## **Going in God's Direction - Acts 16B**

Summarize situation to now.

Acts 16:6-15 Now when they had gone throughout Phrygia and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden of the Holy Ghost to preach the word in Asia, 7 After they were come to Mysia, they assayed to go into Bithynia: but the Spirit suffered them not. 8 And they passing by Mysia came down to Troas. 9 And a vision appeared to Paul in the night; There stood a man of Macedonia, and prayed him, saying, Come over into Macedonia, and help us. 10 And after he had seen the vision, immediately we endeavoured to go into Macedonia, assuredly gathering that the Lord had called us for to preach the gospel unto them. 11 Therefore loosing from Troas, we came with a straight course to Samothracia, and the next day to Neapolis; 12 And from thence to Philippi, which is the chief city of that part of Macedonia, and a colony: and we were in that city abiding certain days. 13 And on the sabbath we went out of the city by a river side, where prayer was wont to be made; and we sat down, and spake unto the women which resorted thither. 14 And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard us: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul. 15 And when she was baptized, and her household, she besought us, saying, If ye have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come into my house, and abide there. And she constrained us.

Matthew 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide *is* the gate, and <u>broad</u> *is* the <u>way</u>, that leadeth to <u>destruction</u>, and many there be which go in thereat:

Going God's way or our way asking God to bless it.

Galations 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?

Ask God open doors He wants us to go through & close the doors He doesn't want us to go through.

Acts 16:8-9 And they passing by Mysia came down to Troas. 9 And a vision appeared to Paul in the night; There stood a man of Macedonia, and prayed him, saying, Come over into Macedonia, and help us.

Judges 6 Gideon testing If it was God

- 2 Corinthians 11:13,14 For such *are* false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. 14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.
- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
- Acts 16:10-12 And after he had seen the vision, immediately we endeavoured to go into Macedonia, assuredly gathering that the Lord had called us for to preach the gospel unto them. 11 Therefore loosing from Troas, we came with a straight course to Samothracia, and the next day to Neapolis; 12 And from thence to Philippi, which is the chief city of that part of Macedonia, and a colony: and we were in that city

- Acts 16:15 And when she was baptized, and her household, she besought us, saying, If ye have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come into my house, and abide there. And she constrained us.
- Romans 12:2 And be not <u>conformed</u> to this <u>world</u>: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Mark 10 Rich young ruler referred to.

Job was rich & trusted God.

- Mark 10:23 And Jesus looked round about, and saith unto his disciples, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God! 24 And the disciples were astonished at his words. But Jesus answereth again, and saith unto them, Children, how hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God! 25 It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.
- Luke 12:17-21 And he thought within himself, saying, What shall I do, because I have no room where to bestow my fruits? 18 And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater; and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods. 19 And I will say to my soul, Soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years; take thine ease, eat, drink, and be merry. 20 But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided? 21 So is he that layeth up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God.

Luke 19 Rich man & Lazarus referred to

Numbers 22:22 And God's anger was kindled because he went: and the

angel of the LORD stood in the way for an adversary against him. Now he was riding upon his ass, and his two servants were with him.

**Explained situation of Baalim.** 

1 Timothy 6:10 For the <u>love</u> of <u>money</u> is the root of all <u>evil</u>: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

Numbers 24 Summarized.

Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of <u>Balaam</u>, who taught Balac to cast a <u>stumblingblock</u> before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.

Joshua 13:22 <u>Balaam</u> also the son of Beor, the soothsayer, did the children of Israel slay with the sword among them that were slain by them.

Matthew 1:20 But while he thought on these things, behold, the <u>angel</u> of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, <u>Joseph</u>, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

Referred to Peter in Jail & angel woke him & freed him.

Matthew 1:24 Then <u>Joseph</u> being raised from sleep did as the <u>angel</u> of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife:

Matthew 2:13 And when they were departed, behold, the <u>angel</u> of the Lord appeareth to <u>Joseph</u> in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him.

This was after the 3 wise men were at the House to see the young child Jesus with gifts to provide for this trip to Egypt.

1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: <u>evil</u> communications <u>corrupt</u> good manners.

Pray for God to guide Children.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and <u>admonition</u> of the <u>Lord</u>.

Matthew 2:19 But when Herod was dead, behold, an <u>angel</u> of the Lord appeareth in a dream to <u>Joseph</u> in Egypt,

Leviticus 19:31 Regard not them that have <u>familiar spirits</u>, neither seek after wizards, to be defiled by them: I *am* the LORD your God.

Leviticus 20:6 And the soul that turneth after such as have <u>familiar spirits</u>, and after wizards, to go a whoring after them, I will even set my face against that soul, and will cut him off from among his people.

Leviticus 20:27 A man also or woman that hath a <u>familiar spirit</u>, or that is a wizard, shall surely be put to death: they shall stone them with stones: their blood *shall be* upon them.

Deuteronomy 18:11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with <u>familiar</u> <u>spirits</u>, or a wizard, or a necromancer.

1 Samuel 28: summarized of Saul & witch at Endor.

Isaiah 8:19 And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have <u>familiar spirits</u>, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their God? for the living to the dead?

**More Service Notes:** 

- 1 Samuel 28:3 Now Samuel was dead, and all Israel had lamented him, and buried him in Ramah, even in his own city. And Saul had put away those that had <u>familiar</u> <u>spirits</u>, and the wizards, out of the land.
- 1 Samuel 28:7-9 Then said Saul unto his servants, Seek me a woman that

hath a <u>familiar spirit</u>, that I may go to her, and enquire of her. And his servants said to him, Behold, *there is* a woman that hath a <u>familiar spirit</u> at Endor. 8 And Saul disguised himself, and put on other raiment, and he went, and two men with him, and they came to the woman by night: and he said, I pray thee, divine unto me by the <u>familiar spirit</u>, and bring me him up, whom I shall name unto thee. 9 And the woman said unto him, Behold, thou knowest what Saul hath done, how he hath cut off those that have <u>familiar spirits</u>, and the wizards, out of the land: wherefore then layest thou a snare for my life, to cause me to die?

- 2 Kings 21:6 And he made his son pass through the fire, and observed times, and used enchantments, and dealt with <u>familiar spirits</u> and wizards: he wrought much wickedness in the sight of the LORD, to provoke *him* to anger.
- 2 Kings 23:24 Moreover the *workers with* familiar spirits, and the wizards, and the images, and the idols, and all the abominations that were spied in the land of Judah and in Jerusalem, did Josiah put away, that he might perform the words of the law which were written in the book that Hilkiah the priest found in the house of the LORD.
- 1 Chronicles 10:13 So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, even against the word of the LORD, which he kept not, and also for asking counsel of one that had a familiar spirit, to enquire of it;
- 2 Chronicles 33:6 And he caused his children to pass through the fire in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he observed times, and used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a <u>familiar spirit</u>, and with wizards: he wrought much evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.
- Isaiah 19:3 And the spirit of Egypt shall fail in the midst thereof; and I will destroy the counsel thereof: and they shall seek to the idols, and to the charmers, and to them that have <u>familiar spirits</u>, and to the wizards.
- Isaiah 29:4 And thou shalt be brought down, *and* shalt speak out of the ground, and thy speech shall be low out of the dust, and thy voice shall be, as of one that hath a <u>familiar spirit</u>, out of the ground, and thy speech shall whisper out of the dust.
