Famines - Godly or Not - Acts 11

Acts 11:27-30 And in these days came prophets from Jerusalem unto Antioch. 28 And there stood up one of them named Agabus, and signified by the Spirit that there should be great dearth throughout all the world: which came to pass in the days of Claudius Caesar. 29 Then the disciples, every man according to his ability, determined to send relief unto the brethren which dwelt in Judaea: 30 Which also they did, and sent it to the elders by the hands of Barnabas and Saul.

V28 Dearth - Strongs #07458 famine/hunger in 45AD.

Mark 8 summarized - Jesus ministers 3 days then feeds them.

John 13:35 By this shall all *men* know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.

Genesis 41:30-31 And there shall arise after them seven years of famine; and all the plenty shall be forgotten in the land of Egypt; and the famine shall consume the land; 31 And the plenty shall not be known in the land by reason of that famine following; for it *shall be* very grievous.

Summarized of Pharoah's dreams & Joseph.

Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.

Summarized 1 Kings 17:1-16 And Elijah the Tishbite, who was of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, As the LORD God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word. - 16

Genesis 31:40 *Thus* I was; in the day the <u>drought</u> consumed me, and the frost by night; and my sleep departed from mine eyes.

Deuteronomy 8:15 Who led thee through that great and terrible wilderness, wherein were fiery serpents, and scorpions, and drought, where there was no water; who brought thee forth water out of the rock of flint;

Job 24:19 <u>Drought</u> and heat consume the snow waters: *so doth* the grave *those which* have sinned.

Genesis 12:10 And there was a <u>famine</u> in the land: and Abram went down into Egypt to sojourn there; for the <u>famine</u> was grievous in the land.

Genesis 26:1 And there was a <u>famine</u> in the land, beside the first <u>famine</u> that was in the days of Abraham. And Isaac went unto Abimelech king of the Philistines unto Gerar.

Genesis 42:5 And the sons of Israel came to buy *corn* among those that came: for the famine was in the land of Canaan.

Lots of examples in Genesis 41 below in Extra Notes.

Matthew 24:7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against

- kingdom: and there shall be <u>famines</u>, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.
- Mark 13:8 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be earthquakes in divers places, and there shall be <u>famines</u> and troubles: these *are* the beginnings of sorrows.
- Luke 4:25 But I tell you of a truth, many widows were in Israel in the days of Elias, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, when great famine was throughout all the land;
- Luke 15:14 And when he had spent all, there arose a mighty <u>famine</u> in that land; and he began to be in want.
- Luke 21:11 And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, & <u>famines</u>, & pestilences; & fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven.
- Acts 7:11 Now there came a <u>dearth</u> over all the land of Egypt and Chanaan, and great affliction: and our fathers found no sustenance.
- Romans 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *shall* tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or <u>famine</u>, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Nothing can separate us from the Love of God in Christ Jesus.
- Revelation 18:8 Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and <u>famine</u>; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong *is* the Lord God who judgeth her.
- Ezekiel 14:13 Son of man, when the land sinneth against me by trespassing grievously, then will I stretch out mine hand upon it, and will break the staff of the bread thereof, <u>and will send famine upon it</u>, and will cut off man and beast from it:
- Ezekiel 14:13 (NKJV) "Son of man, when a land sins against Me by persistent unfaithfulness, I will stretch out My hand against it; I will cut off its supply of bread, send famine on it, & cut off man & beast from it.

God sent many Prophets & the Isrealites killed them.

God with-held the rain for a famine.

- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, & pray, & seek my face, & turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- 1 Chronicles 21:1 And <u>Satan</u> <u>stood</u> up <u>against</u> Israel, and provoked David to number Israel.
- Zechariah 3:1 And he shewed me Joshua the <u>high priest</u> standing before the angel of the LORD, & <u>Satan</u> standing at his right hand to resist him.

Luke 4 satan tempted Jesus.

Mark 8:33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, <u>Get</u> thee <u>behind</u> me, <u>Satan</u>: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.

