- Isaiah 33:13 Hear, ye *that are* far off, what I have done; and, ye *that are* near, acknowledge my might <01369>.
- Isaiah 36:5 I say, sayest thou, (but they are but vain words) I have counsel and strength <01369> for war: now on whom dost thou trust, that thou rebellest against me?
- Isaiah 63:15 Look down from heaven, and behold from the habitation of thy holiness and of thy glory: where *is* thy zeal and thy strength <01369>, the sounding of thy bowels and of thy mercies toward me? are they restrained?
- Jeremiah 9:23 Thus saith the LORD, Let not the wise *man* glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty *man* glory in his might <01369>, let not the rich *man* glory in his riches:
- Jeremiah 10:6 Forasmuch as *there is* none like unto thee, O LORD; thou *art* great, and thy name *is* great in might <01369>.
- Jeremiah 16:21 Therefore, behold, I will this once cause them to know, I will cause them to know mine hand and my might <01369>; and they shall know that my name *is* The LORD.
- Jeremiah 23:10 For the land is full of adulterers; for because of swearing the land mourneth; the pleasant places of the wilderness are dried up, and their course is evil, and their force <01369> is not right.
- Jeremiah 49:35 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Behold, I will break the bow of Elam, the chief of their might <01369>.
- Jeremiah 51:30 The mighty men of Babylon have forborn to fight, they have remained in *their* holds: their might <01369> hath failed; they became as women: they have burned her dwellingplaces; her bars are broken.
- Ezekiel 32:29,30 There is Edom, her kings, and all her princes, which with

- their might <01369> are laid by them that were slain by the sword: they shall lie with the uncircumcised, and with them that go down to the pit. 30 There be the princes of the north, all of them, and all the Zidonians, which are gone down with the slain; with their terror they are ashamed of their might <01369>; & they lie uncircumcised with them that be slain by the sword, & bear their shame with them that go down to the pit.
- Micah 3:8 But truly I am full of power by the spirit of the LORD, and of judgment, and of might <01369>, to declare unto Jacob his transgression, and to Israel his sin.
- Micah 7:16 The nations shall see & be confounded at all their might <u>01369</u>: they shall lay *their* hand upon *their* mouth, their ears shall be deaf.
- Matthew 11:23 And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to hell: for if the mighty works <u>1411</u>, which have been done in thee, had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.
- Matthew 13:54,58 And when he was come into his own country, he taught them in their synagogue, insomuch that they were astonished, and said, Whence hath this *man* this wisdom, and *these* mighty works <1411>? 58 & he did not many mighty works <1411> there because of their unbelief.
- Matthew 14:2 And said unto his servants, This is John the Baptist; he is risen from the dead; and therefore mighty works <1411> do shew forth themselves in him.
- Matthew 22:29 Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power <1411> of God.
- Matthew 24:29,30 Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers <1411> of the heavens shall be shaken: 30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, & they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power <1411> & great glory.
- Matthew 25:15 And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability <1411>; and straightway took his journey.
- Matthew 26:64 Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power <1411>, and coming in the clouds of heaven.
- Mark 5:30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in himself that virtue <1411> had gone out of him, turned him about in the press, and said, Who touched my clothes?
- Mark 6:2,5,14 And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: & many hearing *him* were astonished, saying, From whence hath this *man* these things? and what wisdom *is* this which is

- given unto him, that even such mighty works <1411> are wrought by his hands? 5 And he could there do no mighty work <1411>, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed *them*. 14 And king Herod heard *of him*; (for his name was spread abroad:) and he said, That John the Baptist was risen from the dead, and therefore mighty works <1411> do shew forth themselves in him.
- Mark 9:1,39 And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they have seen the kingdom of God come with power <1411>. 39 But Jesus said, Forbid him not: for there is no man which shall do a miracle <1411> in my name, that can lightly speak evil of me.
- Mark 12:24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power <1411> of God?
- Mark 13:25,26 And the stars of heaven shall fall, and the powers <1411> that are in heaven shall be shaken. 26 And then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great power <1411> and glory.
- Mark 14:62 And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power <1411>, and coming in the clouds of heaven.
- Luke 1:17,35 And he shall go before him in the spirit and power <1411> of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord. 35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power <1411> of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.
- Luke 4:14,36 And Jesus returned in the power <1411> of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about. 36 And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word *is* this! for with authority and power <1411> he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.
- Luke 5:17 And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power <1411> of the Lord was *present* to heal them.
- Luke 6:19 And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue <1411> out of him, and healed *them* all.
- Luke 8:46 And Jesus said, Somebody hath touched me: for I perceive that virtue <1411> is gone out of me.
- Luke 9:1 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power <1411> and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.
- Luke 10:13,19 Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works <1411> had been done in Tyre and Sidon, which have

