## **Removed From Their Tents - Joshua 3C**

- Joshua 3:14-17 And it came to pass, when the people removed from their tents, to pass over Jordan, and the priests bearing the ark of the covenant before the people; 15 And as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,) 16 That the waters which came down from above stood and rose up upon an heap very far from the city Adam, that is beside Zaretan: and those that came down toward the sea of the plain, even the salt sea, failed, and were cut off: and the people passed over right against Jericho. 17 And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over on dry ground, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan.
- Summarized from leaving Egypt until now. The encampment was 12 miles by 12 miles square for 2.5 million Isrealites. They had to get out of their comfort zone to move on. People go through many such stages in life.
- Hebrews 4:15 For we have not an <u>high</u> priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points <u>tempted</u> like as *we are, yet* without sin.
- Joshua 3:14-16 And it came to pass, when the people removed from their tents, to pass over Jordan, and the priests bearing the ark of the covenant before the people; 15 And as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, & the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overflowed all his banks all the time of harvest,) 16 That the waters which came down from above stood & rose up upon an heap very far from the city Adam, that is beside Zaretan: & those that came down toward the sea of the plain, even the salt sea, failed, & were cut off: & the people passed over right against Jericho.
- 12 miles by 12 miles square for 2.5 million Isrealites to pass over Jordan.
- Joshua 3:17 And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on <u>dry ground in the midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over on dry ground</u>, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan.
- Joshua 5:12 And the <u>manna ceased</u> on the morrow after they had eaten of the old corn of the land; neither had the children of Israel <u>manna</u> any more; but they did eat of the fruit of the land of Canaan that year.
- Deuteronomy 28:12 The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to <u>bless</u> all the

work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.

**Summarized David's travels.** 

1 Samuel 22:5 And the prophet Gad said unto David, <u>Abide not in the hold;</u> depart, and get thee into the land of <u>Judah</u>. Then David departed, and came into the forest of Hareth.

Face the enemy & fight back in the heavenlies, not run away.

- Because of sin they lost the privilege to stay in their comfort zone. After the kings Isreal sinned & were exiled for 70 years summarized.
- Genesis 3:22-24 And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever: 23 Therefore the LORD God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from whence he was taken. 24 So he drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Forgiven but suffer consequences of sin. Deuteronomy 23:2 A bastard shall not enter into the congregation of the LORD; even to his <u>tenth</u> <u>generation</u> shall he not enter into the congregation of the LORD.

Explains consequences of Adam's sin.

- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the <u>day</u> of <u>salvation</u> have I succoured thee: behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the <u>day</u> of <u>salvation</u>.)
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

God's provisions to break curse of Eve

1 Timothy 2:15 Notwithstanding she shall be <u>saved</u> in <u>childbearing</u>, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety.

Summarized Lot & family leaving Sodom.

Genesis 12:1-5 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: 2 And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: 3 And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed. 4 So Abram departed, as the LORD had spoken unto him; & Lot went with him: & Abram was 75 years old when he departed out of Haran. 5 & Abram took Sarai his wife, & Lot his brother's son, & all their substance that they had gathered, & the souls that they had gotten in Haran; & they went forth to go into the land of Canaan; & into the land of Canaan they came.

- Summarized travels of Abram leaving his comfort zone to follow God.
- Genesis 12:3B In thee (Abram) shall all families of the earth be blessed (through the Lord Jesus).
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

Job expelled from his comfort zone.

Luke 4 Temptations of our Lord Jesus referred to.

God restrained satan from destroying Job when he was tested.

- 2 Corinthians 3:4 (God) Who comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God.
- 2 Corinthians 11 Paul's in Perils chapter referred to.
- Job 1:20-22 Then Job arose, and rent his mantle, and shaved his head, and fell down upon the ground, and worshipped, 21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD. 22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.

Summarized of early Christian martyrs.

- Mark 8:38 Whosoever therefore shall be <u>ashamed of me & of my words</u> in this <u>adulterous & sinful generation</u>; of him also shall the Son of man be <u>ashamed</u>, when he comes in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.
- Joseph fled from advances of Potiphar's wife.
- Luke 9:26 For whosoever shall be <u>ashamed</u> of <u>me</u> and of my words, of him shall the Son of man be <u>ashamed</u>, when he shall come in his own glory, and *in his* Father's, and of the holy angels.
- 2 Timothy 1:8 Be not thou therefore <u>ashamed</u> of the testimony of our Lord, nor of <u>me</u> his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God;
- 2 Timothy 1:16 The Lord give mercy unto the house of Onesiphorus; for he oft refreshed me, and was not ashamed of my chain:
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- Matthew 11:28-30 <u>Come unto me</u>, all *ye* that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For my yoke *is* easy, and my burden is light.
