

Victory In Jesus - Luke 24

Summarized of salvation by Jesus Who died & rose again to pay for mankind's sin.

John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

Luke 24:1-53 (AV) & (NKJV)

Luke 24:1 (AV) Now upon the first *day* of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared, and certain *others* with them.

Luke 24:1 (NKJV) Now on the first *day* of the week, very early in the morning, they, and certain *other women* with them, came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared.

Luke 24:2 (AV) And they found the stone rolled away from the sepulchre.

Luke 24:2 (NKJV) But they found the stone rolled away from the tomb.

Mark 16:3 And they said among themselves, Who shall roll us away the stone from the door of the sepulchre?

Luke 24:3 (AV) And they entered in, and found not the body of the Lord Jesus.

Luke 24:3 (NKJV) Then they went in and did not find the body of the Lord Jesus.

John 20:7 And the napkin, that was about his head, not lying with the linen clothes, but wrapped together in a place by itself.

Luke 24:4 (AV) And it came to pass, as they were much perplexed thereabout, behold, two men stood by them in shining garments:

Luke 24:5 (AV) And as they were afraid, and bowed down *their* faces to the earth, they said unto them, Why seek ye the living among the dead?

Luke 24:5 (NKJV) Then, as they were afraid and bowed *their* faces to the earth, they said to them, Why do you seek the living among the dead?

Matthew 27:64 Command therefore that the sepulchre be made sure until the third day, lest His disciples come by night, and steal Him away, and say unto the people, He is risen from the dead: so the last error shall be worse than the first.

Luke 24:6 (AV) He is not here, but is risen: remember how He spake unto you when He was yet in Galilee,

Luke 24:8 (AV) And they remembered His Words,

Luke 24:9 (AV) And returned from the sepulchre, and told all these things unto the eleven, and to all the rest.

Luke 24:11 (AV) And their words seemed to them as idle tales, and they believed them not.

Luke 24:11 (NKJV) And their words seemed to them like idle tales, and they did not believe them.

Mark 16:14 Afterward He appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen Him after He was risen.

Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

Luke 24:12 (AV) Then arose Peter, and ran unto the sepulchre; and stooping down, he beheld the linen clothes laid by themselves, and departed, wondering in himself at that which was come to pass.

Luke 24:12 (NKJV) But Peter arose and ran to the tomb; and stooping down, he saw the linen cloths lying by themselves; and he departed, marveling to himself at what had happened.

John 20:4 So they ran both together: and the other disciple (John) did outrun Peter, and came first to the sepulchre.

John 11:44 And he (Lazarus) that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus

saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

Luke 24:13 (AV) And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem *about* threescore furlongs.

Luke 24:17 (AV) And He said unto them, What manner of communications *are* these that ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are sad?

Luke 24:17 (NKJV) And He said to them, What kind of conversation *is* this that you have with one another as you walk and are sad?

Luke 24:18 (AV) And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering said unto Him, Art Thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days?

Luke 24:18 (NKJV) Then the one whose name was Cleopas answered and said to Him, Are You the only stranger in Jerusalem, and have You not known the things which happened there in these days?

Luke 24:19 (AV) And He said unto them, What things? And they said unto Him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, Which was a Prophet mighty in deed and Word before God and all the people:

Luke 24:19 (NKJV) And He said to them, What things? So they said to Him, The things concerning Jesus of Nazareth, Who was a Prophet mighty in deed and Word before God and all the people,

Mark 1:22 And they were astonished at His doctrine: for He taught them as One that had authority, and not as the scribes.

Mark 12:24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the Scriptures, neither the power of God?

John 6:15 When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take Him by force, to make Him a king, He departed again into a mountain

Himself alone.

Luke 24:20 (AV) And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to be condemned to death, and have crucified Him.

Luke 24:20 (NKJV) and how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to be condemned to death, and crucified Him.

Matthew 27:20 But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus.

Luke 24:21 (AV) But we trusted that it had been He which should have redeemed Israel: and beside all this, to day is the third day since these things were done.

Luke 24:24 (AV) And certain of them which were with us went to the sepulchre, and found *it* even so as the women had said: but Him they saw not.

Luke 24:24 (NKJV) And certain of those *who were* with us went to the tomb and found *it* just as the women had said; but Him they did not see.

Luke 24:25 (AV) Then He said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken:

Luke 24:25 (NKJV) Then He said to them, O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken!

Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently

Luke 24:35 (AV) And they told what things *were done* in the way, and how He was known of them in breaking of bread.

Luke 24:35 (NKJV) And they told about the things *that had happened* on the road, and how He was known to them in the breaking of bread.