- 1 Chronicles 21:12-13 Either three years' <u>famine</u>; or three months to be destroyed before thy foes, while that the sword of thine enemies overtaketh *thee*; or else three days the sword of the LORD, even the pestilence, in the land, and the angel of the LORD destroying throughout all the coasts of Israel. Now therefore advise thyself what word I shall bring again to him that sent me.13 And David said unto Gad, I am in a great strait: let me fall now into the hand of the LORD; for very great *are* his mercies: but let me not fall into the hand of man.
- Timothy 2:1 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- 2 Chronicles 6:28 If there be <u>dearth</u> in the land, if there be pestilence, if there be blasting, or mildew, locusts, or caterpillers; if their enemies besiege them in the cities of their land; whatsoever sore or whatsoever sickness *there be*:
- 2 Chronicles 20:9 If, when evil cometh upon us, as the sword, judgment, or pestilence, or famine, we stand before this house, and in thy presence, (for thy name is in this house,) and cry unto thee in our affliction, then thou wilt hear and help.
- Amos prayed 3 times & God didn't judge Isreal, but He did the fourth time.
- 2 Chronicles 32:11 Doth not Hezekiah persuade you to give over yourselves to die by <u>famine</u> and by thirst, saying, The LORD our God shall deliver us out of the hand of the king of Assyria?
- Nehemiah 5:3 *Some* also there were that said, We have mortgaged our lands, vineyards, and houses, that we might buy corn, because of the <u>dearth</u>.
- Jeremiah 5:12 They have belied the LORD, and said, *It is* not he; neither shall evil come upon us; neither shall we see sword nor <u>famine</u>:
- Jeremiah 14:12 When they fast, I will not hear their cry; and when they offer burnt offering and an oblation, I will not accept them: but I will consume them by the sword, and by the famine, and by the pestilence.
- Amos 8:11,12 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a <u>famine</u> in the land, not a <u>famine</u> of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD: 12 And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the LORD, and shall not find *it*.
- Watch out for False Prophets & wolves in sheeps' clothing, etc.
- Jeremiah 3:15 And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.
- Psalms 33:19 To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine.

- Psalms 37:19 They shall not be ashamed in the evil time: and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied.
- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
- Esther 4:14 For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time, *then* shall there enlargement and deliverance arise to the Jews from another place; but thou and thy father's house shall be destroyed: and who knoweth whether thou art come to the kingdom for *such* a time as this?

More Service notes:

- Genesis 41:27-36 And the seven thin and ill favoured kine that came up after them are seven years; and the seven empty ears blasted with the east wind shall be seven years of <u>famine</u>. 30 And there shall arise after them seven years of <u>famine</u>; and all the plenty shall be forgotten in the land of Egypt; and the <u>famine</u> shall consume the land; 31 And the plenty shall not be known in the land by reason of that <u>famine</u> following; for it shall be very grievous. 36 And that food shall be for store to the land against the seven years of <u>famine</u>, which shall be in the land of Egypt; that the land perish not through the <u>famine</u>.
- Genesis 41:50-57 And unto Joseph were born two sons before the years of famine came, which Asenath the daughter of Potipherah priest of On bare unto him. 54 And the seven years of dearth began to come, according as Joseph had said: and the dearth was in all lands; but in all the land of Egypt there was bread. 56 And the famine was over all the face of the earth: And Joseph opened all the storehouses, and sold unto the Egyptians; and the famine waxed sore in the land of Egypt. 57 And all countries came into Egypt to Joseph for to buy corn; because that the famine was so sore in all lands.
- Genesis 42:19 If ye *be* true *men*, let one of your brethren be bound in the house of your prison: go ye, carry corn for the <u>famine</u> of your houses:
- Genesis 42:33 And the man, the lord of the country, said unto us, Hereby shall I know that ye *are* true *men*; leave one of your brethren *here* with me, and take *food for* the <u>famine</u> of your households, and be gone:
- Genesis 43:1 And the <u>famine</u> was sore in the land.
- Genesis 45:6 For these 2 years *hath* the <u>famine</u> *been* in the land: & yet *there are* 5 years, in the which *there shall* neither *be* earing nor harvest.
- Genesis 45:11 And there will I nourish thee; for yet *there are* 5 years of <u>famine</u>; lest thou, & thy household, & all that thou hast, come to poverty.
- Genesis 47:4 They said moreover unto Pharaoh, For to sojourn in the land are we come; for thy servants have no pasture for their flocks; for the <u>famine</u> is sore in the land of Canaan: now therefore, we pray thee, let thy servants dwell in the land of Goshen.

