Getting Ready For Action - Joshua 5A

Joshua 5:1-9 And it came to pass, when all the kings of the Amorites, which were on the side of Jordan westward, and all the kings of the Canaanites, which were by the sea, heard that the LORD had dried up the waters of Jordan from before the children of Israel, until we were passed over, that their heart melted, neither was there spirit in them any more, because of the children of Israel. 2 At that time the LORD said unto Joshua, Make thee sharp knives, and circumcise again the children of Israel the second time. 3 And Joshua made him sharp knives, and circumcised the children of Israel at the hill of the foreskins. 4 And this is the cause why Joshua did circumcise: All the people that came out of Egypt, that were males, even all the men of war, died in the wilderness by the way, after they came out of Egypt. 5 Now all the people that came out were circumcised: but all the people that were born in the wilderness by the way as they came forth out of Egypt, them they had not circumcised. 6 For the children of Israel walked forty years in the wilderness, till all the people that were men of war, which came out of Egypt, were consumed, because they obeyed not the voice of the LORD: unto whom the LORD sware that he would not shew them the land, which the LORD sware unto their fathers that he would give us, a land that floweth with milk & honey. 7 And their children, whom he raised up in their stead, them Joshua circumcised: for they were uncircumcised, because they had not circumcised them by the way. 8 And it came to pass, when they had done circumcising all the people, that they abode in their places in the camp, till they were whole. 9 And the LORD said unto Joshua, This day have I rolled away the reproach of Egypt from off you. Wherefore the name of the place is called Gilgal unto this day.

Summarized the Isrealites crossing the Jordan River.

Joshua 5:1 And it came to pass, when <u>all the kings</u> of the Amorites, which were on the side of Jordan westward, and all the kings of the Canaanites, which were by the sea, <u>heard that the LORD had dried up the waters of Jordan</u> from before the children of Israel, until we were passed over, that <u>their heart melted</u>, <u>neither was there spirit in them any more</u>, because of the children of Israel. (They were overcome with fear.)

Psalm 23:3 He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

Esther 9 Summarized Haman trying to kill the Jews. V2 The <u>Jews</u> gathered themselves together in their cities throughout all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus, to lay hand on such as sought their hurt: and no man

- could withstand them; for the fear of them fell upon all people.
- Acts 5:11 And great fear came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things.
- Exodus 23:27 I will send my fear before thee, and will destroy all the people to whom thou shalt come, and I will make all thine enemies turn their backs unto thee.
- Mark 5:7 And (the demon) cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, *thou* Son of the most high God? I adjure thee by God, that thou torment me not.
- In Old Testament, things were done in the physical, in the New Testament things are done in the spiritual.
- John 18:6 As soon then as he had said unto them, I am *he*, they went <u>backward</u>, and <u>fell</u> to the ground.
- Psalms 53:5 There were they in great fear, *where* no fear was: for God hath scattered the bones of him that encampeth *against* thee: thou hast put *them* to shame, because God hath despised them.
- 2 Kings 7:6,7 For the Lord had made the host of the Syrians to hear a noise of chariots, and a noise of horses, even the noise of a great host: and they said one to another, Lo, the king of Israel hath hired against us the kings of the Hittites, and the kings of the Egyptians, to come upon us. 7 Wherefore they arose and fled in the twilight, and left their tents, and their horses, & their asses, even the camp as it was, & fled for their life.
- Judges 7:20,21 And the three companies blew the trumpets, and brake the pitchers, and held the lamps in their left hands, and the trumpets in their right hands to blow *withal*: and they cried, The <u>sword</u> of the <u>LORD</u>, and of <u>Gideon</u>. 21 And they stood every man in his place round about the camp: and all the host ran, and cried, and fled.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Joshua 5:2,3 At that time the LORD said unto Joshua, Make thee sharp knives, and circumcise again the children of Israel the second time. 3 And Joshua made him sharp knives, and circumcised the children of Israel at the hill of the foreskins.
- Genesis 17:23 And Abraham took Ishmael his son, and all that were born in his house, and all that were bought with his money, every male among the men of Abraham's house; and circumcised the flesh of their foreskin in the selfsame day, as God had said unto him.
- Genesis 17:9-14 And God said unto Abraham, Thou shalt keep my covenant therefore, thou, and thy seed after thee in their generations. 10 This *is* my covenant, which ye shall keep, between me and you and thy seed after thee; Every man child among you shall be circumcised. 11 And ye

shall circumcise the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a token of the covenant betwixt me and you. 12 And he that is eight days old shall be circumcised among you, every man child in your generations, he that is born in the house, or bought with money of any stranger, which *is* not of thy seed. 13 He that is born in thy house, and he that is bought with thy money, must needs be circumcised: and my covenant shall be in your flesh for an everlasting covenant. 14 And the uncircumcised man child whose flesh of his foreskin is not circumcised, that soul shall be cut off from his people; he hath broken my covenant.

Summarized of the spies bringing back an evil report; the reproach from God on the Isrealites; & all men of war died in the wilderness.

Amos interceded 4X & God delayed punishment 3X.

Abraham pleaded with the Lord down to 10 righteous to not destroy Sodom. Genesis 34 Summarized of Simeon & Judah deceiving Shechem & men.

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Daniel 10 referred to daniels answer from God delayed 3 weeks.

Luke 18 parable of the persistant widow summarized.

Ezeziel 14:3 Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?

Joshua 5:4,5 And this is the cause why Joshua did circumcise: All the people that came out of Egypt, that were males, even all the men of war, died in the wilderness by the way, after they came out of Egypt. 5 Now all the people that came out were circumcised: but all the people that were born in the wilderness by the way as they came forth out of Egypt, them they had not circumcised.

Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me;

Exodus 4 Moses actions summarized & Zipporah circumcised his son.

Joshua 5:6-8 For the children of Israel walked forty years in the wilderness, till all the people that were men of war, which came out of Egypt, were consumed, because they obeyed not the voice of the LORD: unto whom the LORD sware that he would not shew them the land, which the LORD sware unto their fathers that he would give us, a land that floweth with milk and honey. 7 And their children, whom he raised up in their stead, them Joshua circumcised: for they were uncircumcised, because they had not circumcised them by the way. 8 And it came to pass, when they had done circumcising all the people, that they abode in their places in

the camp, till they were whole.

This was a kind of re-dedication to God.

- Matthew 10:37 He that <u>loveth</u> father or mother <u>more</u> than <u>me</u> is not worthy of <u>me</u>: and he that <u>loveth</u> son or daughter <u>more</u> than <u>me</u> is not worthy of me.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye at my sacrifice and at mine offering, which I have commanded *in my* habitation; and honourest thy sons above me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel my people?
- Summarized the persecution & Martyrdom of Vanya by the Soviet army.
- Joshua 5:9 And the LORD said unto Joshua, This day have I rolled away the reproach of Egypt from off you. Wherefore the name of the place is called Gilgal unto this day.
- Romans 2:29 But he *is* a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision *is* that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise *is* not of men, but of God.
- Colossians 2:11 In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:
- Summarized of David & Goliath, how David was ready for the action.
- Ezra 7:10 For Ezra had <u>prepared</u> his <u>heart</u> to seek the law of the LORD, and to do *it*, and to teach in Israel statutes and judgments.
- Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye <u>present your bodies a living sacrifice</u>, <u>holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service</u>.
- 1 John 2:15 <u>Love</u> not the <u>world</u>, neither the things *that are* in the <u>world</u>. If any man <u>love</u> the <u>world</u>, the <u>love</u> of the <u>Father</u> is not in him.

Be like Joseph who ran from temptations.

Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. 3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think *of himself* more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.
