Memorials - Joshua 4A

Joshua 4:1-9 - 1 And it came to pass, when all the people were clean passed over Jordan, that the LORD spake unto Joshua, saying, 2 Take you twelve men out of the people, out of every tribe a man, 3 And command ye them, saying, Take you hence out of the midst of Jordan, out of the place where the priests' feet stood firm, twelve stones, and ye shall carry them over with you, and leave them in the lodging place, where ye shall lodge this night. 4 Then Joshua called the twelve men, whom he had prepared of the children of Israel, out of every tribe a man: 5 And Joshua said unto them, Pass over before the ark of the LORD your God into the midst of Jordan, and take ye up every man of you a stone upon his shoulder, according unto the number of the tribes of the children of Israel: 6 That this may be a sign among you, that when your children ask their fathers in time to come, saying, What mean ye by these stones? 7 Then ye shall answer them, That the waters of Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the LORD; when it passed over Jordan, the waters of Jordan were cut off: and these stones shall be for a memorial unto the children of Israel for ever. 8 And the children of Israel did so as Joshua commanded, and took up twelve stones out of the midst of Jordan, as the LORD spake unto Joshua, according to the number of the tribes of the children of Israel, and carried them over with them unto the place where they lodged, and laid them down there. 9 And Joshua set up twelve stones in the midst of Jordan, in the place where the feet of the priests which bare the ark of the covenant stood: and they are there unto this day.

Joshua 4:1 And it came to pass, when all the people were clean passed over Jordan, that the LORD spake unto Joshua, saying,

Numbers 13:2 Send thou men, that they may search the land of Canaan, which I give unto the children of Israel: of every tribe of their fathers shall ye send a man, every one a ruler among them.

Joshua 4:2-7 Take you twelve men out of the people, out of every tribe a man, 3 And command ye them, saying, Take you hence out of the midst of Jordan, out of the place where the priests' feet stood firm, twelve stones, and ye shall carry them over with you, and leave them in the lodging place, where ye shall lodge this night. 4 Then Joshua called the twelve men, whom he had prepared of the children of Israel, out of every tribe a man: 5 And Joshua said unto them, Pass over before the ark of the LORD your God into the midst of Jordan, and take ye up every man of you a stone upon his shoulder, according unto the number of the tribes

- Exodus 13:8 And thou shalt shew thy son in that day, saying, *This is done* because of that *which* the LORD did unto me when I came forth out of Egypt.
- Joshua 4:8 And the children of Israel did so as Joshua commanded, and took up twelve stones out of the midst of Jordan, as the LORD spake unto Joshua, according to the number of the tribes of the children of Israel, and carried them over with them unto the place where they lodged, and laid them down there. 9 And Joshua set up twelve stones in the midst of Jordan, in the place where the feet of the priests which bare the ark of the covenant stood: and they are there unto this day.

- 1) a memorial (that by which the memory of any person or thing is preserved), a remembrance
- Genesis 9:16 And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that is upon the earth.
- Exodus 12:14 And this day shall be unto you for a memorial <02146>; and ye shall keep it a feast to the LORD throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance for ever.
- Luke 22:19 And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake *it*, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in <u>remembrance</u> of me.
- Explained symbology of Lord's supper & how it relates to what Jesus did for us.
- 1 Corinthians 11:24,25 And when he had given thanks, he brake *it*, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in <u>remembrance</u> of me. 25 After the same manner also *he took* the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink *it*, in <u>remembrance</u> of me.

No fermentation at Passover - it is a symbol of sin.

- 1 Corinthians 11:26 For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come.
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not.

- And if any man sin, we have an <u>advocate</u> with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; & they loved not their lives unto the death.
- 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Isaiah 1:18 Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.
- Exodus 12:14 And this day shall be unto you for a memorial <02146>; and ye shall keep it a feast to the LORD throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance for ever.
- Exodus 13:9 And it shall be for a sign unto thee upon thine hand, and for a memorial <02146> between thine eyes, that the LORD'S law may be in thy mouth: for with a strong hand hath the LORD brought thee out of Egypt.
- Exodus 17:14 And the LORD said unto Moses, Write this *for* a memorial <02146> in a book, and rehearse *it* in the ears of Joshua: for I will utterly put out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven.
- Exodus 28:12 And thou shalt put the two stones upon the shoulders of the ephod *for* stones of memorial <02146> unto the children of Israel: and Aaron shall bear their names before the LORD upon his two shoulders for a memorial <02146>.
- Exodus 28:29 And Aaron shall bear the names of the children of Israel in the breastplate of judgment upon his heart, when he goeth in unto the holy *place*, for a memorial <02146> before the LORD continually.
- Exodus 30:16 And thou shalt take the atonement money of the children of Israel, and shalt appoint it for the service of the tabernacle of the congregation; that it may be a memorial <02146> unto the children of Israel before the LORD, to make an atonement for your souls.
- 1 Samuel 15:22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and <u>sacrifices</u>, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to <u>obey</u> is <u>better</u> than <u>sacrifice</u>, and to hearken than the fat of rams.
- Exodus 39:7 And he put them on the shoulders of the ephod, *that they* should be stones for a memorial <02146> to the children of Israel; as the LORD commanded Moses.
- Leviticus 23:24 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first *day* of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial <02146> of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

