## The Decline and Fall of Solomon - 1 Kings 11A

Summarized about King David & King Solomon.

Referred to Adam & Eve & their falling for satan's trap.

- 1 Kings 11:1-2 But king <u>Solomon loved many strange women</u>, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, and Hittites; 2 Of the nations concerning which the LORD said unto the children of Israel, Ye shall not go in to them, neither shall they come in unto you: for surely they <u>will turn away your heart after</u> their gods: Solomon clave unto these in love.
- Proverbs was written by King Solomon who warns often of the dangers of the strange woman.
- Proverbs 2:16 To deliver thee from the <u>strange woman</u>, *even* from the stranger *which* <u>flattereth</u> with her words;
- Proverbs 5:3 For the lips of a <u>strange woman</u> drop *as* an honeycomb, and her mouth *is* smoother than oil:
- Proverbs 5:20 And why wilt thou, my son, be <u>ravished with a strange</u> <u>woman</u>, and embrace the bosom of a stranger?
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of <u>Balaam</u>, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- Proverbs 6:24 To keep thee from the <u>evil woman</u>, from the <u>flattery</u> of the tongue of a <u>strange woman</u>.
- Proverbs 7:5 That they may keep thee from the <u>strange woman</u>, from the stranger *which* <u>flattereth</u> with her words.
- Proverbs 20:16 Take his garment that is surety *for* a stranger: and take a pledge of him for a <u>strange woman</u>.
- Proverbs 23:27 For a <u>whore</u> is a deep ditch; and a <u>strange woman</u> is a narrow pit.
- Proverbs 27:13 Take his garment that is surety for a stranger, and take a pledge of him for a <u>strange woman</u>.
- Genesis 39:12 And she caught him by his (Joseph) garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.
- Judges 16:16 And it came to pass, when she pressed him (Samson) daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death;
- 1 Kings 11:3 And he had seven hundred wives, princesses, and three hundred concubines: and his <u>wives turned away his heart</u>.
- Break off the multiple soulties, in Jesus' name, with previous prostitutes.

  And break off the occult Lust witchcraft methods.
- 1 Kings 11:4 For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, that his wives

- turned away his heart after other gods: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as was the heart of David his father.
- Solomon didn't have trials to keep him close to God like King David. Summarized David's trials.
- 1 John 2:16 For all that *is* in the world, the <u>lust</u> of the <u>flesh</u>, and the <u>lust</u> of the <u>eyes</u>, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.
- 10th commandment Exodus 20:17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.
- 1 Kings 11:5 For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, and after Milcom the abomination of the Ammonites. 6 And Solomon did evil in the sight of the LORD, and went not fully after the LORD, as did David his father.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- 1 Kings 11:7-8 Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that is before Jerusalem, & for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon. 8 And <u>likewise did he for all his strange wives</u>, which burnt incense & sacrificed unto their gods.
- 1 Kings 18 referred to the shoot-out on Mount Carmel & that Baal's priests did not win.
- Deuteronomy 17:14-17 When thou art come unto the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, and shalt possess it, and shalt dwell therein, and shalt say, I will set a king over me, like as all the nations that are about me; 15 Thou shalt in any wise set him king over thee, whom the LORD thy God shall choose: (Saul) one from among thy brethren shalt thou set king over thee: thou mayest not set a stranger over thee, which is not thy brother. 16 But he shall not multiply horses to himself, nor cause the people to return to Egypt, to the end that he should multiply horses: forasmuch as the LORD hath said unto you, Ye shall henceforth return no more that way. 17 Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold.
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the <u>root</u> of all <u>evil</u>: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- Deuteronomy 17:18-20 And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of

his kingdom, that he shall <u>write him a copy of this law</u> in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: 19 And <u>it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life</u>: that he may <u>learn to fear the LORD his God</u>, to <u>keep all the words of this law and these statutes</u>, to do them: 20 That <u>his heart be not lifted up</u> above his brethren, and that <u>he turn not aside from the commandment</u>, to the right hand, or to the left: to the end that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he, and his children, in the midst of Israel.

