Acts 14:8-18 And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked: 9 The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed, 10 Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked. 11 And when the people saw what Paul had done, they lifted up their voices, saying in the speech of Lycaonia, The gods are come down to us in the likeness of men. 12 And they called Barnabas, Jupiter; and Paul, Mercurius, because he was the chief speaker. 13 Then the priest of Jupiter, which was before their city, brought oxen and garlands unto the gates, and would have done sacrifice with the people. 14 Which when the apostles, Barnabas and Paul, heard of, they rent their clothes, and ran in among the people, crying out, 15 And saying, Sirs, why do ye these things? We also are men of like passions with you, and preach unto you that ye should turn from these vanities unto the living God, which made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all things that are therein: 16 Who in times past suffered all nations to walk in their own ways. 17 Nevertheless he left not himself without witness, in that he did good, and gave us rain from heaven, and fruitful seasons, filling our hearts with food and gladness. 18 And with these sayings scarce restrained they the people, that they had not done sacrifice unto them.

Matthew 4:23,24 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them.

John 9:1-3 And as *Jesus* passed by, he saw a man which was blind from *his* birth. 2 And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind? 3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.

John 8:11 Explained - She said, <u>No</u> man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

Watch out for false healing movements.

2 Corinthians 12:7-10 paraphrased 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most

- gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- 2 Chronicles 16:9A For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of *them* whose heart *is* perfect toward him.
- Acts 14:8,9 And in Lystra a certain man without strength in his feet was sitting, a cripple from his mother's womb, who had never walked. 9 *This* man heard Paul speaking. Paul, observing him intently and seeing that he had faith to be healed,
- Mark 6:1-6 referred to Unbelief in Jesus' home town & just few healed Acts 14:10 said with a loud voice, "Stand up straight on your feet!" And he leaped and walked.
- Luke 16 & Lazarus raised referred to
- Acts 14:11-14 Now when the people saw what Paul had done, they raised their voices, saying in the Lycaonian language, "The gods have come down to us in the likeness of men!" 12 And Barnabas they called Zeus, and Paul, Hermes, because he was the chief speaker. 13 Then the priest of Zeus, whose temple was in front of their city, brought oxen and garlands to the gates, intending to sacrifice with the multitudes. 14 But when the apostles Barnabas and Paul heard this, they tore their clothes and ran in among the multitude, crying out 15 and saying, "Men, why are you doing these things? We also are men with the same nature as you, and preach to you that you should turn from these useless things to the living God, who made the heaven, the earth, the sea, and all things that are in them,
- Numbers 14: Summarized 10 Spies giving Evil report & V1 And all the congregation lifted up their voice, and cried; and the people wept that night.
- Acts 14:16 "who in bygone generations allowed all nations to walk in their own ways.
- Acts 17:30,31 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent: 31 Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of salvation.)
- Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Acts 14:17 "Nevertheless He did not leave Himself without witness, in that

- He did good, gave us rain from heaven and fruitful seasons, filling our hearts with food and gladness."
- Matthew 5:45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.
- Acts 14:18 And with these sayings they could scarcely restrain the multitudes from sacrificing to them.
- Leviticus 21:18 For whatsoever man *he be* that hath a blemish, he shall not approach: a blind man, or a <u>lame</u>, or he that hath a flat nose, or any thing superfluous,
- Deuteronomy 15:21 And if there be *any* blemish therein, *as if it be* <u>lame</u>, or blind, *or have* any ill blemish, thou shalt not sacrifice it unto the LORD thy God.
- John 5:1-6 After this there was a feast of the Jews; and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. 2 Now there is at Jerusalem by the sheep market a pool, which is called in the Hebrew tongue Bethesda, having five porches. 3 In these lay a great multitude of impotent folk, of blind, halt, withered, waiting for the moving of the water. 4 For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole of whatsoever disease he had. 5 And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years. 6 When Jesus saw him lie, and knew that he had been now a long time in that case, he saith unto him, Wilt thou be made whole?
- Mark 10 Blind Bart explained V51, 52 And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight. 52 And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.
- John 5:7-10 The impotent man answered him, Sir, I have no man, when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool: but while I am coming, another steppeth down before me. 8 Jesus saith unto him, Rise, take up thy bed, and walk. 9 And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked: and on the same day was the sabbath. 10 The Jews therefore said unto him that was cured, It is the sabbath day: it is not lawful for thee to carry thy bed.
- Mark16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Isaiah 46:1 Bel boweth down, Nebo stoopeth, their idols were upon the beasts, and upon the cattle: your carriages were heavy loaden; they are