Luke 24:36 (AV) And as they thus spake, Jesus Himself stood in the midst of them, and saith unto them, Peace *be* unto you.

Luke 24:36 (NKJV) Now as they said these things, Jesus Himself stood in the midst of them, and said to them, Peace to you.

Mark 16:9 Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, He appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom He had cast seven devils.

John 20:19 Then the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, Peace be unto you.

Acts 20:7 And upon the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight.

Luke 24:43 (AV) And He took *it*, and did eat before them.

**Luke 24:44 (AV) And He said unto them, These *are* the Words which I spake
unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which
were written in the law of Moses, and *in* the Prophets, and *in* the Psalms,
concerning Me.**

**Luke 24:44 (NKJV) Then He said to them, These *are* the Words which I spoke
to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which

**2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from

More Service Notes:

Isaiah 53:1-12 Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed? 2 For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: He hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see Him, *there is* no beauty that we should desire Him. 3 He is despised and rejected of men; a Man of sorrows, and acquainted with

grief: and we hid as it were *our* faces from Him; He was despised, and we esteemed Him not. 4 Surely He hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. 5 But He *was* wounded for our transgressions, *He was* bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed. 6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on Him the iniquity of us all. 7 He was oppressed, and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth: He is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so He openeth not His mouth. 8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare His generation? for He was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was He stricken. 9 And He made His grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death; because He had done no violence, neither *was any* deceit in His mouth. 10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He hath put *Him* to grief: when Thou shalt make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see *His* seed, He shall prolong *His* days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand. 11 He shall see of the travail of His soul, *and* shall be satisfied: by His knowledge shall My righteous Servant justify many; for He shall bear their iniquities. 12 Therefore will I divide Him *a portion* with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong; because He hath poured out His soul unto death: and He was numbered with the transgressors; and He bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Daniel 9:26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for Himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof *shall be* with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

Hosea 6:2 After two days will He revive us: in the third day He will raise us up, and we shall live in His sight.

Psalms 22:1-31 « To the chief Musician upon Aijeleth Shahar, A Psalm of David. » My God, My God, why hast Thou forsaken Me? *why art Thou* so far from helping Me, *and from* the Words of My roaring? 2 O My God, I cry in the daytime, but Thou hearest not; and in the night season, and am not silent. 3 But Thou *art* Holy, *O Thou* that inhabitest the praises of Israel. 4 Our fathers trusted in Thee: they trusted, and Thou didst deliver them. 5 They cried unto Thee, and were delivered: they trusted in Thee, and were not confounded. 6 But I *am* a Worm, and no Man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people. 7 All they that see Me laugh Me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, *saying*, 8 He trusted on the LORD *that* He would deliver Him: let Him deliver Him, seeing He delighted in

Him. 9 But Thou *art* He that took Me out of the womb: Thou didst make Me hope *when I was* upon My mother's breasts. 10 I was cast upon Thee from the womb: Thou *art* My God from My mother's belly. 11 Be not far from M; for trouble *is* near; for *there is* none to help. 12 Many bulls have compassed Me: strong *bulls* of Bashan have beset Me round. 13 They gaped upon Me *with* their mouths, *as* a ravening and a roaring lion. 14 I am poured out like water, and all My bones are out of joint: My heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of My bowels. 15 My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and My tongue cleaveth to My jaws; and Thou hast brought Me into the dust of death. 16 For dogs have compassed Me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed Me: they pierced My hands and My feet. 17 I may tell all My bones: they look *and* stare upon Me. 18 They part My garments among them, and cast lots upon My vesture. 19 But be not Thou far from Me, O LORD: O My Strength, haste Thee to help Me. 20 Deliver My soul from the sword; My darling from the power of the dog. 21 Save Me from the lion's mouth: for Thou hast heard Me from the horns of the unicorns. 22 I will declare Thy Name unto My brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise Thee. 23 Ye that fear the LORD, praise Him; all ye the seed of Jacob, glorify Him; and fear Him, all ye the seed of Israel. 24 For He hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath He hid His face from Him; but when He cried unto Him, He heard. 25 My praise *shall be* of Thee in the great congregation: I will pay My vows before them that fear Him. 26 The meek shall eat and be satisfied: they shall praise the LORD that seek Him: your heart shall live for ever. 27 All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the LORD: and all the kindreds of the nations shall worship before Thee. 28 For the kingdom *is* the LORD'S: and He *is* the Governor among the nations. 29 All *they that be* fat upon earth shall eat and worship: all they that go down to the dust shall bow before Him: and none can keep alive his own soul. 30 A seed shall serve Him; it shall be accounted to the Lord for a generation. 31 They shall come, and shall declare His righteousness unto a people that shall be born, that He hath done *this*.