- Genesis 47:13 And *there was* no bread in all the land; for the <u>famine</u> was very sore, so that the land of Egypt and *all* the land of Canaan fainted by reason of the famine.
- Genesis 47:20 And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the <u>famine</u> prevailed over them: so the land became Pharaoh's.
- Ruth 1:1 Now it came to pass in the days when the judges ruled, that there was a <u>famine</u> in the land. And a certain man of Bethlehemjudah went to sojourn in the country of Moab, he, and his wife, and his two sons.
- 2 Samuel 21:1 Then there was a <u>famine</u> in the days of David 3 years, year after year; & David enquired of the LORD. And the LORD answered, *It is* for Saul, & for *his* bloody house, because he slew the Gibeonites.
- 2 Samuel 24:13 So Gad came to David, and told him, and said unto him, Shall seven years of <u>famine</u> come unto thee in thy land? or wilt thou flee three months before thine enemies, while they pursue thee? or that there be three days' pestilence in thy land? now advise, and see what answer I shall return to him that sent me.
- 1 Kings 8:37 If there be in the land <u>famine</u>, if there be pestilence, blasting, mildew, locust, if there be caterpiller; if their enemy besiege them in the land of their cities; whatsoever plague, whatsoever sickness *there be*;
- 1 Kings 18:2 And Elijah went to shew himself unto Ahab. And *there was* a sore <u>famine</u> in Samaria.
- 2 Kings 4:38 And Elisha came again to Gilgal: and *there was* a <u>dearth</u> in the land; and the sons of the prophets *were* sitting before him: and he said unto his servant, Set on the great pot, and seethe pottage for the sons of the prophets.
- 2 Kings 6:25 And there was a great <u>famine</u> in Samaria: and, behold, they besieged it, until an ass's head was *sold* for fourscore *pieces* of silver, and the fourth part of a cab of dove's dung for five *pieces* of silver.
- 2 Kings 7:4 If we say, We will enter into the city, then the <u>famine</u> is in the city, and we shall die there: and if we sit still here, we die also. Now therefore come, and let us fall unto the host of the Syrians: if they save us alive, we shall live; and if they kill us, we shall but die.
- 2 Kings 8:1 Then spake Elisha unto the woman, whose son he had restored to life, saying, Arise, and go thou and thine household, and sojourn wheresoever thou canst sojourn: for the LORD hath called for a <u>famine</u>; and it shall also come upon the land seven years.
- 2 Kings 25:3 And on the ninth *day* of the *fourth* month the <u>famine</u> prevailed in the city, and there was no bread for the people of the land.
- Job 5:20,22 In <u>famine</u> he shall redeem thee from death: and in war from the power of the sword. 22 At destruction and <u>famine</u> thou shalt laugh: neither shalt thou be afraid of the beasts of the earth.

- Job 30:3 For want and <u>famine</u> they were solitary; fleeing into the wilderness in former time desolate and waste.
- Psalms 105:16 Moreover he called for a <u>famine</u> upon the land: he brake the whole staff of bread.
- Isaiah 14:30 And the firstborn of the poor shall feed, & the needy shall lie down in safety: and I will kill thy root with <u>famine</u>, and he shall slay thy remnant.
- Isaiah 51:19 These two *things* are come unto thee; who shall be sorry for thee? desolation, and destruction, and the <u>famine</u>, and the sword: by whom shall I comfort thee?
- Jeremiah 11:22 Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, Behold, I will punish them: the young men shall die by the sword; their sons and their daughters shall die by famine:
- Jeremiah 14:1 The word of the LORD that came to Jeremiah concerning the dearth.
- Jeremiah 14:13-18 Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! behold, the prophets say unto them, Ye shall not see the sword, neither shall ye have <u>famine</u>; but I will give you assured peace in this place. 15 Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the prophets that prophesy in my name, and I sent them not, yet they say, Sword and <u>famine</u> shall not be in this land; By sword and <u>famine</u> shall those prophets be consumed. 16 And the people to whom they prophesy shall be cast out in the streets of Jerusalem because of the <u>famine</u> and the sword; and they shall have none to bury them, them, their wives, nor their sons, nor their daughters: for I will pour their wickedness upon them. 18 If I go forth into the field, then behold the slain with the sword! and if I enter into the city, then behold them that are sick with <u>famine</u>! yea, both the prophet and the priest go about into a land that they know not.
- Jeremiah 15:2 And it shall come to pass, if they say unto thee, Whither shall we go forth? then thou shalt tell them, Thus saith the LORD; Such as *are* for death, to death; and such as *are* for the sword, to the sword; and such as *are* for the <u>famine</u>, to the <u>famine</u>; and such as *are* for the captivity.
- Jeremiah 16:4 They shall die of grievous deaths; they shall not be lamented; neither shall they be buried; but they shall be as dung upon the face of the earth: and they shall be consumed by the sword, and by famine; and their carcases shall be meat for the fowls of heaven, and for the beasts of the earth.
- Jeremiah 18:21 Therefore deliver up their children to the <u>famine</u>, and pour out their *blood* by the force of the sword; and let their wives be bereaved of their children, and *be* widows; and let their men be put to death; *let* their young men *be* slain by the sword in battle.

