Jesus Christ Is Our Ever Present Help

Joshua 1:1-5

In Exodus 32 Moses gets 10 Commandments from God & Aaron made golden calf for Isrealites. Joshua was Moses' assistant. Joshua & Caleb only Men to enter Promise land. Like we get God's freedom.

Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all *ye* that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Joshua 1:1-5 Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD it came to pass, that the LORD spake unto Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying, 2 Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel. 3 Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses. 4 From the wilderness and this Lebanon even unto the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and unto the great sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your coast. 5 There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

Strongs #0391 Joshua or Jehoshua = Jehovah is salvation in Hebrew.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Concise Bible Dictionary - Joshua 1. Son of Nun, of the tribe of Ephraim. His name was originally OSHEA, or HOSHEA, but it was changed by Moses into Jehoshua, and this was contracted into Joshua, which is the same as JESUS in the Greek, and signifies 'Jehovah the saviour.' Joshua was one of the twelve spies, and he with Caleb brought up a true report of the land, and was one of the two survivors of the men who came out of Egypt that entered the land. The first notice of Joshua is when he led the army against the Amalekites and overcame them while Moses' hands were held up. #Exodus 17:9. He is afterwards called the 'minister of Moses', and as such he went up with him into the mount of God. #Exodus 24:13; 32:17. Joshua was appointed the successor of Moses, not as law-giver, but as leader. He had 'the spirit,' and some of the honour of Moses was put upon him. #Numbers 27:18-23 Deuteronomy 1:38; 3:28.

The principal work of Joshua was to lead the Israelites into the land of promise, not on the ground of their righteousness, but of the promises made to the fathers; the subjugation of the former inhabitants, & dividing the land as a possession for the 12 tribes, & these things are recorded in

- the Book of Joshua. In these points Joshua was a type of Christ as leader or Captain of His saints. He is once called JESHUA. #Nehemiah 8:17.
- Joshua 1:3,5 Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses. 5 There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.
- Psalm 34:7 The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.
- Isaiah 49:25 But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contendeth with thee, and I will save thy children.
- James 4:2 Ye <u>lust</u>, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not.
- Joshua 1:5 There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, *so* I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.
- Deuteronomy 7:24 And he shall deliver their kings into thine hand, and thou shalt destroy their name from under heaven: there shall no man be able to stand before thee, until thou have destroyed them.

Joshua conquered 31 kings. Similar to the demonic kingdoms in people.

Matthew 14:29,30 referred to Peter - "Lord save me".

Ask God to smite ungodly seed & tares; & bless Godly seed.

2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of salvation.)

Call upon Name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall hurt you.
- Luke 4:36 And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word *is* this! for with authority and power he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.
- Luke 9:1 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, *I say*, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
- Hebrews 9:27 it is appointed to men once to die, but after the judgment:
- Deuteronomy 20:4 For the LORD your God *is* he that goeth with you, to fight for you against your enemies, to save you.

- Isaiah 49:25 But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contendeth with thee, and I will save thy children.
- Psalms 46:11 The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge.
- Hebrews 13:5 *Let your* conversation *be* without covetousness; *and be* content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will <u>never leave</u> thee, nor <u>forsake</u> thee.
- Romans 8:31,37 What shall we then say to these things? If God *be* for us, who *can be* against us? 37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: & whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: & whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Matthew 4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.
- Mark 5:8,9 For he said unto him, Come out of the man, *thou* unclean spirit. 9 And he asked him, What *is* thy name? And he answered, saying, My name *is* Legion: for we are many.
- Joshua 3:7 And the LORD said unto Joshua, This day will I begin to magnify thee in the sight of all Israel, that they may know that, as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee.
- Isaiah 3:12 *As for* my people, children *are* their oppressors, and women rule over them. O my people, they which lead thee cause *thee* to err, and destroy the way of thy paths.
- Joshua 6:27 So the LORD was with Joshua; and his fame was *noised* throughout all the country.
- Exodus 3:12 And he said, Certainly I will be with thee; and this *shall be* a token unto thee, that I have sent thee: When thou hast brought forth the people out of Egypt, ye shall serve God upon this mountain.
- Deuteronomy 31:8 And the LORD, he *it is* that doth go before thee; he will be with thee, he will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: fear not, neither be dismayed.
- Numbers 14:4 they said, Let us make a captain, & let us <u>return</u> into <u>Egypt</u>.
- Deuteronomy 31:23 And he gave Joshua the son of Nun a charge, and said, Be strong and of a good courage: for thou shalt bring the children of Israel into the land which I sware unto them: and I will be with thee.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against <u>spiritual</u> <u>wickedness</u> in high *places*.
- Matthew 28:20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: & lo I am with you alway, even to the end of the world.

- Mark 16; 14 18 Jesus' Great Commission explained more.
- Jesus, John Baptist, & Paul said "Repent". Strongs #3956 Always
- Acts 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.
- Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; & they loved not their lives unto the death.
- John 15:20 Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the <u>nurture</u> and <u>admonition</u> of the Lord.
- More Notes: Acts 18:9,10 Then spake the Lord to Paul in the night bya vision, Be not afraid but speak & hold not thy peace For I am with thee & no man shall set on thee to hurt thee for I have much people in this city.
- 2 Timothy 4:17 Notwithstanding the Lord stood with me, and strengthened me; that by me the preaching might be fully known, and *that* all the Gentiles might hear: and I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion.
- Deuteronomy 31:6-8 Be strong & of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, he *it is* that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee. 7 And Moses called unto Joshua, and said unto him in the sight of all Israel, Be strong and of a good courage: for thou must go with this people unto the land which the LORD hath sworn unto their fathers to give them; and thou shalt cause them to inherit it. 8 And the LORD, he *it is* that doth go before thee; he will be with thee, he will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: fear not, neither be dismayed.
- Isaiah 41:10,13,14 Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness. 13 For I the LORD thy God will hold thy right hand, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee. 14 Fear not, thou worm Jacob, and ye men of Israel; I will help thee, saith the LORD, and thy redeemer, the Holy One of Israel.
- Isaiah 43:2,5 When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee. 5 Fear not: for I am with thee: I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west;
