The Spirit of Nobility - Acts 17C

Paul traveled around preaching the Word of God.

Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.

Acts 17:11-15 These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so. 12 Therefore many of them believed; also of honourable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few. 13 But when the Jews of Thessalonica had knowledge that the word of God was preached of Paul at Berea, they came thither also, and stirred up the people. 14 And then immediately the brethren sent away Paul to go as it were to the sea: but Silas and Timotheus abode there still. 15 And they that conducted Paul brought him unto Athens: and receiving a commandment unto Silas and Timotheus for to come to him with all speed, they departed.

Romans 15:19 Through <u>mighty signs and wonders</u>, by the power of the <u>Spirit of God</u>; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, I have <u>fully preached the gospel of Christ</u>.

Matthew 12:28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

Mark 16: 15-18 Christ's Great Commission referred to

1 Corinthians 2:4 And my speech and my <u>preaching</u> was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in <u>demonstration of the Spirit and of power</u>:

Jesus was the most nobel of all yet He was meek.

Numbers 12:3 (Now the man <u>Moses</u> was very <u>meek</u>, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)

Luke 19:12 He said therefore, A certain nobleman <2104> went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom, and to return.

- 1 Corinthians 1:26 For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble <2104>,
- Acts 17:11 These were <u>more noble</u> than those in Thessalonica, in that <u>they</u> <u>received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.</u>
- 2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

- 2 Corinthians 8:11,12 Now therefore perform the doing; that as *there was* a readiness <4288> to will, so *there may be* a performance also out of that

- which ye have. 12 For if there be first a willing mind <4288>, accepted according to that a man hath, and not according to that he hath not.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him <u>give</u>; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a <u>cheerful</u> <u>giver</u>.
- 2 Corinthians 8:19 And not *that* only, but who was also chosen of the churches to travel with us with this grace, which is administered by us to the glory of the same Lord, & *declaration of* your ready mind <4288>:
- Ezra 7:10 For <u>Ezra</u> had <u>prepared</u> his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do *it*, and to teach in Israel statutes and judgments.
- 2 Corinthians 9:2 For I know the forwardness of <4288> your mind <4288>, for which I boast of you to them of Macedonia, that Achaia was ready a year ago; and your zeal hath provoked very many.
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- Kurt Koch found mental illness closely relates to occult involvement.
- Acts 17:11B searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.
- Isaiah 61:1-4 & Luke 4:17-21 And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.
- Luke 24:32 they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?
- Luke 24:45 Then <u>opened</u> he their <u>understanding</u>, that they might <u>understand</u> the scriptures,
- 2 Kings 6:17 And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.
- 1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of salvation.)
- Acts 17:12-13 Therefore many of them believed; also of honourable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few. 13 But when the Jews of Thessalonica had knowledge that the word of God was preached of Paul at Berea, they came thither also, and stirred up the people.
- Luke 23:5 And they were the more fierce, saying, He <u>stirreth</u> up the <u>people</u>, teaching throughout all Jewry, beginning from Galilee to this place.
- Mark 15:10 For he knew that the chief priests had delivered him for envy.
- Matthew 12:33 Either make the <u>tree good</u>, and his <u>fruit good</u>; or else make the <u>tree</u> corrupt, and his <u>fruit</u> corrupt: for the <u>tree</u> is known by *his* <u>fruit</u>.

- Acts 17:14 And then immediately the brethren sent away Paul to go as it were to the sea: but Silas and Timotheus abode there still.
- Acts 15: 20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.
- Acts 17:15 And they that conducted Paul brought him unto Athens: and receiving a commandment unto Silas and Timotheus for to come to him with all speed, they departed.
- Proverbs 1:5 A wise *man* will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels:
- James 1:5 If any of you <u>lack</u> wisdom, let him <u>ask</u> of God, that giveth to all *men* liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.
- Proverbs 9:9 Give *instruction* to a wise *man*, and he will be yet wiser: teach a just *man*, and he will increase in learning.
- Titus 2:4 That they (elderly women) may <u>teach</u> the young <u>women</u> to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,
- Jeremiah 2:21 Yet I had planted thee a noble vine, wholly a right seed: how then art thou turned into the degenerate plant of a strange vine to me?
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, & pray, & seek My face, & turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, & will forgive their sin, & will heal their land.
- John 1:45-49 Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph. 46 And Nathanael said unto him, Can there any good thing come out of Nazareth? Philip saith unto him, Come and see. 47 Jesus saw Nathanael coming to him, and saith of him, Behold an Israelite indeed, in whom is no guile! 48 Nathanael saith unto him, Whence knowest thou me? Jesus answered and said unto him, Before that Philip called thee, when thou wast under the fig tree, I saw thee. 49 Nathanael answered and saith unto him, Rabbi, Thou art the Son of God; Thou art the King of Israel.
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.
- The Lord fed the Isrealites 40 years in wilderness. Jesus fed 20000 people twice abundantly.
- Acts 2:41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added *unto them* about three thousand souls.
- Philippians 2:12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.

More Service Notes:

- Acts 10:33 Immediately therefore I sent to thee; and thou hast well done that thou art come. Now therefore are we all here present before God, to hear all things that are commanded thee of God.
- Acts 11:1 And the apostles and brethren that were in Judaea heard that the Gentiles had also received the word of God.
- Job 23:12 Neither have I gone back from the commandment of his lips; I have esteemed the words of his mouth more than my necessary *food*.
- Proverbs 2:1-5 My son, if thou wilt receive my words, and hide my commandments with thee; 2 So that thou incline thine ear unto wisdom, and apply thine heart to understanding; 3 Yea, if thou criest after knowledge, and liftest up thy voice for understanding; 4 If thou seekest her as silver, and searchest for her as for hid treasures; 5 Then shalt thou understand the fear of the LORD, and find the knowledge of God.
- Proverbs 8:10 Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold.
- Matthew 13:23 But he that received seed into the good ground is he that heareth the word, and understandeth *it*; which also beareth fruit, and bringeth forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.
- 1 Thessalonians 1:6 And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost:
- 1 Thessalonians 2:13 For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received *it* not *as* the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.
- James 1:21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.
- 1 Peter 2:2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:
- Psalms 1:2,3 But his delight *is* in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. 3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.
- Psalms 119:97 MEM. O how love I thy law! it is my meditation all the day.
- Psalms 119:100, 148 I understand more than the ancients, because I keep thy precepts. 148 Mine eyes prevent the *night* watches, that I might meditate in thy word.
- Isaiah 8:20 To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to

this word, it is because there is no light in them.

- Isaiah 34:16 Seek ye out of the book of the LORD, and read: no one of these shall fail, none shall want her mate: for my mouth it hath commanded, and his spirit it hath gathered them.
- Luke 16:29 Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.
- Luke 24:44 And he said unto them, These *are* the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and *in* the prophets, and *in* the psalms, concerning me.
- John 3:21 But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.
- John 5:39 Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.
- 2 Timothy 3:15-17 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. 16 All scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17 That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.
- 1 Peter 1:10-12 Of which salvation the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you: 11 Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow. 12 Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.
- 2 Peter 1:19-21 We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: 20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. 21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.
- 1 John 4:5,6 They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world, and the world heareth them. 6 We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.
