## **Commanded and Sent - Joshua 1**

- Joshua 1:16-18 And they answered Joshua, saying, <u>All that thou commandest us we will do</u>, and <u>whithersoever thou sendest us, we will go</u>. 17 According as we <u>hearkened unto Moses in all things, so will we hearken unto thee</u>: <u>only the LORD thy God be with thee</u>, as he was with Moses. 18 Whosoever he be that doth <u>rebel against thy commandment</u>, and will not hearken unto thy words in all that thou commandest him, he shall be put to <u>death</u>: only <u>be strong and of a good courage</u>.
- Matthew 5:41 whosoever shall compel thee to go a mile, go with him twain.
- Bind & loose over Church & leader. Paraphrased 8 spies & bad report & rebelled against God 40 years earlier & Joshua entering Promised land.
- Numbers 32:25 And the children of Gad and the children of Reuben spake unto Moses, saying, Thy servants will do as my lord commandeth.
- Deuteronomy 5:27 Go thou near, and hear all that the LORD our God shall say: and speak thou unto us all that the LORD our God shall speak unto thee; and we will hear *it*, and do *it*. Exodus 32 summarized.
- Romans 13:1-5 Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. 2 Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation. 3 For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same: 4 For he is the minister of God to thee for good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil. 5 Wherefore ye must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake.

Isaiah 52:11b <u>be</u> ye <u>clean</u>, that <u>bear</u> the <u>vessels</u> of the LORD.

- 1 Timothy 2: 1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Daniel 2:21 And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, & pray, & seek my face, & turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, & will forgive their sin, & will heal their land

Acts 5:29 Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought

to obey God rather than men.

- Titus 3:1 Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work,
- 1 Peter 2:13-15 Submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake: whether it be to the king, as supreme; 14 Or unto governors, as unto them that are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers, and for the praise of them that do well. 15 For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:
- Philippians 2:8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became <u>obedient</u> unto <u>death</u>, even the <u>death</u> of the cross. Jesus.
- Romans 12:21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.
- Colossians 3:22-25 Servants, obey in all things *your* masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice as menpleasers but in singleness of heart, fearing God: & whatsoever ye do, do *it* heartily, as to the Lord, & not unto men; Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ. But he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong he hath done: there is no respect of persons.
- Ephesians 6:5-9 Servants, be obedient to them that are *your* masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ; 6 Not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but as the servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart; 7 With good will doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men: 8 Knowing that whatsoever good thing any man doeth, the same shall he receive of the Lord, whether *he be* bond or free. 9 And, ye masters, do the same things unto them, forbearing threatening: knowing that your Master also is in heaven; neither is there respect of persons with him.
- Colossians 3:17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.
- 2 Chronicles 31:21 And in every work that he began in the service of the house of God, and in the law, and in the commandments, to seek his God, he did *it* with all his heart, and prospered. Hezekiah.
- Psalms 47:6,7 Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises. 7 For God *is* the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding.
- Psalms 103:1 Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, *bless* his holy name.
- Psalms 119:10 With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments.
- Summarized Call to Wedding Feast & Excuses.
- Salvation most important, then Healing & Deliverance etc.
- Mark 16:15-18 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall

be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these <u>signs</u> <u>shall follow them that believe</u>; <u>In my name shall they cast out devils</u>; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Summarized Paul bit by viper on Malta.

- John 13:34 A <u>new commandment</u> I give unto you, That ye <u>love</u> one another; as I have loved you, that ye also <u>love</u> one another.
- More Service Notes: Psalms 119:34 Give me understanding, and I shall keep thy law; yea, I shall observe it with *my* whole heart.
- Psalms 119:145 KOPH. I cried with *my* whole heart; hear me, O LORD: I will keep thy statutes.
- Ecclesiastes 9:10 Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do *it* with thy might; for *there is* no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest.
- Jeremiah 3:10 And yet for all this her treacherous sister Judah hath not turned unto me with her whole heart, but feignedly, saith the LORD.
- 1 Peter 1:22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:
- Zechariah 7:5-7 Speak unto all the people of the land, and to the priests, saying, When ye fasted and mourned in the fifth and seventh month, even those seventy years, did ye at all fast unto me, even to me? 6 And when ye did eat, and when ye did drink, did not ye eat for yourselves, and drink for yourselves? 7 Should ye not hear the words which the LORD hath cried by the former prophets, when Jerusalem was inhabited and in prosperity, and the cities thereof round about her, when men inhabited the south and the plain?
- Matthew 6:16 Moreover when ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces, that they may appear unto men to fast. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.
- Romans 14:8 For whether we live, we live unto the Lord; & whether we die, we die unto the Lord: whether we live therefore or die, we are the Lord's.
- Ephesians 5:22 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.
- 2 John 1:5 And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote a <u>new commandment</u> unto thee, but that which we had from the beginning, that we <u>love</u> one another.
