

Principles of Justice Over Passions - Acts 18E

Acts 18:12-17 And when Gallio was the deputy of Achaia, the Jews made insurrection with one accord against Paul, and brought him to the judgment seat, 13 Saying, This fellow persuadeth men to worship God contrary to the law. 14 And when Paul was now about to open his mouth, Gallio said unto the Jews, If it were a matter of wrong or wicked lewdness, O ye Jews, reason would that I should bear with you: 15 But if it be a question of words and names, and of your law, look ye to it; for I will be no judge of such matters. 16 And he drave them from the judgment seat. 17 Then all the Greeks took Sosthenes, the chief ruler of the synagogue, and beat him before the judgment seat. And Gallio cared for none of those things.

Explained Paul preached to the Jews first, then he went to the Gentiles.

Acts 9:25 Then the disciples took him by night, and let *him* down by the wall in a basket.

Acts 14:19 And there came thither *certain* Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew *him* out of the city, supposing he had been dead.

Acts 18:12 And when Gallio was the deputy of Achaia, the Jews made insurrection with one accord against Paul, and brought him to the judgment seat,

Nowadays, there are mobs, swarmings, knock-out attacks, & "polarbear" attacks, etc.

More people are killed in the name of "God" than any other reason.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Revelation 19 referred to Jesus coming back.

Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

Exodus 20:16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

2721 katephistemi *kat-ef-is'-tay-mee* - make insurrection against

Acts 18:13 Saying, This fellow persuadeth men to worship God contrary to the law.

Acts 17:23 For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, **TO THE UNKNOWN GOD**. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

Paul supported himself tentmaking. He didn't burden the churches.

1 Corinthians 9:11,12,18 If we have sown unto you spiritual things, *is it* a great thing if we shall reap your carnal things? 12 If others be partakers

of *this* power over you, *are* not we rather? Nevertheless we (Paul) have not used this power; but suffer all things, lest we should hinder the gospel of Christ. 18 What is my reward then? *Verily* that, when I preach the gospel, I may make the gospel of Christ without charge, that I abuse not my power in the gospel.

Acts 18:14,15 And when Paul was now about to open his mouth, Gallio said unto the Jews, If it were a matter of wrong or wicked lewdness, O ye Jews, reason would that I should bear with you: 15 But if it be a question of words and names, and of your law, look ye to it; for I will be no judge of such matters.

Leviticus 18 & 20 referred to as topics illegal to say in some areas.

Acts 19:34 But when they knew that he was a Jew, all with one voice about the space of two hours cried out, Great *is* Diana of the Ephesians.

Acts 18:16,17 And he drave them from the judgment seat. 17 Then all the Greeks took Sosthenes, the chief ruler of the synagogue, and beat him before the judgment seat. And Gallio cared for none of those things.

Often now, anarchists join peaceful protests stirring up trouble.

John 15:18-25 If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you. 19 If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you. 20 Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also. 21 But all these things will they do unto you for my name's sake, because they know not Him that sent Me.

1 John 2:23 Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (*but*) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.

John 15:22-24 If I had not come and spoken unto them, they had not had sin: but now they have no cloke for their sin. 23 He that hateth me hateth my Father also. 24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.

John 15:24 (NKJV) "If I had not done among them the works which no one else did, they would have no sin; but now they have seen and also hated both Me and My Father.

Matthew 12:40 For as Jonas was 3 days & 3 nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be 3 days & 3 nights in the heart of the earth.

John 15:25 But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause.

Psalms 35:19 Let not them that are mine enemies wrongfully rejoice over me: *neither* let them wink with the eye that hate me without a cause.

Psalms 69:4 They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of

mine head: they that would destroy me, *being* mine enemies wrongfully,
are mighty: then I restored *that* which I took not away.

Psalms 109:3 They compassed me about also with words of hatred; and fought against me without a cause.

Genesis 18:25 That be far from thee to do after this manner, to slay the righteous with the wicked: & that the righteous should be as the wicked, that be far from thee: Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?

Explained about Abraham negotiating with Jesus to ten righteous.

Moses pleaded to enter the promise land, but God said No.

Genesis 19:22 Haste thee, escape thither; for I cannot do any thing till thou be come thither. Therefore the name of the city was called Zoar.

Proverbs 31:9 Open thy mouth, judge righteously, and plead the cause of the poor and needy.

Be like little Davids against the big Goliaths. Pray taking these situations before God's Court of Divine Justice.

More Service Notes:

Leviticus 19:15 Ye shall do no unrighteousness in judgment: thou shalt not respect the person of the poor, nor honour the person of the mighty: *but* in righteousness shalt thou judge thy neighbour.

Deuteronomy 1:16 And I charged your judges at that time, saying, Hear *the causes* between your brethren, and judge righteously between *every* man and his brother, and the stranger *that is* with him.

Deuteronomy 25:1 If there be a controversy between men, and they come unto judgment, that *the judges* may judge them; then they shall justify the righteous, and condemn the wicked.

1 Kings 8:32 Then hear thou in heaven, and do, and judge thy servants, condemning the wicked, to bring his way upon his head; and justifying the righteous, to give him according to his righteousness.

2 Chronicles 6:23 Then hear thou from heaven, & do, & judge thy servants, by requiting the wicked, by recompensing his way upon his own head; & by justifying the righteous, by giving him according to his righteousness.

Job 9:15 Whom, though I were righteous, yet would I not answer, *but* I would make supplication to my judge.

Job 23:7 There the righteous might dispute with him; so should I be delivered for ever from my judge.

Psalms 7:8 The LORD shall judge the people: judge me, O LORD, according to my righteousness, and according to mine integrity *that is* in me.

Psalms 9:8 And he shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness.

Psalms 35:24 Judge me, O LORD my God, according to thy righteousness; and let them not rejoice over me.

Psalms 50:6 And the heavens shall declare his righteousness: for God *is*

judge himself. Selah.

Psalms 58:1 Do ye indeed speak righteousness, O congregation? do ye judge uprightly, O ye sons of men?

Psalms 67:4 O let the nations be glad and sing for joy: for thou shalt judge the people righteously, and govern the nations upon earth. Selah.

Psalms 72:2 He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy poor with judgment.

Psalms 96:10 Say among the heathen *that* the LORD reigneth: the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved: he shall judge the people righteously.

Psalms 96:13 Before the LORD: for he cometh to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his truth.

Psalms 98:9 Before the LORD; for he cometh to judge the earth: with righteousness shall he judge the world, and the people with equity.

Ecclesiastes 3:17 I said in mine heart, God shall judge the righteous & the wicked: for *there is* a time there for every purpose and for every work.

Isaiah 11:4 But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, & reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: & he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, & with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked.

Isaiah 51:5 My righteousness *is* near; my salvation is gone forth, and mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon me, and on mine arm shall they trust.

Ezekiel 23:45 And the righteous men, they shall judge them after the manner of adulteresses, and after the manner of women that shed blood; because they *are* adulteresses, and blood *is* in their hands.

John 7:24 Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.

Acts 17:31 Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by *that* man whom he hath ordained; *whereof* he hath given assurance unto all *men*, in that he hath raised him from the dead.

2 Timothy 4:8 Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

Revelation 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him *was* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.
