Acts 14:19-28 And there came thither certain Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew him out of the city, supposing he had been dead. 20 Howbeit, as the disciples stood round about him, he rose up, and came into the city: and the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe. 21 And when they had preached the gospel to that city, and had taught many, they returned again to Lystra, and to Iconium, and Antioch, 22 Confirming the souls of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God. 23 And when they had ordained them elders in every church, and had prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord, on whom they believed. 24 And after they had passed throughout Pisidia, they came to Pamphylia. 25 And when they had preached the word in Perga, they went down into Attalia: 26 And thence sailed to Antioch, from whence they had been recommended to the grace of God for the work which they fulfilled. 27 And when they were come, and had gathered the church together, they rehearsed all that God had done with them, and how he had opened the door of faith unto the Gentiles. 28 And there they abode long time with the disciples.

Explained art of persuasion Godly vs. ungodly. Often mind control is used.

Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

- John 15:20 (NKJV) "Remember the word that I said to you, `A servant is not greater than his master.' <u>If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute</u> you. If they kept My word, they will keep yours also.
- John 15:20 (Message) "When that happens, remember this: Servants don't get better treatment than their masters. <u>If they beat on me, they will certainly beat on you</u>. If they did what I told them, they will do what you tell them.
- 1 Corinthians 10:13 There hath no <u>temptation</u> taken you but such as is common to man: but God *is* faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the <u>temptation</u> also <u>make</u> a <u>way</u> to escape, that ye may be able to bear *it*.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Pray for the persecuted Believers.

Acts 14:23 And when they had ordained them elders in every church, and had prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord, on whom they believed.

Explained church leadership. Referred to Leviticus 18 & 20 guidelines.

Isaiah 58 - referred to as God's Chosen Fast chapter.

Mind Control vs. Charisma & the Art of persuasion vs exhortation.

- Romans 12:2 And be <u>not conformed</u> to this <u>world</u>: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- 1 Kings 22:20-23 And the LORD said, Who shall <u>persuade</u> Ahab, that he may go up and fall at Ramothgilead? And one said on this manner, and another said on that manner. 21 And there came forth a spirit, and stood before the LORD, and said, I will <u>persuade</u> him. 22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a <u>lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets</u>. And he said, Thou shalt <u>persuade him</u>, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- Master of persuasion satan in Garden of Eden. Paraphrased the fall of mankind in Genesis 3.
- Jeremiah 13:23 Can the Ethiopian change his skin, or the leopard his spots? *then* may ye also do good, that are accustomed to do evil.
- Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore <u>wise</u> as <u>serpents</u>, and harmless as doves.

More Service Notes:

- 2 Kings 18:32 Until I come and take you away to a land like your own land, a land of corn and wine, a land of bread and vineyards, a land of oil olive and of honey, that ye may live, and not die: and hearken not unto Hezekiah, when he <u>persuadeth</u> you, saying, The LORD will deliver us.
- 2 Chronicles 18:2 And after *certain* years he went down to Ahab to Samaria. And Ahab killed sheep and oxen for him in abundance, and for the people that *he had* with him, and <u>persuaded</u> him to go up *with him* to Ramothgilead.
- 2 Chronicles 32:11 Doth not Hezekiah persuade you to give over yourselves

- to die by famine and by thirst, saying, The LORD our God shall deliver us out of the hand of the king of Assyria?
- 2 Chronicles 32:15 Now therefore let not Hezekiah deceive you, nor <u>persuade</u> you on this manner, neither yet believe him: for no god of any nation or kingdom was able to deliver his people out of mine hand, and out of the hand of my fathers: how much less shall your God deliver you out of mine hand?
- Proverbs 25:15 By long forbearing is a prince <u>persuaded</u>, and a soft tongue breaketh the bone.
- Isaiah 36:18 *Beware* lest Hezekiah <u>persuade</u> you, saying, The LORD will deliver us. Hath any of the gods of the nations delivered his land out of the hand of the king of Assyria?
- Matthew 27:20 But the chief priests and elders <u>persuaded</u> the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus.
- Matthew 28:14 And if this come to the governor's ears, we will <u>persuade</u> him, and secure you.
- Luke 16:31 And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be <u>persuaded</u>, though one rose from the dead.
- Luke 20:6 But and if we say, Of men; all the people will stone us: for they be <u>persuaded</u> that John was a prophet.
- Acts 13:43 Now when the congregation was broken up, many of the Jews and religious proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas: who, speaking to them, <u>persuaded</u> them to continue in the grace of God.
- Acts 18:4 And he reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, and <u>persuaded</u> the Jews and the Greeks.
- Acts 18:13 Saying, This *fellow* <u>persuadeth</u> men to worship God contrary to the law.
- Acts 19:8,26 And he went into the synagogue, and spake boldly for the space of three months, disputing and <u>persuading</u> the things concerning the kingdom of God. 26 Moreover ye see and hear, that not alone at Ephesus, but almost throughout all Asia, this Paul hath <u>persuaded</u> and turned away much people, saying that they be no gods, which are made with hands:
- Acts 21:14 And when he would not be <u>persuaded</u>, we ceased, saying, The will of the Lord be done.
- Acts 26:26,28 For the king knoweth of these things, before whom also I speak freely: for I am <u>persuaded</u> that none of these things are hidden from him; for this thing was not done in a corner. 28 Then Agrippa said unto Paul, Almost thou <u>persuadest</u> me to be a Christian.
- Acts 28:23 And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into *his* lodging; to whom he expounded and testified the kingdom of God, <u>persuading</u> them concerning Jesus, both out of the law of Moses,

- and out of the prophets, from morning till evening.
- Romans 4:21 And being fully <u>persuaded</u> that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.
- Romans 8:38 For I am <u>persuaded</u>, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,
- Romans 14:5 One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day *alike*. Let every man be fully <u>persuaded</u> in his own mind.
- Romans 14:14 I know, and am <u>persuaded</u> by the Lord Jesus, that *there is* nothing unclean of itself: but to him that esteemeth any thing to be unclean, to him *it is* unclean.
- Romans 15:14 And I myself also am <u>persuaded</u> of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another.
- 2 Corinthians 5:11 Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we <u>persuade</u> men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences.
- Galatians 1:10 For do I now <u>persuade</u> men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.
- Galatians 5:8 This persuasion cometh not of him that calleth you.
- 2 Timothy 1:5 When I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am <u>persuaded</u> that in thee also.
- 2 Timothy 1:12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am <u>persuaded</u> that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.
- Hebrews 6:9 But, beloved, we are <u>persuaded</u> better things of you, and things that accompany salvation, though we thus speak.
- Hebrews 11:13 These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were <u>persuaded</u> of *them*, and embraced *them*, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.