- Jeremiah 21:7-10 And afterward, saith the LORD, I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, and his servants, and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence, from the sword, and from the <u>famine</u>, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those that seek their life: and he shall smite them with the edge of the sword; he shall not spare them, neither have pity, nor have mercy. 9 He that abideth in this city shall die by the sword, and by the <u>famine</u>, and by the pestilence: but he that goeth out, and falleth to the Chaldeans that besiege you, he shall live, and his life shall be unto him for a prey. 10 And I will send the sword, the <u>famine</u>, and the pestilence, among them, till they be consumed from off the land that I gave unto them and to their fathers.
- Jeremiah 27:8 And it shall come to pass, *that* the nation and kingdom which will not serve the same Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and that will not put their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, that nation will I punish, saith the LORD, with the sword, and with the <u>famine</u>, and with the pestilence, until I have consumed them by his hand.
- Jeremiah 27:13 Why will ye die, thou and thy people, by the sword, by the <u>famine</u>, and by the pestilence, as the LORD hath spoken against the nation that will not serve the king of Babylon?
- Jeremiah 29:17,18 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Behold, I will send upon them the sword, the <u>famine</u>, and the pestilence, and will make them like vile figs, that cannot be eaten, they are so evil. 18 And I will persecute them with the sword, with the <u>famine</u>, and with the pestilence, and will deliver them to be removed to all the kingdoms of the earth, to be a curse, and an astonishment, and an hissing, and a reproach, among all the nations whither I have driven them:
- Jeremiah 32:24 Behold the mounts, they are come unto the city to take it; and the city is given into the hand of the Chaldeans, that fight against it, because of the sword, and of the <u>famine</u>, and of the pestilence: and what thou hast spoken is come to pass; and, behold, thou seest *it*.
- Jeremiah 32:36 And now therefore thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, concerning this city, whereof ye say, It shall be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon by the sword, by the <u>famine</u>, & by the pestilence;
- Jeremiah 34:17 Therefore thus saith the LORD; Ye have not hearkened unto me, in proclaiming liberty, every one to his brother, and every man to his neighbour: behold, I proclaim a liberty for you, saith the LORD, to the sword, to the pestilence, and to the <u>famine</u>; and I will make you to be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth.
- Jeremiah 38:2 Thus saith the LORD, He that remaineth in this city shall die by the sword, by the <u>famine</u>, and by the pestilence: but he that goeth forth to the Chaldeans shall live; for he shall have his life for a prey, and

shall live.