- been done in you, they had a great while ago repented, sitting in sackcloth and ashes. 19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power <1411> of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Luke 19:37 And when he was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works <1411> that they had seen;
- Luke 21:26,27 Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers <1411> of heaven shall be shaken. 27 And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power <1411> and great glory.
- Luke 22:69 Hereafter shall the Son of man sit on the right hand of the power <1411> of God.
- Luke 24:49 And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power <1411> from on high.
- Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power <1411>, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.
- Acts 2:22 Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles <1411> and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know:
- Acts 3:12 when Peter saw, he answered unto the people, Ye men of Israel, why marvel ye at this? or why look ye so earnestly on us, as though by our own power 1411 or holiness we had made this man to walk?
- Acts 4:7,33 And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, By what power <1411>, or by what name, have ye done this? 33 And with great power <1411> gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.
- Acts 6:8 And Stephen, full of faith and power <1411>, did great wonders and miracles among the people.
- Acts 8:10,13,38 To whom they all gave heed, from the least to the greatest, saying, This man is the great power <1411> of God. 13 Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles <1411> and signs which were done. 38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power <1411>: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.
- Acts 19:11 And God wrought special miracles <1411> by the hands of Paul: Romans 1:4,16 declared *to be* the Son of God with power 1411, according

- to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead: 16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power <u>1411</u> of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, & also the Greek.
- Romans 1:20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, *even* his eternal power <1411> and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:
- Romans 8:38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers <1411>, nor things present,...
- Romans 9:17 For the scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew my power <1411> in thee, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.
- Romans 15:13,19 Now the God of hope fill you with all joy & peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power <1411> of the Holy Ghost. 19 Through mighty <1411> signs and wonders, by the power <1411> of the Spirit of God; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.
- 1Corinthians 1:18,24 For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power <1411> of God. 24 But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power <1411> of God, and the wisdom of God.
- 1Corinthians 2:4,5 my speech & preaching *was* not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit & of power: 5 That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.
- 1Corinthians 4:19 But I will come to you shortly, if the Lord will, and will know, not the speech of them which are puffed up, but the power <1411>. 20 For the kingdom of God *is* not in word, but in power <1411>.
- 1Corinthians 5:4 In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when ye are gathered together, and my spirit, with the power <1411> of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 1Corinthians 6:14 And God hath both raised up the Lord, and will also raise up us by his own power <1411>.
- 1Corinthians 12:10,28,29 To another the working of miracles <1411>; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: 28 And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles <1411>, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues. 29 Are all apostles? are all prophets? are all teachers? are all workers of miracles <1411>?
- 1Corinthians 14:11 Therefore if I know not the meaning <1411> of the voice, I shall be unto him that speaketh a barbarian, and he that speaketh shall be a barbarian unto me.
- 1Corinthians 15:24,43,56 Then cometh the end, when he shall have

- delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule & all authority & power 1411. 43 It is sown in dishonor; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power <1411>: 56 The sting of death *is* sin; and the strength <1411> of sin *is* the law.
- 2Corinthians 1:8 For we would not, brethren, have you ignorant of our trouble which came to us in Asia, that we were pressed out of measure, above strength <1411>, insomuch that we despaired even of life:
- 2Corinthians 4:7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power <1411> may be of God, and not of us.
- 2Corinthians 6:7 By the word of truth, by the power <1411> of God, by the armour of righteousness on the right hand and on the left,
- 2Corinthians 8:3 For to *their* power <1411>, I bear record, yea, and beyond *their* power <1411> *they were* willing of themselves;
- 2Corinthians 12:9,12 he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength <1411> is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power <1411> of Christ may rest upon me. 12 Truly the signs of an apostle were wrought among you in all patience, in signs, and wonders, and mighty deeds <1411>.
- 2Corinthians 13:4 For though he was crucified through weakness, yet he liveth by the power <1411> of God. For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him by the power <1411> of God toward you.
- Galations 3:5 He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles <1411> among you, *doeth he it* by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?
- Ephesians 1:19,21 And what *is* the exceeding greatness of his power <u>1411</u> to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, 21 Far above all principality, power, might <u>1411</u>, dominion, & every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:
- Ephesians 3:7,16 Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power <1411>. 16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might <1411> by his Spirit in the inner man;
- Ephesians 3:20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power <1411> that worketh in us,
- Philipians 3:10 That I may know him, and the power <1411> of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;
- Colossians 1:11,29 Strengthened with all might <1411>, according to his glorious power, unto all patience & longsuffering with joyfulness; 29 Whereunto I also labour, striving according to his working, which worketh in me mightily <1411>.

- 2Thessalonians 1:7,11 to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty <1411> angels, 11 Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of *this* calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of *his* goodness, and the work of faith with power <1411>:
- 2Thessalonians 2:9 *Even him*, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power <1411> and signs and lying wonders,
- 2Timothy 1:8 Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power <1411> of God;
- 2Timothy 3:5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power <1411> thereof: from such turn away.
- Hebrews 1:3 Who being the brightness of *his* glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power <1411>, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;
- Hebrews 2:4 God also bearing *them* witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles <1411>, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will?
- Hebrews 6:5 And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers <1411> of the world to come,
- Hebrews 7:16 Who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power <1411> of an endless life.
- Hebrews 11:11,34 Through faith also Sara herself received strength <1411> to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised. 34 Quenched the violence <1411> of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.
- 1Peter 1:5 Who are kept by the power <1411> of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.
- 1Thessalonians 1:5 For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.
