Whose Bands Are On You - Zechariah 11

- Zechariah 11:7 And I will feed the flock of slaughter, *even* you, O poor of the flock. And I took unto me two staves; the one I called Beauty, and the other I called Bands; and I fed the flock.
- Zechariah 11:14 Then I cut asunder mine other staff, *even* Bands, that I might break the brotherhood between Judah and Israel.

House of God is referred to as Beautiful.

God's Law is referred to as Bands.

Break the Bands was to break the close union between Judah & Israel.

- John 11:44 And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.
- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third & fourth *generation* of them that hate me;
- Strongs #02254 lbx chabal *khaw-bal'* AV-destroy 7, take a pledge 5, pledge 5, bands 2, brought forth 2, at all 1, corrupt 1, corruptly 1, offend 1, spoil 1, travaileth 1, very 1, withholden 1; 29
- 1) to bind 2) to take a pledge 3) to destroy, spoil, deal corruptly, offend, to be ruined, be broken 4) to bring forth, travail 4a) to writhe, twist
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me & my house, we will serve the LORD.
- Matthew 10:37He that <u>loves</u> father or mother <u>more</u> than me is <u>not</u> worthy of me: & he that <u>loves</u> son or daughter <u>more</u> than me is <u>not</u> worthy of me.
- Joshua 24:18 And the LORD drave out from before us all the <u>people</u>, even the Amorites which dwelt in the land: *therefore* will <u>we</u> also serve the LORD; for he *is* our <u>God</u>.
- Joshua 24:24 And the <u>people</u> said unto Joshua, The LORD our <u>God</u> will <u>we</u> serve, and his voice will <u>we</u> obey.
- Psalms 95:7,8 For he *is* our <u>God</u>; and <u>we</u> *are* the <u>people</u> of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. To day if ye will hear his voice, 8 Harden not your heart, as in the provocation, *and* as *in* the day of temptation in the wilderness:
- Hebrews 13:5 *Let your* conversation *be* without covetousness; *and be* content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will <u>never leave</u> thee, nor forsake thee.
- Psalms 100:3 Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us,

- and not <u>we</u> ourselves; <u>we</u> are his <u>people</u>, and the sheep of his pasture.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are <u>bought with</u> a <u>price</u>: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, <u>Father</u>, <u>forgive</u> them; for they know <u>not</u> what they <u>do</u>. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots
- Romans 6:1 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Isaiah 2:3 And many <u>people</u> shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the <u>God</u> of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and <u>we</u> will walk in his paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.
- Micah 4:5 For all <u>people</u> will walk every one in the name of his <u>god</u>, and <u>we</u> will walk in the name of the LORD our God for ever and ever.
- Zechariah 11:14 Then I cut asunder mine other staff, *even* Bands, that I might break the brotherhood (bond) between Judah and Israel.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.
- 1 Kings 11:1-8 Paraphrased V3,4 And he (Solomon) had seven hundred wives, princesses, and three hundred concubines: and his wives turned away his heart. 4 For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, *that* his wives turned away his heart after other gods: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as was the heart of David his father.

Evil soul ties or bands pull Believers down can be broken in Jesus' name.

Exodus 8:1B saith the LORD, Let my people go, that they may serve me.

- 1 Kings 14:30 there was <u>war</u> <u>between</u> <u>Rehoboam</u> & Jeroboam all *their* days.
- 1 Kings 15:6 And there was <u>war</u> <u>between</u> <u>Rehoboam</u> and Jeroboam all the days of his life.
- Luke 13:34,35 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets, and stonest them that are sent unto thee; how often would I have gathered thy children together, as a hen *doth gather* her brood under *her* wings, and ye would not! 35 Behold, your house is left unto you desolate: and verily I say unto you, Ye shall not see me, until *the time* come when ye shall say, Blessed *is* he that cometh in the name of the Lord.
- Matthew 23:35 That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of <u>Zacharias</u> son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar.

Mark 13:14-20 Paraphrased

1 Corinthians 11:21-23; Paraphrased & V27-30 Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink *this* cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty

- of the body and blood of the Lord. 28 But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of *that* bread, and drink of *that* cup. 29 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. 30 For this cause many *are* weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- Song of Solomon 2:4 He brought me to the banqueting house, and his banner over me *was* love.
- John 3:16,17 For God so <u>loved the world</u>, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.
- John 16:8 And when he (the Holy Spirit) is come, he will reprove the world of <u>sin</u>, and of <u>righteousness</u>, and of judgment:
- John 3:18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
- Psalms 23:3 He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.
- Good soul tie breaker spirit causes strife.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Ecclesiastes 4:12 And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-11 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer.