- Jesus often said "tell no man" when He did miracles.
- Numbers 5:15 Then shall the man bring his wife unto the priest, and he shall bring her offering for her, the tenth *part* of an ephah of barley meal; he shall pour no oil upon it, nor put frankincense thereon; for it *is* an offering of jealousy, an offering of memorial <02146>, bringing iniquity to remembrance. (Explained)
- Numbers 5:18 And the priest shall set the woman before the LORD, and uncover the woman's head (show she is coming out from under husband's covering), and put the offering of memorial <02146> in her hands, which is the jealousy offering: and the priest shall have in his hand the bitter water that causeth the curse:
- Numbers 10:10 Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of your months, ye shall blow with the trumpets over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; that they may be to you for a memorial <02146> before your God: I am the LORD your God.
- Numbers 16:40 *To be* a memorial <02146> unto the children of Israel, that no stranger, which *is* not of the seed of Aaron, come near to offer incense before the LORD; that he be not as Korah, and as his company: as the LORD said to him by the hand of Moses. (Explained)
- Numbers 31:54 And Moses and Eleazar the priest took the gold of the captains of thousands and of hundreds, and brought it into the tabernacle of the congregation, *for* a memorial <02146> for the children of Israel before the LORD.
- Nehemiah 2:20 Then answered I them, and said unto them, The God of heaven, he will prosper us; therefore we his servants will arise and build: but ye have no portion, nor right, nor memorial <02146>, in Jerusalem.
- Esther 6:1 On that night could not the king sleep, and he commanded to bring the book of records <02146> of the chronicles; and they were read before the king. (Explained)
- The Word of God is the record of God's memorial. Look at the Old Testament through the sayings of Jesus.
- Matthew 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to <u>lust</u> after her hath committed adultery with her already in his <u>heart</u>.
- Job 13:12 Your remembrances <02146> are like unto ashes, your bodies to bodies of clay.
- Ecclesiastes 1:11 There is no remembrance <02146> of former things; neither shall there be any remembrance <02146> of things that are to come with those that shall come after.
- Ecclesiastes 2:16 For *there is* no remembrance <02146> of the wise more than of the fool for ever; seeing that which now *is* in the days to come shall all be forgotten. And how dieth the wise *man*? as the fool.

- Isaiah 57:8 Behind the doors also and the posts hast thou set up thy remembrance <02146>: for thou hast discovered thyself to another than me, and art gone up; thou hast enlarged thy bed, and made thee a covenant with them; thou lovedst their bed where thou sawest it.
- Ezekiel 8 God shows him evil in temple through God's knothole.
- Zechariah 6:14 And the crowns shall be to Helem, and to Tobijah, and to Jedaiah, and to Hen the son of Zephaniah, for a memorial <02146> in the temple of the LORD.
- Malachi 3:16 Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard *it*, and a book of remembrance <02146> was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.
- Matthew 26:13 Verily I say unto you, Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached in the whole world, *there* shall also this, that this woman hath done, be told for a <u>memorial</u> of her. (Explained)
- Mark 11:21 And Peter calling to <u>remembrance</u> saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away.
- Mark 14:9 Verily I say unto you, Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached throughout the whole world, *this* also that she hath done shall be spoken of for a <u>memorial</u> of her.
- Luke 1:54 He hath holpen his servant Israel, in <u>remembrance</u> of *his* mercy;
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, <u>Father</u>, <u>forgive</u> <u>them</u>; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- Luke 22:19 And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake *it*, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.
- John 1:19 And this is the <u>record</u> of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou?

