## The Spirit of Hatred Galatians 5

In the basic human emotions – love & hatred are main ones. While you will find them to some extent in religions and cultures; some are worse than others. When religion and culture advocates "honour killings" because their pride or honour has been slighted; it is based on hatred, and not love.

Both love and hate are mentioned extensively in Bible. Amos 5:15 - Hate the evil, and love the good, and establish judgment in the gate: it may be that the LORD God of hosts will be gracious unto the remnant of Joseph.

If people would hate evil, there would be fewer problems all around. Even though hatred is not in Our Lord Jesus Christ's bad list; it is an underlying factor in most of them. Mark 7:21-23 - For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, & defile the man. But Paul does mention it. Galatians 5:19-21 - Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred (2189), variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that

they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

The other examples are translated as enmity - Luke 23:12 - And the same day Pilate and Herod were made friends together: for before they were at enmity between themselves.

Romans 8:7 - Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

Ephesians 2:14-17 - For he is our peace, who hath made both 1 & hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us; Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace; & that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby: And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, & to them that were nigh.

James 4:4 - Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

In the New Testament there are 2 other words of hate & hatred.

Romans 1:30 - Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents,

1) to hate, pursue with hatred, detest 2) to be hated, detested

In the Old Testament, hatred like war was expressed mainly on the physical plane. But in the New Testament, we deal with it on the spiritual level. Ephesians 4:26-27 - Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath: Neither give place to the devil.

Let's take a look at some examples of hatred mentioned in the New Testament. Matthew 5:43-44 Ye have heard that it hath been said, Thou shalt love thy neighbour, and hate <3404> thine enemy. But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate <3404> you, & pray for them which despitefully use you, & persecute you; Matthew 6:24 No man can serve 2 masters: for either he will hate the 1, and love the other; or else he will hold to the 1, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon. Matthew 10:22 And ye shall be hated of all *men* for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved. Matthew 24:9-10 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake. And then shall many be offended, & shall betray one another, and shall hate one another. Mark 13:13 And ye shall be hated <3404> of all *men* for my name's sake: but he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

Luke 1:71 That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate <3404> us;

Luke 6:22,27 Blessed are ye, when men shall hate <3404> you, and when they shall separate you from their company, and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of man's sake. But I say unto you which hear, Love your enemies, do good to them which hate <3404> you, Luke 14:26 If any man come to me, & hate not his father, mother, wife, children, brethren, sisters, yea, & his own life also, he can't be my disciple. Luke 16:13 No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate <3404> the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Luke 19:14 But his citizens hated  $\leq 3404 >$  him, and sent a message after him, saying, We will not have this *man* to reign over us.

Luke 21:17 And ye shall be hated <3404> of all men for my name's sake.

John 3:20 For every one that doeth evil hateth <3404> the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. John 7:7 The world cannot hate you; but me it hateth <3404>, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are evil. John 12:25 He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth <3404> his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.

John 15:18-19 If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before *it hated* you. If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world,

therefore the world hateth you. John 15:23-25 He that hateth me hateth my Father also. If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father. But *this cometh to pass*, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated <3404> me without a cause.

John 17:14 I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated <3404> them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

Romans 7:15 For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate <3404>, that do I.

Romans 9:13 As it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated.

Ephesians 5:29 For no man ever yet hated <3404> his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the church:

Titus 3:3 For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, *and* hating <3404> one another.

Hebrews 1:9 Thou hast loved righteousness, & hated iniquity; therefore God, thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

1 John 2:9,11 He that saith he is in the light, and hateth <3404> his brother, is in darkness even until now. But he that hateth <3404> his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes.

1 John 3:13,15 Marvel not, my brethren, if the world hate <3404> you. Whosoever hateth <3404> his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him. 1 John 4:20 If a man say, I love God, and hateth <3404> his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? Jude 1:23 And others save with fear, pulling *them* out of the fire; hating <3404> even the garment spotted by the flesh.

Revelation 2:6, 15 But this thou hast, that thou hatest <3404> the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate <3404>. So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate <3404>.

Revelation 17:16 And the ten horns which thou sawest upon the beast, these shall hate  $\leq 3404 \geq$  the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire.

Revelation 18:2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.
