Paul and the Jailer - Acts 16D

Summarized earlier in Chapter.

- Acts 16:25-34 And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them. 26 And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, & everyone's bands were loosed. 27 And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled. 28 But Paul cried with a loud voice, saying, Do thyself no harm: for we are all here. 29 Then he called for a light & sprang in & came trembling & fell down before Paul & Silas, 30 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? 31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. 32 And they spake unto him the word of the Lord, and to all that were in his house. 33 And he took them the same hour of the night, & washed their stripes; & was baptized, he & all his, straightway. 34 And when he had brought them into his house, he set meat before them, and rejoiced, believing in God with all his house.
- Mark 13:11 But when they shall lead *you*, and deliver you up, take no thought beforehand what ye shall speak, neither do ye premeditate: but whatsoever shall be given you in that hour, that speak ye: for it is not ye that speak, but the Holy Ghost
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an <u>advocate</u> with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:17 Pray without ceasing.
- Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer & supplication in the Spirit, & watching thereunto with all perseverance & supplication for all saints;
- In the Old Covenant they prayed against people, but in the New Covenant, we pray against spiritual enemy in the heavenlies. Like Jesus did, Hate the sin but love the sinner.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Acts 16:25 And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed

be the name of the LORD.

Psalms 150:1-6 Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in His sanctuary: praise Him in the firmament of his power. 2 Praise Him for His mighty acts: praise Him according to His excellent greatness. 3 Praise Him with the sound of the trumpet: praise Him with the psaltery & harp. 4 Praise Him with the timbrel & dance: praise Him with stringed instruments & organs. 5 Praise him upon the loud cymbals: praise him upon the high sounding cymbals. 6 Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD.

Acts 16:26 And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed.

Acts 12:2 And he killed James the brother of John with the sword.

Acts 12 Summarized Peter jailed & released by angel.

Acts 14 Summarized Paul stoned & raised from death.

Acts 16:27 And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, & seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled.

Matthew 12 & Luke 11 Jesus cautions to not cast demons out of unbelievers. They do not have God's Holy Spirit.

Luke 11:26 Then goeth he, and taketh *to him* seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last *state* of that man is worse than the first.

Acts 16:28 Paul cried "Do thyself no harm: for we are all here."

Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a <u>fault</u>, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. John 3 Nicodemus referred to.

John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

1 King 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.

Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among

- my people; 14 If my people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, & pray, & seek my face, & turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, & will forgive their sin, & will heal their land.
- Matthew 3:8 Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:
- Luke 3:8 Bring forth therefore <u>fruits</u> worthy of <u>repentance</u>, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to *our* father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.
- Acts 16:29-31 Then he called for a light, and sprang in, and came trembling, and fell down before Paul and Silas, 30 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? 31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any *man* pluck them out of my hand. 29 My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck *them* out of my Father's hand.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all *ye* that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of salvation.)
- Summarized when the season of grace is over & Jesus returns.
- Luke 23:42,43 And he said unto Jesus, Lord, <u>remember me</u> when thou comest into thy <u>kingdom</u>. 43 And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise.
- Luke 8:12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.
- Acts 16:32-33 And they spake unto him the word of the Lord, and to all that were in his house. 33 And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed their stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway.
- Luke 11:33 No man, when he hath lighted a candle, putteth *it* in a secret place, neither under a <u>bushel</u>, but on a candlestick, that they which come in may see the light.
- Acts 16:34 And when he had brought them into his house, he set meat before them, and rejoiced, believing in God with all his house.
- Mark 10:13,14 And they brought young children to him, that He should touch them: and his disciples rebuked those that brought them. 14 But when Jesus saw it, he was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.
- Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

- 2 Chronicles 20:20-30 20 And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper.
- 2 Chronicles 20:21,22 And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for His mercy *endureth* for ever. (like Psalm 136) 22 And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.

Psalm 68:1 Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered: let them also that hate him flee before him.

2 Chronicles 20:23 For the children of Ammon and Moab stood up against the inhabitants of mount Seir, utterly to slay and destroy *them*: and when they had made an end of the inhabitants of Seir, every one helped to destroy another.

Ask God to break ungodly confederacies in Jesus name.

Psalm 18 & 37 Referred to David asking God to defeat his enemies.

Bring situations to God's Court of Divine Justice.

Acts 13 & 18 Referred to Simon Magus & Elymus the sorcerer

Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but *rather* give place unto wrath: for it is written, <u>Vengeance</u> is <u>mine</u>; I will repay, saith the <u>Lord</u>.

2 Chronicles 20:24 And when Judah came toward the watch tower in the wilderness, they looked unto the multitude, and, behold, they *were* dead bodies fallen to the earth, and none escaped.