- Jeremiah 42:16-22 Then it shall come to pass, that the sword, which ye feared, shall overtake you there in the land of Egypt, and the famine, whereof ye were afraid, shall follow close after you there in Egypt; and there ye shall die. 17 So shall it be with all the men that set their faces to go into Egypt to sojourn there; they shall die by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence: and none of them shall remain or escape from the evil that I will bring upon them. 22 Now therefore know certainly that ye shall die by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence, in the place whither ye desire to go and to sojourn.
- Jeremiah 44:12-18,27 And I will take the remnant of Judah, that have set their faces to go into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, and they shall all be consumed, and fall in the land of Egypt; they shall even be consumed by the sword and by the famine: they shall die, from the least even unto the greatest, by the sword and by the famine: and they shall be an execration, and an astonishment, and a curse, and a reproach. 13 For I will punish them that dwell in the land of Egypt, as I have punished Jerusalem, by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence: 18 But since we left off to burn incense to the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto her, we have wanted all things, and have been consumed by the sword and by the famine. 27 Behold, I will watch over them for evil, and not for good: and all the men of Judah that are in the land of Egypt shall be consumed by the sword and by the famine, until there be an end of them.
- Jeremiah 52:6 And in the fourth month, in the ninth *day* of the month, the <u>famine</u> was sore in the city, so that there was no bread for the people of the land.
- Lamentations 5:10 Our skin was black like an oven because of the terrible famine.
- Ezekiel 5:12-17 A third part of thee shall die with the pestilence, and with famine shall they be consumed in the midst of thee: and a third part shall fall by the sword round about thee; and I will scatter a third part into all the winds, and I will draw out a sword after them. 16 When I shall send upon them the evil arrows of famine, which shall be for their destruction, and which I will send to destroy you: and I will increase the famine upon you, and will break your staff of bread: 17 So will I send upon you famine and evil beasts, and they shall bereave thee; and pestilence and blood shall pass through thee; and I will bring the sword upon thee. I the LORD have spoken it.
- Ezekiel 6:11,12 Thus saith the Lord GOD; Smite with thine hand, and stamp with thy foot, and say, Alas for all the evil abominations of the house of Israel! for they shall fall by the sword, by the <u>famine</u>, and by the

- pestilence. 12 He that is far off shall die of the pestilence; and he that is near shall fall by the sword; and he that remaineth and is besieged shall die by the <u>famine</u>: thus will I accomplish my fury upon them.
- Ezekiel 7:15 The sword *is* without, and the pestilence and the <u>famine</u> within: he that *is* in the field shall die with the sword; and he that *is* in the city, <u>famine</u> and pestilence shall devour him.
- Ezekiel 12:16 But I will leave a few men of them from the sword, from the <u>famine</u>, and from the pestilence; that they may declare all their abominations among the heathen whither they come; and they shall know that I *am* the LORD.
- Ezekiel 14:13 Son of man, when the land sinneth against me by trespassing grievously, then will I stretch out mine hand upon it, and will break the staff of the bread thereof, and will send <u>famine</u> upon it, and will cut off man and beast from it:
- Ezekiel 14:21 For thus saith the Lord GOD; How much more when I send my four sore judgments upon Jerusalem, the sword, and the <u>famine</u>, and the noisome beast, and the pestilence, to cut off from it man and beast?
- Ezekiel 36:29,30 I will also save you from all your uncleannesses: and I will call for the corn, and will increase it, and lay no <u>famine</u> upon you. 30 And I will multiply the fruit of the tree, and the increase of the field, that ye shall receive no more reproach of <u>famine</u> among the heathen.
- Jeremiah 24:10 And I will send the <u>sword</u>, the <u>famine</u>, and the pestilence, among them, till they be consumed from off the land that I gave unto them and to their fathers.
- Psalms 32:4 For day and night thy hand was heavy upon me: my moisture is turned into the <u>drought</u> of summer. Selah.
- Isaiah 58:11 And the LORD shall guide thee continually, and satisfy thy soul in <u>drought</u>, and make fat thy bones: and thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.
- Jeremiah 2:6 Neither said they, Where *is* the LORD that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, that led us through the wilderness, through a land of deserts and of pits, through a land of <u>drought</u>, and of the shadow of death, through a land that no man passed through, and where no man dwelt?
- Jeremiah 17:8 For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and *that* spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of <u>drought</u>, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.
- Jeremiah 50:38 A <u>drought</u> is upon her waters; and they shall be dried up: for it is the land of graven images, and they are mad upon *their* idols.
- Hosea 13:5 I did know thee in the wilderness, in the land of great <u>drought</u>.
- Haggai 1:11 And I called for a <u>drought</u> upon the land, and upon the

mountains, and upon the corn, and upon the new wine, and upon the oil, and upon *that* which the ground bringeth forth, and upon men, and upon cattle, and upon all the labour of the hands.

- Genesis 41:38 And Pharaoh said unto his servants, Can we find *such a one* as this *is*, a man in whom the Spirit of God *is*?
- 2 Kings 8:1-2 Then spake Elisha unto the woman, whose son he had restored to life, saying, Arise, and go thou and thine household, and sojourn wheresoever thou canst sojourn: for the LORD hath called for a famine; and it shall also come upon the land seven years. 2 And the woman arose, and did after the saying of the man of God: and she went with her household, and sojourned in the land of the Philistines seven years.
