Switching From the Old to the New - Joshua 5B

Explained of coming out of the old sin life to the new life in Christ.

Summarized about the wandering in the wilderness of Isrealites & coming into the promised land.

- Joshua 5:10-12 And the children of Israel encamped in Gilgal, and kept the passover on the fourteenth day of the month at even in the plains of Jericho. 11 And they did eat of the old corn of the land on the morrow after the passover, unleavened cakes, and parched corn in the selfsame day. 12 And the manna ceased on the morrow after they had eaten of the old corn of the land; neither had the children of Israel manna any more; but they did eat of the fruit of the land of Canaan that year.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Gilgal here is just 1 mile east of Jericho.

The Passover feast was about the beginning of the barley harvest.

Passover reminds them of their deliverance from bondage in Egypt. This is similar to our remembering the day of our salvation.

The local country folk went into Jericho for safety leaving their crops. Isreal could eat off the land that the Lord had provided for them.

- John 6:9-13 There is a lad here, which hath <u>five</u> barley <u>loaves</u>, and two small <u>fishes</u>: but what are they among so many? 10 And Jesus said, Make the men sit down. Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand. 11 And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would. 12 When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost. 13 Therefore they gathered *them* together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten.
- Isaiah 40:31 But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.
- Psalms 37:9 For evildoers shall be cut off: but those <u>that wait upon</u> the LORD, they shall inherit the earth.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye <u>not</u> that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in <u>you</u>, which ye have of God, and ye are <u>not</u> your <u>own</u>? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your

body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

- Deuteronomy 6:10,11 And it shall be, when the LORD thy God shall have brought thee into the land which he sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give thee great and goodly cities, which thou buildedst not, 11 And houses full of all good *things*, which thou filledst not, and wells digged, which thou diggedst not, vineyards and olive trees, which thou plantedst not; when thou shalt have eaten and be full;
- Joshua 2:9 And she said unto the men, I know that the LORD hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you.
- God protected the Isrealites while they recovered from the circumcision.
- Psalms 23:5 Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.
- Job 1:10 Hast not thou made an hedge about him, and about all that he hath on every side? thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his substance is increased in the land.
- Exodus 34:24 For I will cast out the nations before thee, and enlarge thy borders: neither shall any man desire thy land, when thou shalt go up to appear before the LORD thy God thrice in the year.
- **Exodus 12 Summarized. Read for extra study of the Passover.**
- Compair the Passover to spiritual things that happen on Salvation.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are <u>sealed</u> unto the day of <u>redemption</u>.
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, *I say*, and willing rather to be <u>absent</u> from the body, and to be <u>present</u> with the <u>Lord</u>.
- 2 Corinthians 1:22 Who hath also sealed us, and given the <u>earnest</u> of the Spirit in our hearts.
- 2 Kings 23 Summarized of King Josiah cleaning up Isreal from idolatry.
- John 6:29-31 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on Him whom He hath sent. 30 They said therefore unto him, What sign shewest thou then, that we may see, and believe thee? what dost thou work? 31 Our fathers did eat manna in the desert; as it is written, He gave them bread from heaven to eat.
- Jesus had already fed groups of 4000 and 5000 men, plus women & children, miraculously.
- John 8:32,36 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. 36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled <u>again</u> with the yoke of <u>bondage</u>.
- John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater *works* than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.
- John 6:32,33 Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but My Father giveth you the true bread from heaven. 33 For the bread of God is He which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- Acts 15:1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, *and said*, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.
- John 6:34,35 Then said they unto Him, Lord, evermore give us this bread. 35 And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.
- Like the woman of the well in John 4.
- John 6:36 But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not.
- Acts 7:41 And they made a calf in those days, and offered sacrifice unto the idol, and rejoiced in the <u>works</u> of their own <u>hands</u>. (refers to Exodus 32 Summarized.)
- Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.
- Ezekiel 14:Ezekiel 14:3 Son of man, these men have set up their <u>idols</u> in their <u>heart</u>, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: <u>evil</u> communications <u>corrupt</u> <u>good</u> manners.
- Flee evil like Joseph. Do not do evil like Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, etc.
- Ephesians 4:28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.
- **Exodus 20:15 Thou shalt not steal.**

- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the <u>nurture</u> and <u>admonition</u> of the <u>Lord</u>.
- Titus 2:4 That they (elderly women) may <u>teach</u> the young women to be sober, to <u>love</u> their husbands, to <u>love</u> their children,
- 1 Thessalonians 4:11 And that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you;
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses *was* very <u>meek</u>, above <u>all</u> the <u>men</u> which *were* upon the face of the earth.)
- Matthew 11:29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I (Jesus) am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.
- Revelation 9:20 And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the <u>works</u> of their <u>hands</u>, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:
- 2 Peter 2:5 And spared not the old world, but saved <u>Noah</u> the eighth *person*, a <u>preacher</u> of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

Jonah summarized of God's grace on Nineveh.

Exodus 20:3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

- 1 Kings18:21 And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? if the LORD *be* God, follow him: but if Baal, *then* follow him. And the people answered him not a word.
- 1 Kings 18:39 And when all the people saw *it*, they fell on their faces: and they said, The <u>LORD</u>, <u>he</u> *is* the <u>God</u>; the <u>LORD</u>, <u>he</u> *is* the <u>God</u>.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- Matthew 14:30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, <u>Lord</u>, <u>save</u> <u>me</u>.
