Acts 10:9-10 - On the morrow, as they went on their journey, and drew nigh unto the city, Peter went up upon the housetop to pray about the sixth hour: And he became very hungry, and would have eaten: but while they made ready, he fell into a trance,

Many ungodly religions have some form of Trance. Is it Godly or not? Occultic or psychic gifts or the Holy Spirit? 2 Corinthians 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light

- 1) any casting down of a thing from its proper place or state, displacement
- 2) a throwing of the mind out of its normal state, alienation of mind, whether such as makes a lunatic or that of a man who by some sudden emotion is transported as it were out of himself, so that in this rapt condition, although he is awake, his mind is drawn off from all surrounding objects and wholly fixed on things divine that he sees nothing but the forms and images lying within, and thinks that he perceives with his bodily eyes and ears realities shown him by God.
- 3) amazement, the state of one who, either owing to the importance or the novelty of an event, is thrown into a state of blended fear and wonderment

Ezekiel 8:1-3 And it came to pass in the sixth year, in the sixth month, in the fifth day of the month, as I sat in mine house, & the elders of Judah sat before me, that the hand of the Lord GOD fell there upon me. Then I beheld, & Io a likeness as the appearance of fire: from the appearance of his loins even downward, fire; & from his loins even upward, as the appearance of brightness, as the colour of amber. & he put forth the form of an hand, & took me by a lock of mine head; & the spirit lifted me up between the earth & the heaven, & brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the inner gate that looketh toward the north; where was the seat of the image of jealousy, which provoketh to jealousy. & Paraphrased chapter showing Holy Spirit can dwell in God's temple with ungodliness/demons.

Ezekiel 11:24 Afterwards the spirit took me up, and brought me in a vision by the Spirit of God into Chaldea, to them of the captivity. So the vision that I had seen went up from me.

Ezekiel 40:2 In the visions of God brought he me into the land of Israel, and set me upon a very high mountain, by which was as the frame of a city on the south.

Music; rock concerts; & Mind control used to get listeners into altered state of consciousness explained.

John - 2 Corinthians 12:2-4 I knew a man in Christ above 14 years ago, (whether in the body, I cannot tell; or whether out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) such an one caught up to the third heaven. Referred to the Infilling of Holy Spirit in Acts 2.

Altered or heightened state of consciousness from excitement; & music.

Mind control blitzing the mind of others.

Trance Like Conditions from Wikipedia [with comments]

Enchantment: a psychological state induced by (or as if induced by) a magical incantation [Occult influence]

A state of mind in which consciousness is fragile & voluntary action is poor or missing. [Diabetic low or coma - can hear all but not respond.]

A state resembling deep sleep. [Channelling events - Sangoma ritual too invoke ancestral spirits for occultism.]

[Pray for God in Jesus' name to have you in proper state of Consciousness. Mind racing spirits, highway hypnosis, etc.

Take thoughts captive to Jesus referred to - 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;]

Capture: attract; cause to be enamored; "She captured all the men's hearts"; in the sense of entranced. [by Occult means & glamouring spell]

A condition of apparent sleep or unconsciousness, with marked physiological characteristics, in which the body of the subject is liable to possession. [half awake; or fast shows - altered mind, or passivity]

An out-of-body experience in which one feels they have passed out of the body into another state of being, a rapture, an ecstasy. [Astral projection; mind over pain; & self hypnosis; etc.]

In a general way, the entranced conditions thus defined are divided into varying degrees of a negative, unconscious state, and into progressive gradations of a positive, conscious, illumining condition. A state of hyper or enhanced suggestibility. [Hypnotists; & mind altering medicines]

An induced or spontaneous sleep-like condition of an altered state of consciousness, which permits the subject's physical body to be utilized by the discarnate as a means of expression. [Founders of religions - got info from demons - 12 Steps, & cults etc.]

An altered state of awareness induced via hypnotism in which unconscious or dissociated responses to suggestion are enhanced in quality and increased in degree. [hypnosis for breaking off addictions]

A state induced by the use of hypnosis; the person accepts the suggestions of the hypnotist.

A state of consciousness characterized by extreme dissociation often to the point of appearing unconscious. [separated from reality; & spaced out]