- Deuteronomy 7:1-2 When the LORD thy God shall bring thee into the land whither thou goest to possess it, and hath cast out many nations before thee, the Hittites, and the Girgashites, and the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than thou; 2 And when the LORD thy God shall deliver them before thee; thou shalt smite them, and utterly destroy them; thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor shew mercy unto them:
- In the New Covenant we fight in the heavenlies against demons not against people like in the Old Testament.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.
- Deuteronomy 7:3 Neither shalt thou make marriages with them; thy daughter thou shalt not give unto his son, nor his daughter shalt thou take unto thy son. 4 For they will turn away thy son from following me, that they may serve other gods: so will the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and destroy thee suddenly. 5 But thus shall ye deal with them; ye shall destroy their altars, and break down their images, and cut down their groves, and burn their graven images with fire. 6 For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth.
- 2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not <u>unequally yoked</u> together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?
- 1 Kings 11:9-14 And the LORD was angry with Solomon, because his heart was turned from the LORD God of Israel, which had appeared unto him twice, 10 And had commanded him concerning this thing, that he should not go after other gods: but he kept not that which the LORD commanded. 11 Wherefore the LORD said unto Solomon, Forasmuch as this is done of thee, and thou hast not kept my covenant and my statutes, which I have commanded thee, I will surely rend the kingdom from thee, and will give it to thy servant. 12 Notwithstanding in thy days

I will not do it <u>for David thy father's sake</u>: but I will rend it out of the hand of thy son. 13 Howbeit I will not rend away all the kingdom; but will give one tribe to thy son <u>for David my servant's sake</u>, and for Jerusalem's sake which I have chosen. 14 And the LORD stirred up an adversary unto Solomon, Hadad the Edomite: he was of the king's seed in Edom.

Leaders need to give account for their actions.

Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are <u>sealed</u> unto the day of <u>redemption</u>.

Psalm 51:11 Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.

- 1 Samuel 16:14 But the <u>Spirit</u> of the LORD <u>departed</u> from Saul, and an <u>evil</u> spirit from the LORD troubled him.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also *that is* born unto thee shall surely die.

Summarized the situation why Nathan came to David.

- 2 Samuel 12:7-13 And Nathan said to David. Thou art the man. Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I anointed thee king over Israel, and I delivered thee out of the hand of Saul; 8 And I gave thee thy master's house, and thy master's wives into thy bosom, and gave thee the house of Israel and of Judah; and if that had been too little, I would moreover have given unto thee such and such things. 9 Wherefore hast thou despised the commandment of the LORD, to do evil in his sight? thou hast killed Uriah the Hittite with the sword, and hast taken his wife to be thy wife, and hast slain him with the sword of the children of Ammon. 10 Now therefore the sword shall never depart from thine house; because thou hast despised me, and hast taken the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be thy wife. 11 Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will raise up evil against thee out of thine own house, and I will take thy wives before thine eyes, and give them unto thy neighbour, and he shall lie with thy wives in the sight of this sun. 12 For thou didst it secretly: but I will do this thing before all Israel, and before the sun. 13 And David said unto Nathan, I have sinned against the LORD. And Nathan said unto David, The LORD also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die.
- Psalm 51:4 Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done *this* evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, *and* be clear when thou judgest.
- Exodus 32 summarized Moses on Mount Sinai interceded for 40 days for Isreal & Aaron's sins or God would have wiped them out.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is

born unto thee shall surely die.

Like now when Christian leader falls, the ungodly mock God.

- 1 Corinthians 8:13 Wherefore, if meat make my <u>brother</u> to <u>offend</u>, I will eat no flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my <u>brother</u> to <u>offend</u>.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 Summarized When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. 12 For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee. 13 Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God. 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- Acts 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.
- Isaiah 29:13,14 Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near *me* with their mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far from me, and their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men: 14 Therefore, behold, I will proceed to do a marvellous work among this people, *even* a marvellous work and a wonder: for the wisdom of their wise *men* shall perish, and the understanding of their prudent *men* shall be hid.

Do not follow the decline & fall of Solomon.

Be like David a man after God's heart.