More Service Notes:

- John 1:32 And John bare <u>record</u>, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.
- John 1:34 And I saw, and bare <u>record</u> that this is the Son of God.
- John 8:1 The Pharisees therefore said unto him, Thou bearest <u>record</u> of thyself; thy <u>record</u> is not true.
- John 8:14 Jesus answered and said unto them, Though I bear <u>record</u> of myself, <u>yet</u> my <u>record</u> is true: for I know whence I came, and whither I go; but ye cannot tell whence I come, and whither I go.
- John 12:17 The people therefore that was with him when he called Lazarus out of his grave, and raised him from the dead, bare <u>record</u>.
- John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your <u>remembrance</u>, whatsoever I have said unto you.

- John 19:35 And he that saw *it* bare <u>record</u>, and his <u>record</u> is true: and he knoweth that he saith true, that ye might believe.
- Acts 10:4 And when he looked on him, he was afraid, and said, What is it, Lord? And he said unto him, Thy prayers and thine alms are come up for a <u>memorial</u> before God.
- Acts 10:31 And said, Cornelius, thy prayer is heard, and thine alms are had in <u>remembrance</u> in the sight of God.
- Acts 20:26 Wherefore I take you to <u>record</u> this day, that I *am* pure from the blood of all *men*.
- Romans 10:2 For I bear them <u>record</u> that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge.
- 1 Corinthians 4:17 For this cause have I sent unto you Timotheus, who is my beloved son, and faithful in the Lord, who shall bring you into <u>remembrance</u> of my ways which be in Christ, as I teach every where in every church.
- 2 Corinthians 1:23 Moreover I call God for a <u>record</u> upon my soul, that to spare you I came not as yet unto Corinth.
- 2 Corinthians 8:3 For to *their* power, I bear <u>record</u>, yea, and beyond *their* power *they were* willing of themselves;
- Galatians 4:15 Where is then the blessedness ye spake of? for I bear you <u>record</u>, that, if *it had been* possible, ye would have plucked out your own eyes, and have given them to me.
- Philippians 1:3,8 I thank my God upon every <u>remembrance</u> of you, 8 For God is my <u>record</u>, how greatly I long after you all in the bowels of Jesus Christ.
- Colossians 4:13 For I bear him <u>record</u>, that he hath a great zeal for you, and them *that are* in Laodicea, and them in Hierapolis.
- 1 Thessalonians 3:6 But now when Timotheus came from you unto us, and brought us good tidings of your faith and charity, and that ye have good remembrance of us always, desiring greatly to see us, as we also to see you:
- 1 Timothy 4:6 If thou put the brethren in <u>remembrance</u> of these things, thou shalt be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished up in the words of faith and of good doctrine, whereunto thou hast attained.
- 2 Timothy 1:3,5,6 I thank God, whom I serve from *my* forefathers with pure conscience, that without ceasing I have <u>remembrance</u> of thee in my prayers night and day; 5 When I call to <u>remembrance</u> the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also. 6 Wherefore I put thee in <u>remembrance</u> that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands.
- 2 Timothy 2:14 Of these things put them in remembrance, charging them

- before the Lord that they strive not about words to no profit, *but* to the subverting of the hearers.
- Hebrews 10:3 But in those *sacrifices there is* a <u>remembrance</u> again *made* of sins every year.
- Hebrews 10:32 But call to <u>remembrance</u> the former days, in which, after ye were illuminated, ye endured a great fight of afflictions;
- 2 Peter 1:12,13,15 Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in <u>remembrance</u> of these things, though ye know *them*, and be established in the present truth. 13 Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this tabernacle, to stir you up by putting *you* in <u>remembrance</u>; 15 Moreover I will endeavour that ye may be able after my decease to have these things always in <u>remembrance</u>.
- 2 Peter 3:1 This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in *both* which I stir up your pure minds by way of <u>remembrance</u>:
- 1 John 5:7 For there are three that bear <u>record</u> in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.
- 1 John 5:10,11 He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the <u>record</u> that God gave of his Son. 11 And this is the <u>record</u>, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.
- 3 John 1:12 Demetrius hath good report of all *men*, and of the truth itself: yea, and we *also* bear <u>record</u>; and ye know that our <u>record</u> is true.
- Jude 1:5 I will therefore put you in <u>remembrance</u>, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.
- Revelation 1:2 Who bare <u>record</u> of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw.
- Revelation 16:19 And the great city was divided into 3 parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in <u>remembrance</u> before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.
- Luke 22:19 And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake *it*, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.
- 1 Corinthians 11:24 And when he had given thanks, he brake *it*, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.
