God's Protection for the Righteous - Joshua 2C

- Use Old Testament battles as patterns for Spiritual Warfare as mentioned in Ephesians 6.
- Joshua 2:22-24 And they went, and came unto the mountain, and abode there three days, until the pursuers were returned: and the pursuers sought them throughout all the way, but found them not. 23 So the two men returned, and descended from the mountain, and passed over, and came to Joshua the son of Nun, and told him all things that befell them: 24 And they said unto Joshua, Truly the LORD hath delivered into our hands all the land; for even all the inhabitants of the country do faint because of us.
- Joshua 2:22 And they went, and came unto the mountain, and abode there three days, until the pursuers were returned: and the pursuers sought them throughout all the way, but found them not.
- Joahua 2:16 Rahab's instructions. And she said unto them, Get you to the mountain, lest the pursuers meet you; and hide yourselves there three days, until the pursuers be returned: and afterward may ye go your way.
- Jonah 3 days & 3 nights in the belly of the whale like Jesus in the tomb.

 Not like the traditions of men.
- 1 Samuel 15:22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.
- Joshua 2:23 So the two men returned, and descended from the mountain, and passed over, and came to Joshua the son of Nun, and told him all things that befell them: 24 And they said unto Joshua, Truly the LORD hath delivered into our hands all the land; for even all the inhabitants of the country do faint because of us.
- Luke 7:22 Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and <u>tell John</u> what things ye have seen and heard; how that the blind <u>see</u>, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached.
- Isaiah 61 read by Jesus in Luke 4:17-19 And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written, 18 The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, 19 To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any

means hurt you.

- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Genesis 7:1-4 And the LORD said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation. 2 Of every clean beast thou shalt take to thee by sevens, the male and his female: and of beasts that are not clean by two, the male and his female. 3 Of fowls also of the air by sevens, the male and the female; to keep seed alive upon the face of all the earth. 4 For yet seven days, and I will cause it to rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights; and every living substance that I have made will I destroy from off the face of the earth.
- Genesis 6 summarized situation of Noah V5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- Summarized Moses interceded 40 days for the Isrealites.
- Genesis 7:7 And Noah went in, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons' wives with him, into the ark, because of the waters of the flood.
- Genesis 7:13 In the selfsame day entered Noah, and Shem, and Ham, and Japheth, the sons of Noah, and Noah's wife, and the three wives of his sons with them, into the ark;
- As Born Again Believer, we are covered in the Blood of Jesus.
- Hebrews 1:14 Are they (God's angels) not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall be bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Mark 3:27 No man can enter into a <u>strong</u> man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first <u>bind</u> the <u>strong</u> man; and then he will spoil his house.
- Job 5:19-24 He shall deliver thee in six troubles: yea, in seven there shall no evil touch thee. 20 In famine he shall redeem thee from death: and in war from the power of the sword. 21 Thou shalt be hid from the scourge of the tongue: neither shalt thou be afraid of destruction when it cometh.
- !saiah 54:17 No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue *that* shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This *is* the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness *is* of me, saith the LORD.
- Psalm 23:4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil:for thou *art* with me; thy rod & thy staff they comfort me. Many times God in the Bible says "do not fear" & "be not afraid".
- Job 5:22 At destruction and famine thou shalt laugh: neither shalt thou be

- afraid of the beasts of the earth.
- Daniel 3:17,18 If it be *so*, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver *us* out of thine hand, O king. 18 But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.
- Job 5:23,24 For thou shalt be in league with the stones of the field: and the beasts of the field shall be at peace with thee. 24 And thou shalt know that thy tabernacle *shall be* in peace; and thou shalt visit thy habitation, and shalt not sin.
- Psalm 34:7 The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.
- Psalms 91:1-10 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. 2 I will say of the LORD, *He is* my <u>refuge and my fortress</u>: my God; in him will I trust. 3 Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, & from the noisome pestilence.
- Ask God to protect you from the devil's snares & to send them back upon the sending demons.
- Psalm 91:4 He shall <u>cover thee</u> with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: <u>his truth shall be thy shield and buckler</u>.
- Matthew 23:37 O <u>Jerusalem</u>, <u>Jerusalem</u>, <u>thou</u> that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under *her* wings, and ye would not!
- Like our Gospel armour in Ephesians 6.
- Mark 12:24 And Jesus answering said unto them, <u>Do</u> ye <u>not</u> therefore err, because ye <u>know not</u> the <u>scriptures</u>, neither the power of God?
- 1 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Ephesians 6:16 Above all, taking the <u>shield</u> of <u>faith</u>, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.
- Matthew 17:20 And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have <u>faith</u> as a grain of <u>mustard seed</u>, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.
- **Explained Romans' shield use & tortoise position.**
- Psalm 91:5 Thou shalt <u>not be afraid</u> for the <u>terror by night</u>; *nor* for the <u>arrow</u> that flieth by day; 6 Nor for the <u>pestilence</u> that walketh in darkness; nor for the <u>destruction</u> that wasteth at noonday. 7 A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall <u>not come nightee</u>. 8 Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked. 9 Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even

- the most High, thy habitation; 10 There shall <u>no evil befall thee</u>, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.
- More Service Notes: Proverbs 14:26 In the fear of the LORD *is* strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge.
- Proverbs 18:10 The name of the LORD *is* a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe.
- Ezekiel 9:4,6 And the LORD said unto him, Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and set a mark upon the foreheads of the men that sigh and that cry for all the abominations that be done in the midst thereof. 6 Slay utterly old and young, both maids, and little children, and women: but come not near any man upon whom is the mark; and begin at my sanctuary. Then they began at the ancient men which were before the house.
- Zephaniah 2:3 Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.
- Psalms 33:18,19 Behold, the eye of the LORD *is* upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy; 19 To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine.
- Proverbs 10:6,9 Blessings *are* upon the head of the just: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked. 9 He that walketh uprightly walketh surely: but he that perverteth his ways shall be known.
- Proverbs 11:4-6,8 Riches profit not in the day of wrath: but righteousness delivereth from death. 5 The righteousness of the perfect shall direct his way: but the wicked shall fall by his own wickedness. 6 The righteousness of the upright shall deliver them: but transgressors shall be taken in *their own* naughtiness. 8 The righteous is delivered out of trouble, and the wicked cometh in his stead.
- Isaiah 3:10 Say ye to the righteous, that *it shall be* well *with him*: for they shall eat the fruit of their doings.
- 2 Peter 2:7-9 And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked: 8 (For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed *his* righteous soul from day to day with *their* unlawful deeds;) 9 The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished:
