preparation, and the Sabbath drew on.
- Luke 23:54 (NKJV) That day was the Preparation, and the Sabbath drew near.
- Luke 23:55 (AV) And the women also, which came with Him from Galilee, followed after, and beheld the sepulchre, and how His Body was laid.
- Luke 23:55 (NKJV) And the women who had come with Him from Galilee followed after, and they observed the tomb and how His Body was laid.
- Luke 23:56 (AV) And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the Sabbath day according to the commandment.
- Luke 23:56 (NKJV) Then they returned and prepared spices and fragrant oils. And they rested on the Sabbath according to the commandment.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Daniel 10 Referred to the spiritual battle in the heavenlies.