- a burden to the weary beast.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- 2 Samuel 4:4 And Jonathan, Saul's son, had a son *that was* <u>lame</u> of *his* feet. He was five years old when the tidings came of Saul and Jonathan out of Jezreel, and his nurse took him up, and fled: and it came to pass, as she made haste to flee, that he fell, and became <u>lame</u>. And his name *was* Mephibosheth.
- 2 Samuel 5:6,8 And the king and his men went to Jerusalem unto the Jebusites, the inhabitants of the land: which spake unto David, saying, Except thou take away the blind and the <u>lame</u>, thou shalt not come in hither: thinking, David cannot come in hither. 8 And David said on that day, Whosoever getteth up to the gutter, and smiteth the Jebusites, and the <u>lame</u> and the blind, that are hated of David's soul, he shall be chief and captain. Wherefore they said, The blind and the <u>lame</u> shall not come into the house.
- 2 Samuel 9:3 And the king said, *Is* there not yet any of the house of Saul, that I may shew the kindness of God unto him? And Ziba said unto the king, Jonathan hath yet a son, *which* is <u>lame</u> on *his* feet. & v13.
- 2 Samuel 19:26 And he answered, My lord, O king, my servant deceived me: for thy servant said, I will saddle me an ass, that I may ride thereon, and go to the king; because thy servant *is* <u>lame</u>.
- Mark 16:18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Pray that medication & any deadly thing shall not hurt us.

Job 29:15 I was eyes to the blind, and feet was I to the lame.

New laws world wide - mercy killing or euthenasia of sick, elderly & disabled.

Proverbs 26:7 The legs of the <u>lame</u> are not equal: so *is* a parable in the mouth of fools.

Isaiah 35:6 Then shall the <u>lame</u> man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert.

Acts 3:9 And all the people saw him walking and praising God:

Mark 7:35 And straightway his ears were opened, and the <u>string</u> of his <u>tongue</u> was loosed, and he spake plain.

Malachi 1:13 Ye said also, Behold, what a weariness *is it*! and ye have snuffed at it, saith the LORD of hosts; and ye brought *that which was* torn, and the <u>lame</u>, and the sick; thus ye brought an offering: should I accept this of your hand? saith the LORD. (Give it to your governer)

More Service Notes:

- Jeremiah 31:8 Behold, I will bring them from the north country, and gather them from the coasts of the earth, *and* with them the blind and the <u>lame</u>, the woman with child and her that travaileth with child together: a great company shall return thither.
- Malachi 1:8 And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, *is it* not evil? and if ye offer the <u>lame</u> and sick, *is it* not evil? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts.
- Matthew 11:5 The blind receive their sight, and the <u>lame</u> walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them.
- Matthew 15:30,31 And great multitudes came unto him, having with them those that were <u>lame</u>, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them: 31 Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the <u>lame</u> to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.
- Matthew 21:14 And the blind and the <u>lame</u> came to him in the temple; and he healed them.
- Luke 7:22 Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that the blind see, the <u>lame</u> walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached.
- Luke 14:13 But when thou makest a feast, call the poor, the maimed, the <u>lame</u>, the blind:
- Acts 3:2 And a certain man <u>lame</u> from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple;
- Acts 3:11 And as the <u>lame</u> man which was healed held Peter and John, all the people ran together unto them in the porch that is called Solomon's, greatly wondering.
- Acts 8:7 For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.
- Hebrews 12:13 And make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is <u>lame</u> be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed.
